MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT:

This Memorandum of Agreement is made and entered into and executed by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE REGIONAL FIELD OFFICE 10**, a government agency created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with office address at Antonio Luna St. Cagayan de Oro City, represented by its Regional Executive Director, **CARLENE C. COLLADO, CPA**, herein referred to as the "**DA-RFO 10**";

-and-

The **CITY LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, a government agency created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at City Hall, Cagayan de Oro City represented herein by its City Mayor, **ROLANDO A. UY** duly authorized under Sangguniang Panlungsod to represent the LGU to enter into this agreement, herein referred to as the "**CLGU**";

-and-

The **RABBIT COLONY ASSOCIATION**, a duly recognized farmers association with office address located at Saint Andrew St. Zone 6, Capisonon, Kauswagan, Cagayan de Oro City, represented by its President, **JOSE ANDY G. ABELLA** hereinafter referred to as "**PROPONENT**".

-WITNESSETH-

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8435 otherwise known as *Agriculture and Fisheries Modernization Act of 1997 (AFMA)* sets out the Government's policies in the agriculture sector in attaining equitable distribution of opportunities, income, and wealth, expanding productivity and sustaining an increase in production of goods and services thereby raising the quality of life of the people;

WHEREAS, enhanced animal production is envisioned to narrow the gaps of the looming poverty incidence in the countryside through increased number of animal population and making available meat and milk as alternative means to address hunger, nutrition and livelihood problems;

WHEREAS, the **DA RFO 10** implements the Livestock Economic Enterprise Development (LEED) Program which aims to strengthen the contribution of the livestock and poultry sub-sectors in increasing the income of small-hold farmers through distribution of livestock and poultry modules as grant;

WHEREAS, the **DA RFO 10, PROPONENT** and the **CLGU** jointly pledge to extend full support and cooperation for the successful implementation of the project entitled "**RABBIT MULTIPLIER FARM**" under LEED Program which aims to establish farms that can produce quality poultry materials to be distributed as livelihood assistance to qualified recipients in the locality.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the above-premises and their mutual covenant herein set forth, the parties hereby agree on the following:

**SECTION I
PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND SOURCE OF FUND**

This Memorandum of Agreement covers the responsibilities of **DA-RFO 10**, the **CLGU** and **PROPONENT** in the implementation of the **“RABBIT MULTIPLIER FARM”** under Livestock Economic Enterprise Development Program in the City of Cagayan de Oro, to wit;

A. The Project Component

B. Project Objectives:

1. To contribute in the supply of safe and nutritious rabbit meat in Northern Mindanao;
2. To increase rabbit inventory in the region;
3. Provide additional source of food and income to the farmer beneficiaries;
4. To promote clustering and consolidation among small hold rabbit raisers;
5. Provide a venue for trainings, extension, and learning of farmers, students, and interested individuals; and
6. Support DA and other government agencies’ livestock-based livelihood programs by producing adequate and quality rabbit meat to supply industry need.

**SECTION III
DUTIES OF THE PARTIES**

A. The DA-REGIONAL FIELD OFFICE 10 shall:

1. Evaluate and validate the proposed project of the LGU and the PROPONENT;
2. Conduct the procurement activities in accordance with RA 9184;
3. Turnover the project to the CLGU and conduct on-site inspection of the goods and infra upon the delivery or its completion;
4. Require the CLGU and PROPONENT to submit monthly report of accomplishment that includes but not limited to the farm records of operations to DA-RFO 10 after the completion of the delivery and establishment of all the components of the project;
5. Conduct periodic monitoring and evaluation of the project to ascertain the progress/accomplishment of the project, proper utilization and compliance with the provisions in this agreement;

6. Issue Journey Entry Voucher (JEV) or Property Transfer Report for the transfer of the delivered goods and other interventions as prescribed under existing laws;
7. Have the administrative right to intervene and institute corrective measures for the purpose of preserving the objectives of the project.

B. The CLGU shall:

1. Acknowledge receipt of the project and turnover to the intended recipient;
2. Orient and assist the recipient in the operations, maintenance and implementing guidelines of the project;
3. Supervise the project in accordance with its intended use;
4. Submit required report of the project;
5. Submit geotagged/digital photos/videos to document the project from pre to post-implementation;
6. Provide technical assistance to the proponent such as insuring the animals to PCIC, implement animal health program and management to ensure the welfare of the animals delivered; and
7. Strictly abide and follow the provision, terms and conditions of the agreement as stipulated in the MOA.

C. The RABBIT COLONY ASSOCIATION shall:

1. Submit to DA RFO-10 the project proposal and Letter of Intent duly endorsed by the CLGU and other documentary requirements;
2. Secure all legal documents as needed by the project and shall have full accountability to any problem or issue arising out of it;
3. Provide adequate and sufficient lot or land, that is owned by the association, and compliant to the existing zoning ordinances and other existing laws, rules and regulation to be used for the project;
4. Shoulder the cost beyond the subsidy of DA-RFO 10 such as feeds, drugs and biologics and other maintenance expense for the project;
5. Acknowledge the receipt of the project as proponent and shall be responsible in shouldering the operating/maintenance cost;
6. Ensure that policies and guidelines are duly complied with in consonance with DA guidelines;
7. Insure all animals to the Philippine Crop Insurance Corporation (PCIC); and
8. Submit in writing quarterly progress report as to the operations of the project, including but not limited to the production record.

SECTION III GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. DA-RFO 10 shall transfer the assets at cost to the CLGU implementing unit after final acceptance of the project and all required documents are submitted. Accordingly, such assets shall be taken up in the books of the recipient-LGU if Capital Outlay;
2. The parties hereto guarantee to carry out the project using generally accepted professional and technical standards, and in accordance with the attached schedules and appropriate Procurement Procedures of R.A. 9184-Government Procurement Reform Act;
3. Pursuant to the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof shall be subject to arbitration in accordance with the current PDRCI (Philippine Dispute Resolution Center Inc.) Arbitration Rules; provided, that the venue of the arbitration shall be held solely and exclusively in Cagayan de Oro City;
4. The Parties, by mutual written consent, may modify or amend any provision in this MOA;
5. DA RFO 10 has the right to seize the project when:
 - a. Not properly maintained and utilized for one (1) year;
 - b. Not settling any problem/s arising from the use of equipment/machinery for a period of one (1) year;
 - c. There is a written complaint, coming from the residents nearby and government unit/s and any sanction arising from continued usage; and
 - d. Not complying with the Memorandum of Agreement.
6. Penalties and Sanctions. In case of project suspension, cancellation or termination, the existing government accounting and auditing rules prevail.

**SECTION IV
EFFECTIVITY AND DURATION**

This agreement shall take effect upon its signing hereof of the parties concerned and shall terminate upon the satisfactory compliance of the terms and conditions and upon issuance of JEV or PTR to the CLGU.

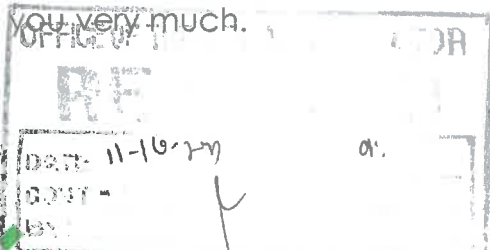



WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines mandates the protection and advancement of the right of Filipino People to a healthful and balanced ecology, provides for the promotion of social justice, guarantees the right of the people and their organization to reasonable participation at all levels of social, political and economic decision making.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 known as the Local Government Code (Code) directs and authorized local government to establish, maintain, preserve and conserve communal forest and watersheds.

WHEREAS, Executive Order 192 mandate the DENR as primary government agency responsible for the conservation, management and protection, and proper use and sustainable development of the country's environmental and natural resources and the LGUs, who have likewise the responsibility for sustainable management and development of forest resources and watersheds within their territories, mutually commit themselves to pursue such objectives under a multiple and sustainable use, demand driven and participation, development approach.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004 (Republic Act No. 9275) aims to protect the country's water bodies from pollution from land-based sources (industries and commercial establishments, agriculture and community/household activities). The law also provides for a comprehensive and integrated strategy to prevent and minimize pollution through a multi-sectoral and participatory approach involving all the stakeholders;

WHEREAS, the Republic Act (RA) 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, provides the necessary policy framework, institutional mechanisms and mandates the local government unites (LGUs) to achieve 25% waste reduction through establishing an integrated solid waste management plans based on 3Rs (reduce, reuse and recycling). The need to emphasize that per RA 9003, open dump sites shall not be allowed as final disposal sites. If an open dump site is existing within the city or municipality, the plan shall make provisions for its closure or eventual phase out within the period specified under the framework and pursuant to the provisions under Sec. 37 of this Act. As an alternative, sanitary landfill site shall be developed and operated as a final disposal site for solid and, eventually, residual wastes of a municipality or city or a cluster of municipalities and/or cities. Sanitary landfill shall be designed and operated in accordance with the guidelines set under Secs. 40 and 41 of this Act;

WHEREAS, the role of non-government, people's and civic organizations in local governance and administration in the area of environmental protection and management is promoted and mandated in the Local Government Code.

WHEREAS, the Cabinet Cluster on Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation Resolution No. 2012-001 states that the Department of Public Works and Highways has declared that their dredging and desilting efforts and resources are focused on the eighteen (18) major river basins, namely, Cagayan, Mindanao, Agusan, Pampanga, Agno, Abra,

Pasig-Marikina-Laguna, Bicol, Abulug, Tagum-Libuganon, Ilog-Hilabangan, Panay, Tagoloan, Agus, Davao, Cagayan de Oro, Jalaur and Buayan-Malungon. Provided further that the member-clusters have agreed to support the DPWH efforts by focusing their programs and projects in these 18 major river basins;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9996 of the Mindanao Development Authority Act of 2010, created the Mindanao Development Authority (MinDA), which is tasked to establish an effective institutional mechanism to address the need for a coordinated and integrated approach in the formulation and integration of a Mindanao-wide, inter-regional development plans, programs and projects;

WHEREAS, MinDA Board Resolution No. 18, Series of 2011 states to take the lead in integrating the efforts of key partners and stakeholders in rehabilitating, developing and managing Mindanao's river basins and watersheds through MindaNOW: Nurturing Our Waters Program, which seeks to integrate interventions (including the establishment of river basin/watershed management mechanisms) designed to facilitate sustainable economic development and environmental integrity, adopting the ridge-to-reef approach to planning and policy development;

WHEREAS, the management of river basin and watersheds should achieve the goals of (1) sustainable multiple use of natural resources within the river basin and watersheds in a manner that is environmentally sound, economically viable and socially acceptable; and (2) the prevention of further watershed degradation and the restoration of the productive and protective function of currently degraded river basin and watersheds.

WHEREAS, the spiritual role of Religious Group in the protection, rehabilitation and management of the Cagayan de Oro River Basin is also recognized;

WHEREAS, the role of the Academe in the scientific and research activities for the protection, rehabilitation and management of Cagayan de Oro River Basin is indispensable in prompting science and technology;

WHEREAS, the role of the Security Group is important in maintaining the peace and order condition within and adjacent to the River Basin for its protection, rehabilitation and management;

WHEREAS, effective and purposive collaboration and coordination of development initiatives among all stakeholders in a watershed including Local Government Units, National Government Agencies, Non-Government Organizations, People's Organizations, and the Private Sector, will hasten and facilitate the achievement of these goals.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, herein parties commit to bind themselves and agree as follows:

Section 1. Creation/Strengthening and Institutionalization of the Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council - To carry out the objectives outlined of managing the Cagayan de Oro River Basin, the Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council is hereby created/strengthened and institutionalized.

Section 2A. Role and Function of the Council – The Council shall serve as a decision and implementing body that:

1. Adopt the Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council Technical Working Groups (CDORBMC TWGs) for the updating of Integrated River Basin Management and Development Master Plan for Cagayan de Oro River Basin (IRBMDMP-CDORB) to include, among others, protection, restoration and rehabilitation, water quality monitoring and delineation of buffer zone;
2. Approve the updated IRBMDMP-CDORB endorsed by the TWGs;
3. Participate in the formulation of policies that support inter-agency coordination, collaboration, cooperation, partnership and convergence, and complementation of natural resources benefits and cost sharing, and resources planning and program implementation;
4. Contribute in the management of the resources and development activities stipulated under the approved IRBMDMP-CDORB;
5. Review existing policies governing the river basin or specific watershed and recommend appropriate revisions/amendments to concerned agencies, if necessary;
6. Join in the monitoring of the activities, such as rehabilitation and protection, among others, within the river basin or particular watershed;
7. Ensure enforcement of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) laws, rules and regulations in coordination with DENR and concern agencies;
8. Endorse persons for the deputation by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Office (DENR);
9. Facilitate the resolution of problems and conflicts that may occur within the river basin or particular watershed, in coordination with concerned agencies;
10. Support and participate in activities that promote and establish awareness on watershed management and resource use;
11. Formulate internal rules, regulations and guidelines with regards to the conduct and principles for the proper functioning of the Council;
12. Develop a Manual of Operations for the guidance of the Council;
13. Coordinate with existing watershed management bodies present within the river basin (Protected Area Management Board, Watershed Quality Management Area Governing Board etc.) to ensure that river basin/watershed programs, projects and activities of the Council complement with that of other watershed management bodies; and
14. Endorse to Regional Development Council-X the updated IRBMDMP-CDORB for adoption.

Section 2B. Commitment of the Council Members

A. NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES (NGAs) and GOVERNMENT-OWNED and CONTROL CORPORATIONS

DENR-X

1. Act as a lead agency in the protection, development, rehabilitation, utilization, and management of the projects within the Cagayan de Oro River Basin;
2. Coordinate with the LGUs, NGAs, NGOs, Academe, Religious Groups and other stakeholders in the continuous planning, implementation, monitoring and

evaluation of projects and other activities geared toward the sustainable development of Cagayan de Oro River Basin;

3. Facilitate in the filing of criminal charges against violators of environmental and forestry laws within the River Basin;
4. Facilitate the creation/strengthening of the Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council (CDORBMC) and allocate funds for its operationalization;
5. Assist in the development of Manual of Operations for the guidance of the Council; and
6. Designate Regional River Basin Focal and Alternate Focal Persons to compose the Secretariat of CDORBMC.

NEDA-X

1. Provide technical assistance in regional and urban development planning, preparation and updating of Provincial Development Physical Framework Plans (PDPFP) and Comprehensive Land Use Plans (CLUPs) of highly urbanized cities;
2. Review/evaluate proposed programs and projects that seek endorsement by the Regional Development Council and approval of the Investment Coordinating Committee; and
3. Promote socio-economic development programs/projects.

MinDA

1. Provide oversight and/or advisory role to the Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council;
2. Provide technical assistance to the Council; and
3. Assist in the fund mobilization and generation for the identified programs and projects as may be identified in the Climate Change - Responsive IRBMDMP-CDORB.

OTHER NGAs

Support the operation and strengthening of Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council through the implementation of programs and projects geared towards the effective management and protection of the Cagayan de Oro River Basin through any of the following activities:

1. Assist and coordinate with major stakeholders in the identification and development of resettlement sites;
2. Assist in the implementation of reforestation project and river bank protection activities;
3. Provide technical assistance to LGUs in the preparation and updating of City and Municipal Comprehensive Land Use Plans (CLUPs), Comprehensive

Development Plans (CDPs); Provincial Development Physical Framework Plan (PDPFP);

4. Harmonize policies, gaps, overlaps and conflicts (e.g. DENR, NCIP, DAR, etc.);
5. Promote socio-economic programs/projects; and
6. Promote literacy programs especially in IP communities.

B. LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS

1. Provide technical assistance in the formulation/updating of Barangay Watershed Management Planning;
2. Assist in the rehabilitation of all river tributaries within the Cagayan de Oro River Basin;
3. Formulate supporting policies and ordinances relative to the sustainable management of Cagayan de Oro River Basin;
4. Assist in the enforcement of environmental and forestry laws in coordination with other stakeholders;
5. The city and municipal governments shall integrate the Barangay Watershed Management Plan to the Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP); and
6. Whenever necessary and applicable, the Barangay Watershed Management Plan as integrated in the Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) shall be integrated or given consideration in the Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plan (PDPFP).

C. NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS

1. Assist in the capacity building of communities through research, trainings, facilitation, information sharing, livelihood projects implementation, advocacy programs and fund sourcing; and
2. Advocate active protection and preservation of all resources within Cagayan de Oro River Basin.

D. RELIGIOUS GROUP

1. Form, organize and mobilize the religious sectors in collaborating with other stakeholders in the Management and Protection of Cagayan de Oro River Basin;
2. Conduct continuous IEC activities through tri-media and news media;
3. Promote integral ecological activities based on the sound theology of creation;
4. Support the sustainable agriculture and appropriate eco-friendly technology; and
5. Strongly encourage both the religious groups and stakeholders to celebrate meaningfully the liturgical Season of Creation, the Father Nery Satur Day, the annual Earth Day celebration and other significant ecological events.

E. SECURITY GROUP

PNP

1. Assist in the enforcement of laws and policies for the protection of Cagayan de Oro River Basin.

AFP

1. Intensify patrol in identified hot spot areas in coordination with DENR and other concerned agencies within the Area of Responsibility and provided availability of personnel.

F. CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATION (ACADEME)

1. Initiate the conduct of Research and Development (R and D) projects/activities related to Cagayan de Oro River Basin in coordination with the concerned agencies;
2. Initiate/assist in the conduct of Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaign;
3. Initiate community engagement;
4. Assist in designing a resource utilization fee scheme and the implementing mechanism; and
5. Integrate in the localization and contextualization of the curriculum implemented by schools located within and/or adjacent to the CDORB the principles behind the CDORBMC and the affirmative actions implemented by its members

G. BUSINESS SECTOR

1. Extend assistance to the communities using the allocated funds under its Corporate Social Responsibilities (CSRs).

H. PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS/ INDIGENOUS PEOPLE'S

ORGANIZATION

1. Help facilitate the concept of river basin management to fellow IPs and farmers organization;
2. Support and participate the implementation of projects for the preservation of indigenous knowledge system and practices;
3. Protect, develop and conserve the various resources within the river basin; and
4. Assist in the apprehension of any environmental violators within the river basin.

Section 3. Composition of the Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council – the Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council shall be composed of the Local Chief Executives, Heads of Offices of the National Government Agencies, Social/Peoples Organizations, etc of all members to this agreement (*see attached organizational structure*).

Section 4. Term of Office – The position of the Chairperson shall have a term of two (2) years. The DENR shall hold the Co-Chairpersonship of the Cagayan de Oro River Basin Management Council. In the case of elective LGU officials, whether Chairperson or members of the Council, the term of Office shall be co-terminus to his/her position. Once the term of Office of the incumbent expires, the next official shall assume the position.

Section 5. Effectivity. This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon signing of the members herein.



- h. Special Cockfight – A cockfight held on days other than Sundays and Legal Holidays for special purposes.**
- i. Special Permit – A permit secured from the Commission for International Derby or the City Mayor for local derby, as the case may be, to hold cockfighting on days other than Sundays and Legal Holidays.**

x X x

SECTION 738. *Special cockfighting.*- Special cockfighting shall likewise be allowed on special and legal holidays from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. upon prior application and approval of the City Council through an ordinance for the purpose and the corresponding permit issued by the City Mayor, except on the days not allowed by law, to wit:

1. New Year's Day (January 1)
2. Maundy Thursday and Good Friday
3. Philippine Independence Day
4. All Saint's Day (November 1)
5. Christmas Day (December 25)
6. Election/Referendum Day

7. On the occasion of agricultural, commercial or industrial fairs, carnival or exposition within the month of the City fiesta.

SECTION 739. *Derby.*- **Derby shall be allowed once a month and for a duration not exceeding two days in each duly licensed cockpit with an interval of at least six (6) days. One additional derby for a duration not exceeding two days may be allowed on the occasion of the City or Barangay Fiesta where the cockpit is located and also during the Christmas Season.** Such additional Derbys. may not be covered by the 6-day interval. In all cases, shall derby be allowed only upon prior approval of the City Council through an ordinance for the purpose and the corresponding permit issued by the City Mayor, except on the days not allowed by law. The filing of applications for derby with the Sanggunian Panlungsod shall be made at least thirty (30) days before the holding of the same. *[AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 5347-96; ORDINANCE NO. 8832-2003]*

On the account of the foregoing, provided that the above provision of law is duly complied with, then this office opposes no legal objection to such application and submits to the sound wisdom and discretion of the Honorable Members of the City Council.

We trust we have sufficiently addressed the concerns on the matter.
