Public office is a public trust. Public officers and employees must at all times be accountable to the people, serve them with utmost responsibility, integrity, loyalty, and efficiency, act with patriotism and justice, and lead modest lives.¹

This resolves the Complaint filed by Lee Elumba Nellas, Rogelio M. Waniwan, and Flordeliz M. Java against Barangay Chairperson Diosdado T. Wabe, Delia Wabe and Lycelle D. Quilantang.

Version of the complainants

The Complainants alleged that Barangay 31 organized a basketball league which was held on November 1 - 30, 2018 at the open court of the said barangay. In their affidavit complaint, they aver that the barangay allocated the amount of One Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Pesos (Php 151,780.00) for the said project. This was sourced from the MOOE - Cultural and Athletic Expenses.

However, the said basketball league was not implemented and no open basketball league for women's division was ever conducted.²

Respondents' Defense

In their Position Paper, Respondents posit that they were not furnished with a copy of the complaint affidavit. Further, Respondents hinge their defense based on the lack of evidence presented by Complainants³

The issue that needs to be addressed is whether or not Respondents violated any provisions of the Local Government Code.

WE RESOLVE.

As to the procedural aspect

To straighten the records of this case, this Office received a copy of the Joint Affidavit Complaint of Nellas, Waniwan, and Java on October 28, 2022. However, when this case was called on January 26, 2023, the records revealed that Respondents were not furnished with a copy of the said complaint. Accordingly, this office directed the secretariat to deliver a copy to Atty. Gan, who was likewise present on the said hearing. Lastly, Atty. Gan was given fifteen (15) days to file the answer if he so desires.

Contrary to what the Respondents postulated in their Position Paper, Complainants had complied with the necessary forms of filing the instance case and the parties were duly furnished with copies thereof.

Substantial evidence, quantum of proof in administrative cases

Settled is the rule that the quantum of proof in administrative proceedings necessary for a finding of guilt is substantial evidence or such relevant evidence as a reasonable mind may accept as adequate to support a conclusion.

Substantial evidence is defined as such amount of relevant evidence which a reasonable mind might accept as adequate to support a conclusion. It is more than a mere scintilla of evidence⁴. The standard of substantial evidence is satisfied when there is reasonable ground to believe, based on the evidence submitted, that the respondent is responsible for the misconduct complained of. It need not be overwhelming or preponderant, as is required in an ordinary civil case,⁵ or evidence beyond reasonable doubt, as is required in criminal cases, but the evidence must be enough for a reasonable mind to support a conclusion.

Here, Complainants testified on their complainant of facts which they had personal knowledge of. First, as incumbent *Kagawads*, they particularly know the budget allocation and the projects which are to be implemented. To further corroborate their allegations of the ghost activity, they submitted the

activity design, disbursement voucher showing that the amount of Php 151,780.00 was released. They also showed photos depicting participants but were not actually playing at the Barangay 31 open basketball court. Complainants attached payrolls from November 1-31, 2018 showing the release of funds. Finally, Complainants also showed a photograph of the actual basketball court of Barangay 31 which is way different from what was documented by Respondents.

All these satisfy the standard required of substantial evidence in administrative proceedings.

As to the substantive issue

The 1987 Constitution spells out the basic ethos underlying public office:

Section 1. Public office is a public trust. Public officers and employees must at all times be accountable to the people, serve them with utmost responsibility, integrity, loyalty, and efficiency and act with patriotism and justice, and lead modest lives.⁶

This provision was conceived after decades of Martial Law rule. The Filipino People have framed and adopted the 1987 Constitution, which sets forth in the Declaration of Principles and State Policies in Article II that "[t]he State shall maintain honesty and integrity in the public service and take positive and effective measures against graft and corruption. Learning how unbridled power could corrupt public servants under the regime of a dictator, the Framers put primacy on the integrity of the public service by declaring it as a constitutional principle and a State policy. More significantly, the 1987 Constitution strengthened and solidified what has been first proclaimed in the 1973 Constitution by commanding public officers to be accountable to the people at all times:

In Belgica, it was explained that:

[t]he aphorism forged under Section 1, Article XI of the 1987 Constitution, which states that "public office is a public trust," is an **overarching reminder that every instrumentality of government should exercise their official functions only in accordance with the principles of the Constitution which embodies the parameters of the people's trust. The notion of a public trust connotes accountability**

A careful examination of the Activity Design⁸ would show that the basketball league was intended for the residents of Brgy 31 and the event was to be held at Barangay 31, open basketball court. The document reveals that the objective of the league is to "enhance the development of the residents of Barangay 31, into the field of sports enable them to become law abiding citizens as they learn the true essence of sportsmanship and enhancing their skills in the field of sport activities".

Clearly, this league was only intended only for the residents of Barangay 31 and that the event should be held at the open basketball court in the said barangay.

Preceding therefrom, Complainants established the fact of the existence of a Barangay project for basketball league. Likewise, the disbursement voucher⁹, Liquidation Report,¹⁰ Authorization¹¹, and payrolls¹², are pieces of evidence showing the disbursement of funds submitted to this committee would obviously denote that public funds were in fact released.

The controversy arose as to how this project was implemented. There is a patent narrative to arrive at an inference this project was really not implemented, or simply a ghost activity.

First, Complainants proved the fact that the basketball court is not the actual basketball court of Barangay 31. Second, the participants of the said basketball league are not residents of Barangay 31.

Grave Misconduct, violation of the Local Government Code

The Local Government Code enumerates the grounds for disciplinary action of which an elective official may be disciplined, suspended, or removed from office, based on any of the following grounds, to wit:

CHAPTER 4. - DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS SECTION 60. Grounds for Disciplinary Actions. - An elective local official may be disciplined, suspended, or removed from office on any of the following grounds:

(c) Dishonesty, oppression, misconduct in office, gross negligence, or dereliction of duty;

XXX

In *Atty. Amado Q. Navarro v. Ombudsman*¹³, the Supreme Court defined dishonesty and Grave Misconduct in this wise, to wit:

Dishonesty and Grave Misconduct

Dishonesty is committed when an individual intentionally makes a false statement of any material fact, practices or attempts to practice any deception or fraud in order to secure his examination, registration, appointment, or promotion. It is understood to imply the disposition to lie, cheat, deceive, betray or defraud; untrustworthiness; lack of integrity; lack of honesty, probity or integrity in principle; and the lack of fairness and straightforwardness.

Misconduct, on the other hand, is intentional wrongdoing or deliberate violation of a rule of law or standard of behavior. To constitute an administrative offense, misconduct should relate to or be connected with the performance of the official functions and duties of a public officer. In grave misconduct, as distinguished from simple misconduct, the elements of corruption, clear intent to violate the law, or flagrant disregard of an established rule must be manifest.

From the given definitions above, the element of **intent to commit a wrong** exists in both administrative offenses of dishonesty and grave misconduct which, under the law, merit the penalty of dismissal from service.

Dishonesty and misconduct are both present in this case. First, Respondent failed to rebut the allegations against them that the participants of the basketball league were not residents of Barangay 31 and that the event was not held at the said basketball court of the barangay. What is surprising to this committee is the fact that Respondents neither submitted nor presented any evidence to prove that there was no anomaly in the open basketball league project. They heavily relied on the argument that the allegations against them is based on hearsay.

Second, Complainants had established the fact that the venue that was in the photograph was not actually the basketball court of Barangay 31.

Further, it was also established by the Complainants that the participants of the basketball league were not residents of Barangay 31.

Considering that Complainants presented substantial evidence that such a reasonable mind might accept as adequate to support a conclusion that Respondents committed dishonesty and misconduct, the burden now is shifted to the latter which they failed to do so. They did not make any explanation as to how the project was implemented.

All told, Barangay Officials are the grassroot leaders of this City. As leaders and elected officials, they are mandated by the constitution to be serve with utmost responsibility, integrity, loyalty, and efficiency.

WHEREFORE, this Committee finds Respondents Diosdado Wabe, Delia Wabe, and Lycelle Quilantang guilty of dishonesty and misconduct. Respondents are hereby suspended for four (4) months.

DISSENTING OPINION

This case stemmed from the complaint of Barangay Kagawads of Barangay 31, this City, namely Hon. Lee Elumba Nellas, Hon. Rogelio M. Waniwan and Hon. Flordeliz M. Java, against Punong Barangay Diosdado T. Wabe, Hon. Delia T. Wabe and Barangay Treasurer Lycelle D. Quilantang for allegedly conducting a ghost activity.

The committee opined finding the Respondents guilty for Grave Misconduct and Dishonesty. However, on the other hand, the undersigned respectfully opine otherwise as it finds no sufficient basis on the allegations propounded by the Complainants.

Ghost activity, as defined, is an activity planned and organized, and funds allocated thereto, but has not actually transpired. As alleged, Respondents conducted a ghost activity by hosting a basketball league in their barangay. Complainants believed that this activity did not actually happened stating that they have not seen such activity. Contrarily, evidences would show that such activity actually happened. Respondent, in support and as justification thereof, submitted liquidation of the activity by submitting the disbursement voucher, liquidation report, activity design, pictures and payroll to the Commission on Audit (COA). This fact alone debunks the allegation that such activity did not transpire. Nowhere in the affidavit and position paper of the Complainant would support their allegations. In fact, they themselves were the ones who presented the evidences which can bolster the defense of the Respondents. **Basic is the rule that an allegation alone not supported with evidence is merely hearsay and therefore must not be given credence and weight.** [Emphasis supplied].

The Supreme Court, in a long line of cases, has consistently ruled that:

“It is a basic rule on evidence that a witness can testify only on the facts that he knows of his own personal knowledge, i.e. those which are derived from his own perception. A witness may not testify on what he merely learned, read or heard from others because such testimony is considered hearsay and may not be received as proof of the truth of what he has learned, read or heard.

Hearsay evidence is evidence, not of what the witness knows himself but, of what he has heard from others; it is not only limited to oral testimony or statement but likewise applies to written statements, such as affidavits.”

xxx

xxx

xxx

It must also be noted that during preliminary conference, Complainants prayed before the Committee that the City Accounting Office be ordered to investigate on the matter to which the undersigned responded that the committee cannot do so as it will already be adducing evidence for the Complainants.

To add, it must also be noted that there is even no single finding from the Commission on Audit (COA) to support that there was irregularity in the conduct of such activity. To this, what the Complainant could have done to strengthen their case is to present corroborative witnesses who allegedly took part of the said activity that it did not actually transpire. However, apparently, they have also failed to do so.

Lastly, as to the allegation that the said activity was not conducted in their barangay, there no prohibition in any law or rules that the barangay council cannot conduct activity outside its jurisdiction. The undersigned finds no wrong when the Respondents opted to conduct the said basketball league in a different venue considering that they do not have a covered court in their barangay to prepare for any contingencies. Logic will say that the fact that they held the said activity in a different venue does not necessarily follow that the said program did not also actually happen. The evidences presented by the Complainants themselves, attached in their affidavit, would actually state otherwise. **Having no evidence to refute the authenticity and veracity of such documents, which are public documents, then the presumption of regularity shall stand in favor of the Respondents.** [Emphasis supplied]

Substantial evidence, based on jurisprudence and as quantum of proof in administrative cases, is defined as such amount of relevant evidence which a reasonable mind might accept as adequate to support a conclusion. It is more than a mere scintilla of evidence. The standard of substantial evidence is satisfied when there is reasonable ground to believe, based on the evidence submitted, that the respondent is responsible for the misconduct complained of. It need not be overwhelming or preponderant, as is required in an ordinary civil case, or evidence beyond reasonable doubt, as is required in criminal cases, but the evidence must be enough for a reasonable mind to support a conclusion.

As defined above, the undersigned believes that the standard of evidence required from the Complainants which was presented before this committee, based on the evidences, has not been met by the Complainants which, as a result, the committee can conclude that the activity complained of was actually a bogus. No documentary evidence was presented by the Complainant, aside from those attached in their joint affidavit and which can actually prove the existence of the activity, other than their mere allegation. Hence, such allegation has no leg to stand on and must therefore fail.

Thought the defense of the Respondents is that of denial, which is the weakest form of defense, the Complainant must rely on the strength of their case and not of the weakness of the opposing party. It must be remembered that the burden of proof is with the Complainant to prove their allegations against the Respondent of which the undersigned believes, based on the evidences presented, that the former has failed to establish.

The undersigned respectfully opines that the Committee, especially in resolving cases that would render a penalty of suspension, must be cautious in considering the evidences presented to it as it will result in deprivation of a person's life and property which will ultimately affect not only their respective families but was well as their constituents.

RECOMMENDATION

For lack of evidence on the part of the Complainants, the undersigned recommends for the dismissal of the case.

PREFATORY STATEMENT

" Malversation is committed either intentionally or by negligence. The dolo or the culpa present in the offense is only a modality in the perpetration of the felony. Even if the mode charged differs from the mode proved, the same offense of malversation is involved and conviction thereof is proper. All that is necessary for conviction is sufficient proof that the accountable officer had received public funds, that he did not have them in his possession when demand therefor was made, and that he could not satisfactorily explain his failure to do so. Direct evidence of personal misappropriation by the accused is hardly necessary as long as the accused cannot explain satisfactorily the shortage in his accounts." ¹

Complainants filed an administrative complaint and/or seeking for an administrative investigation against Barangay 31 Chairman Diosdado Wabe, Barangay 31 Committee Chairman for Appropriations Delia T. Wabe and our

Quilantang for MALVERSATION committed by conducting an activity titled: " Barangay 31 Open Basketball League " which was allegedly held last November 1 – 30, 2018 at Barangay 31 Open Basketball Court for Men and Women using the MOOE for Cultural and Athletic Expenses of Barangay No.31 in the amount P151,780.00

Thus, we respectfully raise the following issues, to wit:

ISSUE/S:

Given the foregoing facts and circumstances, the following issues are presented for discussion:

- I. WHETHER OR NOT RESPONDENT IS CRIMINALLY AND ADMINISTRATIVELY LIABLE.**
- II. WHETHER OR NOT CONSPIRACY EXIST BETWEEN RESPONDENTS**

ARGUMENTS AND DISCUSSIONS

Issues denominated as I and II are jointly discussed since these issues intertwined.

Complainants are elected Barangay Kagawad since July 2, 2018 and were never absent to our Regular Sessions which are regularly scheduled on 1st and 3rd Monday of the month which was recently rescheduled to 1st and 2nd Monday of the month. However, they were shocked to know that the Barangay released an amount of P151,780.00² for the activity Open Basketball League for women's and men's which was never conducted.

The in the Disbursement Voucher, respondents attached pictures of the players playing at the alleged venue basketball court in Barangay 31 which is marked as Annex "A-4", however, the said basketball court appearing in Annex "A-4" does not depict the true Basket Court of Barangay 31 (Please see attached photo of the only basketball court of Barangay 31) and the alleged players appearing in the pictures (Annex A-4) are not residents of Barangay 31 and the complainants has not seen them in their barangay.

Complainants can attest that no open basketball league for women's division was ever conducted in their barangay.

Proof, not mere conjectures or assumptions, should be proffered to indicate that the accused had taken part in.³ Fairly evident, however, is the fact that the actions taken by respondents involved the very functions they had to discharge in the performance of his official duties. There has been full knowledge of all respondents

that they are committing irregularity in disbursing the fund without actual activity conducted.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully prayed unto this Honorable Office that an administrative sanction be imposed against respondents for MALVERSATION.

Such other reliefs and remedies consistent with law, justice and equity are likewise prayed for.

I WHETHER OR NOT RESPONDENTS WERE INVOLVED IN GHOST ACTIVITY WITH AN ALLOCATED BUDGET AS ALLEGED BY COMPLAINANTS

DISCUSSIONS, ARGUMENTS WITH JURISPRUDENCE

At the onset the complainants submitted a Letter Complaint and subscribed on September 27, 2022, Thereafter, they submitted mere Affidavit without furnishing the respondents herein, and the same was not in substantial form as required by the Committee on Ethics and Blue Ribbon Committee.

Perusing their allegations, the same had no legs to stand and did not hold water. The basic rule is that were allegations is not evidence and is not equivalent to proof. Charges based on mere suspicion and speculation likewise cannot be given credence, (787 Phil. 167, 2016' A. C No. 11087 October 12, 2020). Hence, a mere allegation is not evidence and he who alleges has the burden of proving his allegation with the requisite quantum of evidence. (G.R. No. 193804, February 27,2013).

Numerous orders had already been given by this Honorable Office for the Complainants to submit their Judicial Affidavit and substantiate their allegations but the same fell on callous and deaf ears. Having failed to do so, it is but proper to further say that their complaint fell squarely on hearsay rule. It means any information that has been heard from here and there. Such information cannot be believed because the source could not be authenticated. It is also hearsay if its probative value is not based on the personal knowledge of the witness but on the knowledge of another person who is not on the witness stand (G.R. No. 182356, December 4, 2013)

PRAYER


WHEREFORE, premises considered it is most respectfully prayed of the Honorable Office of the Committee on Ethics and Blue Ribbon that the instant case hurled against the respondents herein be dismissed outright for utter lack of merit.

This pertains to the herein attached Motion No. 062-2023 of the Committee on Games and Amusement referring to the City Legal Office the letter request of Mr. Rodrigo G. Go, LOSA-President, requesting for a special permit to hold an INIVITATIONAL 2-DAY "5 STAG-DERBY" on August 15 and 17, 2023 at Lumbia Octagon Sports Arena, located at Barangay Lumbia, this City, in time for the upcoming Higalaay Festival, for review, recommendation, and legal opinion.

In this connection, we would like to direct your attention to the pertinent provisions of law pertaining to operation and regulation of cockpits, specifically on derby, to wit:

City Ordinance No. 4373-94
CHAPTER 171: COCKPITS

SECTION 736. Definition of terms:

x X x

g. Regular Cockfight – A cockfight held on Sundays and/or legal Holidays.

h. Special Cockfight – A cockfight held on days other than Sundays and Legal Holidays for special purposes.

i. Special Permit – A permit secured from the Commission for International Derby or the City Mayor for local derby, as the case may be, to hold cockfighting on days other than Sundays and Legal Holidays.

x X x

SECTION 738. Special cockfighting.- Special cockfighting shall likewise be allowed on special and legal holidays from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. upon prior application and approval of the City Council through an ordinance for the purpose and the corresponding permit issued by the City Mayor, except on the days not allowed by law, to wit:

1. New Year's Day (January 1)
2. Maundy Thursday and Good Friday
3. Philippine Independence Day
4. All Saint's Day (November 1)
5. Christmas Day (December 25)


6. Election/Referendum Day
7. On the occasion of agricultural, commercial or industrial fairs, carnival or exposition within the month of the City fiesta.

SECTION 739. *Derby.* - **Derby shall be allowed once a month and for a duration not exceeding two days in each duly licensed cockpit with an interval of at least six (6) days. One additional derby for a duration not exceeding two days may be allowed on the occasion of the City or Barangay Fiesta where the cockpit is located and also during the Christmas Season.** Such additional Derbys. may not be covered by the 6-day interval. In all cases, shall derby be allowed only upon prior approval of the City Council through an ordinance for the purpose and the corresponding permit issued by the City Mayor, except on the days not allowed by law. The filing of applications for derby with the Sanggunian Panlungsod shall be made at least thirty (30) days before the holding of the same. [AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 5347-96; ORDINANCE NO. 8832-2003]

On the account of the foregoing, provided that the above provision of law is duly complied with, then this office opposes no legal objection to such application and submits to the sound wisdom and discretion of the Honorable Members of the City Council.

We trust we have sufficiently addressed the concerns on the matter.
