AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5133-95, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AND OTHER INTOXICATING BEVERAGES IN ALL PUBLIC PLAZAS, PARKS, ROADS, SIDEWALKS AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY AND ITS BARANGAYS EXCEPT ON OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF", IN THE MANNER PROVIDED FOR HEREIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the 20th City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) of Cagayan de Oro in session that:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5133-95, entitled: "*An Ordinance Prohibiting the Drinking of Alcoholic Liquor and Other Intoxicating Beverages in All Public Plazas, Parks, Roads, Sidewalks and Alleys of the City and Its Barangays Except on Official Functions and Providing Penalty for Violation Thereof*", is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

"ORDINANCE NO. 5133-95

'AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AND OTHER INTOXICATING BEVERAGES IN ALL PUBLIC ACCESS PROPERTIES IN THE CITY OF CAGAYAN DE ORO EXCEPT ON OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS, PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

'WHEREAS, Section 458, paragraph (1) (v) of RA 7160 states that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall "Enact ordinances intended to prevent, suppress and impose appropriate penalties for habitual drunkenness in public places...";

'WHEREAS, it has been observed that public plazas, parks, roads, sidewalks and alleys of the City including those of its barangays are being used as venue for liquor drinking sessions and sprees which are not only unsightly and offensive against public decency but, in some cases, would result to altercations;

'NOW, THEREFORE

'**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) of the City of Cagayan de Oro in session assembled that:

'**SECTION 1. *Definition of Terms*** - For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms shall be construed to mean:

- '(a) ***Alcoholic Liquor*** shall be construed to refer to spirituous or intoxicating liquors of any kind, and includes whiskey, ale, beer, brandy, gin, rum, champagne, caña rum, Panay rum, basi, tuba, mallorca, or any other beverages liable to produce intoxication.
- '(b) ***Public Access Properties*** shall mean places that are accessible or open to the public or places for collective use, regardless of ownership or right of access, such as schools, government facilities, church grounds, health/hospital compounds, transportation terminals, waiting sheds/areas, public plazas, parks, roads, alleys, sidewalks, walkways, rotundas, entrance ways, parking lots or any private parking lots open to public use (regardless if the private parking lot establishment is open or close for business), bridges, skyways, overpasses, underpasses and flyovers.

'**SECTION 2. *Prohibition*** - It shall be unlawful for any person to drink alcoholic liquor and other intoxicating beverages upon any and all public access properties within the City and its barangays except on official functions or occasions duly authorized, sanctioned or approved by the Barangay Council concerned or the City Council and/or covered by a permit issued therefor by the Office of the Punong Barangay or the City Mayor.



‘In cases of special occasions like anniversary, birthday or other milestone celebrations, wedding, funeral wake/vigil, fiesta or promotional/advertising events to be held on public access properties that are privately-owned, the owner/proprietor, manager, administrator or person in-charge thereof shall secure a permit for the purpose from the concerned Punong Barangay or the City Mayor.

‘SECTION 3. **Penalty** - Any person found violating the provision of this Ordinance shall suffer the following penalties:

- ‘a) For the first offense – administrative fine of ₱3,000.00;
- ‘b) For the second offense – administrative fine of ₱4,000.00;
- ‘c) For the third and subsequent offenses – administrative fine of ₱5,000.00 and/or imprisonment of six (6) months at the discretion of the court;

‘Provided, that any person caught or apprehended for violation of this Ordinance by any apprehending officer, police officer or deputized enforcer shall be issued an Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR) evidencing the commission of such offense. The offender shall, within seventy-two (72) hours from the date of apprehension and issuance of the OVR, pay and settle the administrative fine at the Office of the City Treasurer, otherwise the case shall be prosecuted against him/her.

‘SECTION 4. **Suppletory Clause** – The pertinent provisions of Ordinance No. 12139-2011, entitled: An Ordinance Prescribing the Issuance of Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR) or Citation Ticket to Violators or Offenders of Cagayan de Oro City Ordinances, Providing Guidelines Therefor and For Other Purposes, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) shall apply in a suppletory manner hereof.

‘SECTION 5. **Repeal Clause** - All executive orders, rules and regulations and other issuances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby revoked, amended, or modified accordingly.

‘SECTION 6. **Severability** – If any provision or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, *ultra vires*, or invalid, such decision shall not affect or impair the validity of any of the remaining provisions or parts of this Ordinance.

‘x-x-x”

SECTION 2. Effectivity - This ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation and posting in conspicuous public places in the City.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement is entered into and executed by and between:

The **BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY-CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY JAIL-MALE DORMITORY**, with office address at F. Delima St., Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, herein represented by its Regional Director, **JCSUPT CESAR M LANGAWIN** hereinafter referred to as "**First Party**";

THE CITY GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO, a Local Government Unit established and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines duly represented herein by the City Mayor, **HON. ROLANDO A. UY**, with office address at Executive Building, City Hall, City Mayor`s Office, hereafter referred to us LGU, Cagayan de Oro through the City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office (CLENRO) as the "**Second Party**";

The **BARANGAY COUNCIL BAIKINGON** represented by its **Brgy. Captain NATHAN PABELEC YAÑEZ** with office address at Brgy. Baikington, Cagayan de Oro City, herein after referred to as the "**Third Party**";

-and-

The **PATINGTINGAN INTEGRATED SOCIAL FORESTRY FARMERS ASSOCIATION (PISFFA)**, a PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATION represented by its **President, Ms Adela Yana** with office address at Brgy. Baikington, Cagayan de Oro City, herein after referred to as the "**Fourth Party**";

WITNESSETH that:

WHEREAS, Section 16, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and advance the right of the Filipino people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro through the City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office (CLENRO) is mandated to share with the national government, particularly the responsibility on sustainable management and development of the environment and natural resources within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Local Government of Cagayan de Oro City through the City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office (CLENRO) to seek cooperation, involvement and participation of all the sectors of the society to ensure the fulfillment of its mandate;

WHEREAS, BJMP-CDOCJ-MD has expressed its interest to adopt a National Greening Program (NG) site and undertake tree planting and maintenance and protection activities in the area hereunder described:

Location: (Iponan Riverbank) Baikington, Cagayan de Oro City
Area/Linear: 2 kilometers (Timberland)
Number of Seedlings: 200 Bamboo and 200 Forest Trees

WHEREAS, in order to ensure the survival of the planting materials that will be provided by the **Second Party**, the planting sites should be properly prepared;

WHEREAS, the **Third and Fourth Party** supports efforts to rehabilitate, conserve and protect the area through reforestation initiatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and of the obligations and undertaking hereinafter set forth, the "**First, Second, Third and Fourth Party**" hereby agree on the following terms and conditions:

ARTICLE I

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES:

Section 1: The First Party shall:

1. Ensure that the planting location is a suitable site for greening and is within the Region-X.
2. Provide gardening tools and accessories for site preparation, such as strip brushing, weeding, soil leveling, and hole digging;
3. Plant properly the seedlings/saplings delivered in accordance with the appropriate planting standards;
4. Conduct **Maintenance & Protection (M&P)** activities every month during the first year of the effectivity of the MOA and quarterly during the second and third year. The M&P activities include weeding, vine removal, patrolling, and watering during dry months.
5. Submit to the Regional National Greening Program Coordinator the report and photo/video documentation taken, before, during, and after planting;
6. Conduct quarterly monitoring of the planted seedling to determine the survival rate and submit a report regarding the same; and
7. Conduct replanting at the onset of the rainy season for the second and third year as part of M&P activities of the established plantation, in case the survival rate is below 75%.

Section 2: The Second Party shall:

1. Assess the planting site and recommend appropriate species of seedling/saplings available in the nursery;
2. Provide appropriate planting materials suitable to the planting sites;
3. Provide Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) materials to aid in informing the public of the existence and sustainability of the project;

4. Provide technical assistance as often as necessary in the proper planting, caring, maintenance, and protection of the planted seedlings;

Section 3: The Third Party shall:

1. Allow the **First Party** to adopt an area with two (2) kilometers of land at Baikingon, Cagayan de Oro City (Iponan Riverbank) for Tree Growing and Rehabilitation activities;
2. Assist the **First Party** in the preparation of the tree growing site and installation of Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) materials;
3. Protect, maintain and care for the plantation area;
4. Coordinate with the Second Party if they want to utilize any of the grown trees.

Section 4: The Fourth Party shall:

1. Assist the **First and Second Party** as often as necessary in the proper planting, caring, maintenance, and protection of the planted seedlings;
2. Assist the **First and Second Party** in the preparation of the tree growing site and installation of Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) materials;
3. Protect, maintain and care for the plantation area;
4. Coordinate with the Second Party if they want to utilize any of the grown trees.

ARTICLE II

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SECTION 1. The parties agree to comply with the provisions of the existing Anti-Bribery and Corruption Policies and Laws of the Philippines.

SECTION 2. The parties agree that any conflict, controversies, issues, or disputes which may arise within or during the effectiveness of this agreement shall, in their best effort, try to settle the same among themselves.

In case of failure to come to an amicable settlement, all disputes between the parties arising from the interpretation or application of this Agreement shall be settled through Chapter 14 Book IV of Executive Order No. 292 dated July 25, 1987.

However, in the event that any legal action shall arise from this Agreement, the regular court or competent quasi-judicial bodies of Cagayan de Oro City shall have the exclusive jurisdiction over any disputes and/or claims arising thereto.

SECTION 3. This agreement shall take effect for a period of three (3) years upon signing thereof by **First, Second, Third and Fourth Party** unless earlier terminated by mutual agreement of the parties.

SECTION 4: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to imply a joint venture, partnership, or principal-agent relationship between the PARTIES, and none of the PARTIES shall have the right, power or authority to obligate or bind the other in any manner whatsoever, except as otherwise agreed in writing.

Further, this Agreement does not create an employer-employee relationship between the PARTIES, their employees, agents or sub-contractors.

SECTION 5: None of the PARTIES shall assign or delegate this Agreement or any rights, duties, or obligations hereunder to any other person and/or entity without prior express written approval of the PARTIES.

SECTION 6: If any provision of this agreement is declared invalid or unenforceable, such provision shall be deemed modified to the extent necessary and possible to render. It valid and enforceable. In any event, the unenforceability or invalidity of any provision shall not affect any other provision of this Agreement, and this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect, and be construed and enforced, as if such provision had not been included, or had been modified as above provided, as the case may be.

Thus, should the City Government find the terms and conditions of the *Memorandum of Agreement* amenable and for the best interests of the City Government, and assuming that the City can fully comply with it through CLENRO, then this Office recommends that such be duly forwarded to the Honorable Members of the City Council for their favorable consideration, with a request for an Ordinance authorizing the City Mayor to enter into and sign the same pursuant to Sec. 455 (1) (vi) of the Local Government Code.

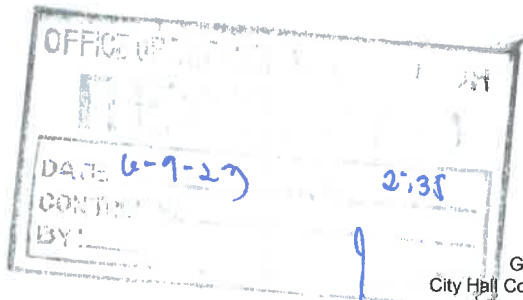

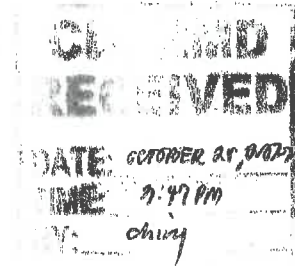

Greetings!



This pertains to the *Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the City Government of Cagayan de Oro, represented by City Mayor Rolando A. Uy and the Department of Science and Technology - Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (DOST - PHIVOLCS), represented by its DOST Undersecretary and Officer-in-Charge of PHIVOLCS, Dr. Teresito C. Bacolcol, relative to its collaboration in the Installation of Intensity Meter within the premises of the City Hall Building, for important data gathering that could be used for near-real time evaluation of impacts of earthquake events.*

In this connection, kindly be informed that this Office has thoroughly reviewed the above-mentioned MOA, finding the application legally sound and posing no legal objection to the same, save for the following recommendations/observations:

1. As to the parties in the MOA, this Office highly recommends that it be amended in line with the format suggested below, considering that Cagayan de Oro City is a highly urbanized city which is independent of Misamis Oriental,¹ *to wit:*

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, a local government unit organized and existing by virtue of its Charter under Republic Act No. 521 and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, with office address at City Hall, Cagayan de Oro City, duly represented herein by its Local Chief Executive, **HON. ROLANDO A. UY**, hereinafter referred to as the "**LGU CDO**";

¹ R.A. No. 7160, Section 22. Provincial Relations with Component Cities and Municipalities. - The province, through the governor, shall ensure that every component city and municipality within its territorial jurisdiction acts within the scope of its prescribed powers and functions. **Highly urbanized cities and independent component cities shall be independent of the province.**" (Emphasis supplied)

2. In addition, it is also proposed that two (2) **ACKNOWLEDGMENT** portions be prepared at the back portion of the MOU, considering that the representative of DAP is from Manila, hence the notarization for his acknowledgment will also be in Manila.

Moreover, it is also highly suggested that one of the witnesses for the MOU be the head of the implementing office, City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Department, Mr. Nick A. Jabagat.

3. Kindly refer to the herein-attached MOA for some corrections and/or suggestions involving minor typographical and clerical errors.

Thus, should the City Government find the terms and conditions in the *Memorandum of Agreement* amenable and for the best interests of the City Government, and assuming that the City can fully comply with it, thru the City Disaster Risk and Management Department, then this Office recommends that the *Memorandum of Agreement* be duly forwarded to the Honorable Members of the City Council for their favorable consideration, with a request for an Ordinance authorizing the City Mayor to enter into and sign the same, pursuant to Sec. 455 (1) (vi)² of the Local Government Code.

Garcia Avenue, UP Campus, Diliman, Quezon City, represented in this agreement by **DR TERESITO C. BACOLCOL** in his capability as the Undersecretary of DOST and Officer-in-Charge of PHIVOLCS, hereinafter referred to as "**DOST-PHIVOLCS.**"

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, DOST-PHIVOLCS is the Philippine government agency mandated to avert disasters arising from geotectonic processes (earthquakes, and related geotectonic phenomena such as faulting, landslides and tsunami) and mitigate risks arising there from through formulation of up-to-date comprehensive disaster preparedness and loss reduction action plans;

WHEREAS, DOST-PHIVOLCS, aims to establish, operate and maintain a network of Intensity Meters strategically located in key areas of the country in order to record and made available online on near-real time basis, information on the severity of ground shaking due to various earthquake events;

WHEREAS, the CITY, aware of the needs of DOST-PHIVOLCS to establish strategically located Intensity Meters in key areas of the country, aims to collaborate with DOST-PHIVOLCS to gather these very important data that could be used for near-real time evaluation of impacts of earthquakes events;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and their mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agreed as follows:

A. Undertaking by CITY:

1. That the CITY, in consideration of the benefits that Intensity Meters can provide to Local Government Units in the CITY of CAGAYAN DE ORO, hereby agrees to allow DOST-PHIVOLCS to install Intensity Meter inside the premises of the City Hall Building, free of all costs for the occupation of the premises, the electrical consumption and internet connection;
2. That the CITY, shall allow DOST-PHIVOLCS to gain access to the Intensity Meter during its regular visits for maintenance and data downloading;
3. That the CITY in coordination with DOST-PHIVOLCS shall ensure the safety and security of the equipment at all times;
4. That the equipment shall not be moved to another place unless agreed upon by both parties;

5. In case of any problem arising related to the functioning of the equipment, the CITY shall inform DOST-PHIVOLCS immediately. Only DOST-PHIVOLCS personnel are allowed to check the instrument and decide on whatever proper action to be taken concerning said instruments;
6. The CITY further agrees to properly quote DOST-PHIVOLCS in any documentation or project that used such data and/or information;

B. Undertaking of PHIVOLCS:

1. That DOST-PHIVOLCS will ensure that the information of Earthquake Intensity will be available on the web portal and can be accessed by the CITY.
2. Assurance that the equipment is safe to human and environment.
3. Shall seek approval of the CITY about any new installation especially those that could be hazardous to life and environment.
4. If necessary, waveform data of earthquake events can be provided to the CITY, as well as a copy of any work or publication that used the data from said equipment that will be used for the development and zoning of the CITY.
5. DOST-PHIVOLCS shall shoulder the expenses necessary for the installation of the instrument.

C. Effectivity and Termination

The terms of this agreement shall be effective and binding upon signing of all parties and shall remain effective until both parties agree to terminate this agreement with sufficient notice to each party.

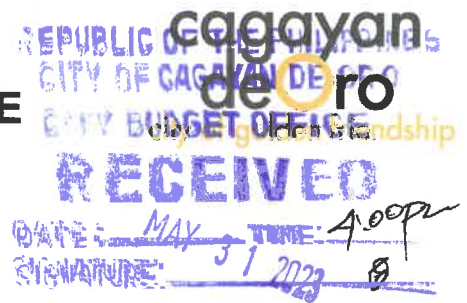
