When the hearing of the herein case was called on October 27, 2022, both parties failed to appear inspite of notice served. Hence, the hearing of the case was reset on November 24, 2022.

The Committee then required the complainant to submit his Judicial Affidavit Complaint and the respondent was also directed to submit his Judicial Affidavit upon receipt of the said complaint.

On January 19, 2023, when the hearing of the case was set, both parties were not present. However, the complainant, Datu Roberto Cabaring, has submitted to the Committee an Affidavit of Desistance signed and notarized by Private Counsel dated January 23, 2023. It stated among others that the complainant, upon thorough examination of the events and factual circumstances of the case, decided to forgo the prosecution and desist further testifying the case because he realized that the same arose out of misunderstanding and misapprehension of facts.

Likewise, the Office of National Commission on Indigenous Peoples of Misamis Oriental (NCIP MisOr) through Acting Provincial Officer, Atty. Jerie Marapao Ragsac, assisted in the resolution of the conflict between the Higaonon ICC of Nahiliran Dansolihon Ancestral Domain and the Barangay Local Government of Dansolihon, this city.

Thus, the complainant of herein case executed an Affidavit of Desistance to show good faith that the conflict between them has been resolved both parties further agreed that they opt to work together and maintain peace and harmony and to promote and protect the rights of every inhabitant in the community.

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, there is no reason to prolong the prosecution of the case. The committee feels that it cannot be more popish than the Pope.

THEREFORE, for the interest of promoting the spirit of unity, justice and peace of the parties and inhabitants thereof, this case be dismiss accordingly.

RESOLUTION

Before this Committee is a complaint filed against the Honorable Barangay Chairperson of Barangay Macasandig, this City, for alleged violation of laws above mentioned.

After parties have submitted their respective pleading, indicating thereto their respective contentions, and after deliberation of the members, the Committee now comes to resolve the issues at hand.

FACTUAL ANTECEDENCE

Version of the Complainant

Sometime in the year 2021, at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, complainant was worried because the household of his neighbor, Marianne Jeong, was receiving visitors and would have drinking spree until early morning or dawn and was distracted with his sleep every time. To this, worried and afraid that he might contract the said virus, he reprimanded them several time to stop what they are doing. Instead of heeding to this call, they took offense, disregarded plea and started mocking him. They then filed a case against him before the Barangay Hall to which personnel from the barangay went to my house and served the summons upon me and took pictures thereof without his consent. The night parties persisted from time to time so he decided to file a case against his neighbor before the barangay office. In one of the set hearings,



Respondent told the complainant discriminatory words to which he said: *“You foreigners must understand and accept Filipino culture and if you do not, you should go back to your own country because you do not belong here.”* No agreement was reached by the parties so complainant requested for a Certificate to File Action but the Respondent refused to issue despite being requested several times. Hence, this complaint against him.

Version of the Respondent

For his part, Respondent denied the allegations against him by the Complainant stating that it was not true that summons was served upon him by him and/or his staff with regard to a complaint filed by his neighbor, Marianne Jeong. Nor was it true that he took photos of his house without this consent. On the other hand, based on the records in the office, it was not also true that a formal complaint was filed by the complainant against his neighbor. What really transpired was merely a dialogue between the complainant and his neighbor assisted by him in the hope the matters will be settled amicably. Therefore, absent the filing of a formal complaint, his office cannot issue a Certificate to File Action. Lastly, he denied the discriminatory words he allegedly uttered during the said dialogue and as far as he can recall, more or less, these were the words he said to him: *“Mr. Totten you must understand that it is our practice or culture to have a dog that will serve as guard and their usual natural character will bark if there is any intruder. If you have a problem about this, you have the option to go back to your country of origin or you may stay but you must adjust to the local culture.”*

ISSUE

- i. Whether or not there is violation of the Katarungang Pambarangay;
- ii. Whether or not there is Racism and violation of Data Privacy Act;

RULING

Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, particularly Section 412 (a), provides that:

- (a) Pre-condition to Filing of Complaint in Court. - No complaint, petition, action, or proceeding involving any matter within the authority of the lupon shall be filed or instituted directly in court or any other government office for adjudication, unless there has been a confrontation between the parties before the lupon chairman or the



pangkat, and that no conciliation or settlement has been reached as certified by the lupon secretary or pangkat secretary as attested to by the lupon or pangkat chairman or unless the settlement has been repudiated by the parties thereto.

Furthermore, Supreme Court Circular No. 14-93 dated July 15, 1993 states that:

II. Under the provisions of R.A. 7160 on Katarungang Pambarangay conciliation, as implemented by the Katarungang Pambarangay Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Justice, the certification for filing a complaint in court or any government office shall be issued by Barangay authorities only upon compliance with the following requirements:

1. Issued by the Lupon Secretary and attested by the Lupon Chairman (Punong Barangay), certifying that a confrontation of the parties has taken place and that a conciliation settlement has been reached, but the same has been subsequently repudiated (Sec. 412, Revised Katarungang Pambarangay Law; Sec. 2[h], Rule III, Katarungang Pambarangay Rules);
2. Issued by the Pangkat Secretary and attested by the Pangkat Chairman, certifying that:
 - a. a confrontation of the parties took place but no conciliation/settlement has been reached (Sec. 4[f], Rule III, Katarungang Pambarangay Rules; or
 - b. that no personal confrontation took place before the Pangkat through no fault of the complainant (Sec. 4[f], Rule III, Katarungang Pambarangay Rules).

In the present case, Complainant alleged that he filed a complaint before the barangay office of Macasandig with regard to the violation of COVID-19 protocol committed his neighbor. However, this fact of filing was not supported by any proof to show that indeed he filed a complaint. Complainant did not attach any document relating to his complaint against his neighbor. On the other hand, Respondent refuted this fact by attaching in his affidavit as support thereto a Complaint Form as a means for invitation for a dialogue requested and signed by the Complainant and an Invitation for a Dialogue issued by the former, marked as Annexes "1" and "2". Such was not a formal complaint filed before the Lupon Tagapamayapa as a prerequisite for the issuance of the Certificate to File Action. With that being said, it was proper for the Respondent not to issue



a Certificate to File Action absent the filing of a formal complaint before the Lupon Tagapamayapa.

Furthermore, the declaration of policy of Republic Act No. 10173 otherwise known as Data Privacy Act of 2012 is to protect the fundamental human right of privacy, of communication while ensuring free flow of information to promote innovation and growth. The State recognizes the vital role of information and communications technology in nation-building and its inherent obligation to ensure that personal information in information and communications systems in the government and in the private sector are secured and protected. Complainant averred that his right to privacy in relation to the said law has been violated when the barangay personnel took pictures of his house when they served to him the summons without his consent. The Committee thinks otherwise.

As stated above, the Data Privacy Law protects privacy of communication and information. It has no relation as to one taking picture of someone's house. Complainant's statement that Mr. Closas took pictures of his house was not and cannot even be substantiated or proven. To add, assuming pictures were really taken, there was even no mention that what was taken in the alleged picture was inside the house or outside only.

Finally, as to the alleged racism. Racism, as defined under Merriam-Webster Dictionary, is a belief that race is a fundamental determinant of human traits and capacities and that racial differences produce an inherent superiority of a particular race or a behavior or attitudes that reflect and foster this belief racial discrimination or prejudice.

Complainant averred that Respondent showed discrimination when he said that he better leaves the country should he cannot adapt with our culture and tradition. This was denied by the latter and explained what he really said to him, as can be referred to from the facts. To this, the Committee finds no clear showing of deliberate intent on the part of the Respondent to discriminate the Complainant based on his nationality or race. However, Respondent must be cautioned to explain matters in a way that does not or cannot be interpreted to be discriminatory. He could have explained and make the Complainant understand better on the situation than saying those things to him. But nevertheless, the Committee still finds no cogent reason to sanction him administratively.






WHEREFORE, premises considered, the Committee finds no ground to sanction the Respondent, Honorable Barangay Chairperson Amor G. Sanchez, based on the allegations against him and hereby dismisses the case.



However, Respondent is cautioned and reminded to avoid using words or giving statements which can be interpreted otherwise by any party in his effort to settle cases before his Barangay.

RESOLUTION

This case was forwarded to City Council from the Office of the Ombudsman on July 25, 2022 and was then referred by the Honorable Vice Mayor to the Committee on Ethics and Blue Ribbon.

The case stemmed from the fact that Complainants were hired as workers of the LGU Barangay Balulang, this City, headed by herein Respondent, Barangay Chairman Edwin E. Micabani. The brief statement of the factual antecedence which led to the filing of this case are as follows:

Complainants' Version

The Complainants were members of the Barangay Tanod of Barangay Balulang hired on various dates.¹ On July 14, 2020, Respondent issued E.O. No. 2020-013 arbitrarily and without due process ordered all complainants to stop reporting for duty. Upon knowing of such issuance, Complainants wrote a letter to the Respondent inquiring from him as to the status and nature of their

employment, whether they were contractual or co-terminus and whether they can be dismissed from service without due process and concurrence of the Barangay Council. Parties then tried to settle the case amicably. However, contrary to what was agreed upon during the said meeting, they were assigned as Traffic Aide instead as Barangay Tanods. Discouraged, they stopped reporting for work. They were then called by the Respondent and informed them that it was a mistake and reinstated them as Tanods. On September 7, 2020, Respondent issued another memorandum to complainant Matela accusing him to have attended a meeting of the tanods wherein he was allegedly drunk, which, to him, was an act by the former on how he was really bent on dismissing him.

Respondent's Version

In his response, Respondent denied all the allegations against him brought out by the Complainants. He contended that the appointment of the Complainants, as members of the Barangay Tanod, refer to positions that are coterminous by nature, either as co-existent with the tenure of the appointing authority or at their pleasure. Furthermore, he contended that he engaged the services of the Complainants under a Job Order Contract that envisions a wide array of tasks and assignment and their term fixed for a duration of six (6) months.² According to him, no proof has been shown by the Complainants that their appointments designation was for the position of a Barangay Tanod and that he has no obligation to even notify them of the expiration of their respective Job Order Contracts. Lastly, the letter inquiry that was sent to him was not served and received by the Office of the Punong Barangay hence he was under no obligation to act upon it.

ISSUE

- i. Whether or not Respondent has the authority to dismiss the Complainants from service;
- ii. Whether or not Respondent is administratively liable;

RULING

The members of the Committee held a caucus primarily to discuss the factual antecedence surrounding this case and the evidences proffered by both parties. Having thoroughly discussed the issues at hand, the Committee hereby resolve to dismiss the case for lack of merit.

Abuse of authority, as defined by the Supreme Court in the case of *Office of the Ombudsman v. Caberoy*, cited in the case of *Chua vs. Cordova*³ and in a long line of cases, is a misdemeanor committed by a public officer, who under color of his office, wrongfully inflict upon any person any bodily harm, imprisonment or other injury. It is an act of cruelty, severity, or excessive use of authority.

The Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 2003-042 or the Guideline on Professionalizing the Barangay Tanods, wherein it stated that the term of appointment of barangay tanod member shall be for three (3) years which may be renewed unless earlier revoked for a valid cause, such as:

1. Violation of law (Revised Penal Code or Special Law)
2. Commission of a crime involving moral turpitude
3. Gross neglect of duty
4. For other causes that the BPOC may determine
5. Voluntary resignation

The above-mentioned circular also provides that appointments of barangay tanod must be done upon recommendation of the Barangay Peace and Order Council (BPOC).

As alleged by the Complainants, their services were hired by the Respondent and have been functioning as Tanods of Barangay Balulang. When the Executive Order issued by the Respondent came to their knowledge, wherein they were allegedly dismissed from service, they questioned his authority terminating them, as the said order was without basis and concurrence and approval of the Sangguniang Barangay, and that as Tanods, their term was fixed for a period of three (3) years. Therefore, he whimsically and despotically abused his authority and power as a Punong Barangay.

Analyzing such fact, if such was true that they were appointed as Barangay Tanod Members, then their appointments were not valid as there was no recommendation submitted by the BPOC to the office of the Respondent for his consideration and approval, as required by the memorandum circular. Contrarily, however, their appointments were that of a Job Order with a term of six (6) month, not specifically designating them to function primarily as Barangay Tanods. This is supported by the Job Order Contract issued to them which is attached in the Counter-Affidavit of the Respondent. Nowhere in the said contract can be gleaned that their appointment and function was that solely as a peacemaker or tanod.

On the other hand, Complainants have not satisfactorily shown and established that their appointments were specifically that of a Tanod. This claim was not supported by any document to bolster their claim. Had it been that case, then the memorandum circular cited should have been followed by the Respondent, which their appointment was not in consonance thereto. Their terms of service have automatically ended, by operation of law, upon the expiration of the period indicated in the job order contract. Hence, this simply follows that they were not arbitrarily removed from service by the Respondent contrary to their allegation.

The Respondent, being the Punong Barangay of Balulang, has the primary responsibility of ensuring the peace and order of his barangay. By this, since there was a need to augment personnel in different concerns, and since there was no recommendation submitted to him by the BPOC for hiring and appointment of tanods, he was constrained to hire the Complainants to augment the personnel needed in maintaining the peace and order of the barangay. Their designation and function in the barangay may be change anytime should the Respondent see the need thereto, as their appointment was through a Job Order Contract with no specific designation of work.

The hiring of Job Order Personnel is within the discretion of the Punong Barangay, subject, of course, to the availability of funds. To this, the continuity and renewal of their services rest upon the pleasure of the appointing power – the Respondent. The exercise of such discretion may not be questioned when there is legal basis to do so and absent any grave abuse in the exercise thereof.

WHEREFORE, finding no basis to the acts complained of, the Committee hereby resolves to dismiss the case for lack of merit.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

This refers to the request of the undersigned for a Resolution by your good office conforming to and confirming the termination of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the City Government of Cagayan de Oro and the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) for the Temporary Operation and Management by the City Government of Cagayan de Oro of the Cagayan de Oro Convention Center (CDOCC).

To recall, the said agreement was the subject of Ordinance No. 14321-2022. However, with the recent development that Premier Island Management Corporation (PIMC), a third-party proponent, has submitted an unsolicited proposal for the operation and management of the CDOCC, the purpose of the agreement has ceased.

With the advent of such partnership by TIEZA and the PIMC for the operation and management of the CDOCC, now officially known as the Aquilino Q. Pimentel Jr. International Convention Center, the city shall now be able to host more world class events, congresses and conventions, thereby boosting tourism in the city.

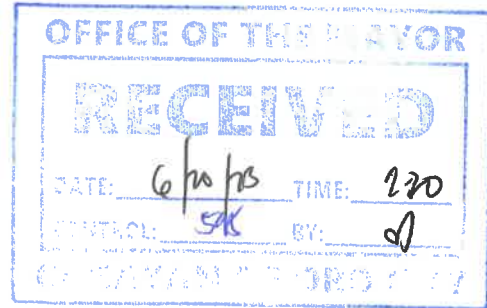

Greetings!

This is in reference to the letter dated 15 May 2023 by the Tourism and Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) regarding the termination of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the City Government and TIEZA for the interim operation of the Cagayan de Oro Convention Center (CDOCC).

In this connection, kindly be informed that this Office has thoroughly reviewed the above-mentioned document and the following observations and recommendations are respectfully forwarded:

1. The aforementioned Memorandum of Agreement was the subject of City Ordinance No. 14321-2022 dated 13 June 2022 entitled "*An Ordinance Authorizing the Honorable City Mayor Oscar S. Moreno to Enter into and Sign the Memorandum Of Agreement (MOA) with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA), to be Represented by its Chief Operating Officer, Mark T. Lapid, Covering the Collaboration of the Parties for the Temporary Operation and Management by the LGU-CDO of the Cagayan De Oro Convention Center (CDOCC), Under the Terms and Conditions Stipulated in the MOA Attached Hereto*" which authorized then City Mayor Oscar S. Moreno to enter into the said agreement on behalf of the City Government.
2. A perusal of the said approved MOA would show that the agreement only pertains to the temporary and interim operation and management of the CDOCC by the City Government of Cagayan de Oro until such time that a third-party proponent is formally selected to operate and manage the same.
3. In particular, it states that the agreement shall be terminated once a third-party operator is selected by TIEZA under either a Joint Venture Agreement, a Management Contract, a Lease/Concession Agreement, or any other applicable modality, or once the two-year period of cooperation is concluded, whichever comes earlier.

The pertinent provisions of the MOA relative thereto provide:

"ARTICLE VII. THIRD PARTY OPERATOR, JV PARTNER
TIEZA may operate and manage the CDOCC pursuant to its mandate, or **contract the services of a third-party operator** or enter into a partnership though a Joint Venture Agreement,

Management Contract, Lease/Concession Agreement, and other modalities in accordance with applicable laws, rules, regulations and internal issuances by TIEZA. If the modality chosen is a Joint Venture Agreement, the TIEZA Joint Venture Guidelines shall be adopted.

xxx

ARTICLE XI. DURATION

This Memorandum of Agreement, which is for the interim operation, management, and maintenance of the CDOCC, shall remain effective for two (2) years from the date of execution of this MOA or up to the award by TIEZA of the subject property to a winning proponent, management company, lessee, or any third-party operator, whichever comes earlier. This Agreement may be renewed at the option of TIEZA, the duration of which shall be agreed upon by the parties in the renewal contract, in case no joint venture partner, management company, lessee, or third-party operator has been engaged within this two-year period." (Emphasis and underscoring supplied)

4. Considering that the communication forwarded by TIEZA contains information that Premier Island Management Corporation (PIMC), a third-party proponent who is also the current operator of the TIEZA-owned Iloilo Convention Center, has submitted an unsolicited proposal to operate and manage the CDOCC in accordance with TIEZA Joint Venture Guidelines and given that there was no official turn-over of the facility to the City Government, the premise of the agreement has now ceased.

Accordingly, this Office finds that there is no basis to oppose the termination of the MOA as conveyed by TIEZA and recommends that the said request be forwarded to the august members of the City Council for the promulgation of an appropriate *Sanggunian Resolution* to conform to and confirm such termination.
