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#### **ORDINANCE NO. 14726-2024**

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING THE PUROK SYSTEM IN THE DELIVERY OF DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS IN EVERY BARANGAY OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Ownereas, under the local governance system, puroks are sub-units of the barangay, which is the basic political unit of the government. Traditionally, puroks are considered geographical groupings of households within the barangays for the delivery of basic government services and to promote Bayanihan in the community;

**O'Phoreas**, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro City intends to transform the "Purok" as a powerful tool for community mobilization and action, through institutionalization of a purok development system in every barangay of the city to further improve the delivery of services to the constituents;

**Complete** Section 384 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides the role of the barangay to serve as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans, programs, projects, and activities in the community and a forum wherein the collective views of the people may be expressed, crystallized and considered, and where disputes may be amicably settled;

**O'Phoreas**, the establishment of Purok is provided for in Paragraph (16), Section 391 of RA 7160, states that the "Sangguniang Barangay can provide for the organization of Community Brigades, Barangay Tanod, or Community Service Units as may be necessary";

#### **NOW, THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the  $20^{th}$  City Council (Sangguniang Panlungsod) of Cagayan de Oro in session that:

#### ARTICLE I - TITLE AND DECLARATION OF POLICY

**SECTION 1. Title**. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Purok Development Program Ordinance of 2024**".

**Section 2. Declaration of Policy**. - It is hereby declared the policy of the city government to adopt the Purok System as a holistic approach to the delivery of basic services to the constituents and a feedback mechanism to facilitate the development of all barangays of the City. It shall likewise endeavor to promote strong cooperation among residents through active engagement in community governance.

**SECTION 3.** Definition of Terms – For purposes of this Ordinance, the term Purok shall refer to a district or zone division within a barangay composed of not less than fifty (50) households contiguous to each other as maybe delineated by the Sangguniang Barangay.

#### ARTICLE II – PUROK ORGANIZATION

**SECTION 4.** *Purok Organizations*. There shall be established and institutionalized puroks in every barangay. The number of puroks shall depend on the number of households in the barangay. The barangay officials headed by the Punong Barangay shall divide the barangay into areas called puroks.

All households situated in the delineated or defined area shall be registered as the purok residents represented by the head of the family.

The population size and accessibility of government services shall be the primary considerations in organizing additional purok.

**SECTION 5. Purok Membership**; **Rules on Transferees**. Purok membership and transferees shall be governed as follows:

- a) No member of any purok shall be accepted unless he/she is an actual resident of the said purok;
- b) Residents who are not actually living under the jurisdiction of the purok shall be allowed to be a member of any purok; *Provided*, that he/she has acquired a property in that particular purok; *Provided further*, that he/she can avail only once during her/his entire membership; *Provided finally*, that once a member has sold her/his property of that particular purok, her/his membership shall automatically transfer to his/her actual residency; and
- c) No transferee shall be accepted without securing first a Purok Clearance from the previous purok.

**SECTION 6.** City Purok Consultants. There shall be City Purok Consultants to be appointed by the City Mayor that will be responsible in the organization, strengthening, expansion of purok, and supervision in the conduct of election of purok officers in coordination with the barangay officials.

**SECTION 7. Purok Certification**. A Purok Certification that shall be issued by the Purok President may be a pre-requisite in securing Barangay Clearance. It shall indicate that the applicant is a registered and a member-in-good standing of Purok where he/she resides.

**SECTION 8.** *Purok Officers*. There shall be Purok Officers that will perform the duties and responsibilities assigned to them. It shall be composed of the following: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor, Purok Information Officer, and Sgt.-at-Arms. These officers shall constitute as the Purok Executive Committee.

In case of a vacancy in any of the positions, except for the President, the vacant position shall be filled by appointment by the Purok President upon recommendation of the Purok Executive Committee. In the event the Purok President cannot fulfill his/her entire term of office due to valid reasons except removal, the Purok Vice-President will assume his/her responsibilities for the remainder of his/her term.

#### **SECTION 9. Functions of Purok Officers:**

- (a) **President** shall be the official spokesperson of the Purok and shall have general supervision of the Purok affairs. The Purok President, or his/her designate shall preside at all meetings. He/she shall act as the Purok Coordinator that will serve as the link of the Municipal Purok Consultants on matters related to Purok Development Program.
- (b) **Vice President** shall fill the position of Purok President at any time that he/she may be absent or unable to fulfill the duties as Purok President and shall perform such other duties assigned to him/her.
- (c) **Secretary** shall keep an accurate written record and a synopsis of the minutes of all meetings. The Secretary shall issue all notices of meetings and any other such notices. He/she shall prepare and keep on record a file of all Purok members. The Secretary shall record and keep the record of all Purok activities.
- (d) **Treasurer** shall keep full and accurate records of receipts and disbursements in books belonging to Purok. A full report of the Purok's financial status will be required at each meeting. The Treasurer shall deposit all monies to the credit of the Purok in a suitable banking institution and shall disburse funds as approved by the Executive Committee. He/she shall also receive and keep records of all dues, contributions and prizes collected.
- (e) **Auditor** shall see to it that all financial disbursements are in accordance with its purpose.
- (f) **Purok Information Officer** shall be responsible for the dissemination of all relevant information to all purok residents.
- (g) **Sergeant-at-Arms** shall see to it that all purok meetings are done in peaceful manner.



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**SECTION 10.** *Qualifications*. No person shall be eligible to run or be a candidate for any Purok Officer position unless if he/she is a member-in-good standing and a permanent resident of the purok where he/she will be area under the purok jurisdiction.

**SECTION 11.** *Purok Officers Election*. The election of Purok Officers shall be held annually on the 1st Friday of January. In instances that a new purok is established, the date of election of officers thereof shall be determined by the concerned Sangguniang Barangay.

In case of *force majeure*, the Sangguniang Barangay in coordination with the City Purok Consultants shall set the election of purok officers on the next proximate Friday.

- **SECTION 12.** *Place of Election*. The election of Purok Officers shall be held at the Purok Multipurpose Center, or in the absence thereof at the nearest public place to be determined by the Sangguniang Barangay.
- **SECTION 13. Process of Election**. The purok officers shall be elected by the members-ingood standing by *viva voce*. No absentee or proxy voting shall be allowed.
- **SECTION 14. Assumption and Term of Office**. The elected Purok Officers shall assume office right after the election has been completed and shall serve for a term of one (1) year.

All officers and members shall meet regularly or once a month in their purok and submit reports to the Punong Barangay and to the government agencies that may request copies of such reports.

**SECTION 15. Purok Federations**. All duly elected Purok Presidents shall comprise the barangay Federation of Purok Presidents. Likewise, all duly elected Presidents of the Barangay Federations of Purok Presidents shall compose the City Purok Federation. Elections of the Federations shall be facilitated by the City Purok Consultants to be conducted every 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of January for the Barangay Federation and 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of January for the City Federation. The City Federation of Purok Presidents shall elect seven (7) members of the Board of Directors. Immediately after the elections of the Federation's Board of Directors, they shall elect from among themselves its Officers.

**SECTION 16.** *Purok Multipurpose Center*. Every purok may have a Purok Multipurpose Center that will serve as the purok residents' convergence area preferably located at the most convenient place for all purok residents. It shall also serve as its reading or information center, multi-use facility, and a show-window of all purok initiatives such as but not limited to communal garden, plant nursery, materials recovery facility, etc.

**SECTION 17.** *Purok Map.* Purok officers in coordination with the City Purok Consultants and concerned Sangguniang Barangay are enjoined to have their respective Purok Maps to be displayed at the Purok Multipurpose Center. It shall contain information of all features found therein.

#### ARTICLE III – PUROK DEVELOPMENT

**SECTION 18.** *Purok Capability Building*. There shall be a yearly Purok Capability Building activities to be conducted in every purok for the purpose of empowering and capacitating the purok residents to become productive partners in the delivery of socio-economic services that would further spur the communities' economic development.

**SECTION 19.** *Purok Incentive System.* (A) As an incentive, there shall be a monthly financial assistance to be provided to all Purok Presidents at the rate of Three Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbf{P}\$3,000.00) each, additional Three Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbf{P}\$3,000.00) per month for Barangay Federation President, and additional Three Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbf{P}\$3,000.00) per month for the City Federation President.



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(B) There shall also be a reward for those puroks and barangays who are best performer during the "Search for Outstanding Puroks and Barangays". Rewards shall be provided by the City Government, as follows:

18.B.1 Prizes for Barangay Winners shall be provided by the City Government, to wit:

a) First prize - ₱60,000.00 cash and ₱1.5 million worth of priority project/s;

b) Second prize - ₱50,000.00 cash and ₱1.0 million worth of priority project/s;

c) Third prize - ₱30,000.00 and ₱500,000 worth of priority project/s;

**SECTION 20.** Search Parameters, Criteria, and Point System. The following shall be the parameters, criteria and point system to serve as guide by the program evaluators, to wit:

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**SECTION 21. Purok Aid**. All purok organizations may be entitled to an annual purok aid in the amount not less than Three Thousand Pesos (₱3,000.00) for the operation of the said purok. The Sangguniang Barangay may increase the incentives as the need arises and when funds so warrant

**SECTION 22.** *Imposition of Purok Fees.* Purok Council may impose fees in connection with the issuance of purok clearance or certification, or membership dues; *Provided*, it must be approved by the purok assembly and confirmed by Sangguniang Barangay.

#### **ARTICLE IV - FINAL PROVISIONS**

**SECTION 23.** Appropriations - There shall be allocated in the annual budget of the City Government so much amount necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 24.** *Special Committee* - There shall be a Special Committee to be created by the City Mayor that will formulate the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Ordinance, and the same shall be transmitted to the City Mayor for his approval through an Executive Order.

**SECTION 25.** *Administrative Sanctions* - Barangay officials found remiss in the implementation of this Ordinance shall be held administratively liable.

**SECTION 26.** Transitory Provisions - Pending the election of Purok officials, the City Mayor is hereby authorized to appoint the interim Purok President from the list of three (3) nominees per purok to be submitted by the Sangguniang Barangay.

**SECTION 27.** Severability. - If, for any reason, any provision, section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase of part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or suspended or revoked by a court with competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections or parts thereof, which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 28.** Repealing Clause. - All ordinances, local rules and regulations or parts thereof, whose provision conflicts with or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, and modified accordingly.

**SECTION 29.** Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its publication in a local newspaper and posting for ten (10) in three (3) conspicuous public places in the City.

#### LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

This refers to the request of the undersigned for the grant of authority to represent the City Government of Cagayan de Oro, as the Local Chief Executive, to enter into and sign the Data Use Agreement with Epimetrics, Inc., to be represented by its Project Manager, Dr. John Q. Wong, MD, MSC, for the utilization of the former's "Data Sets".



#### Data Use Agreement

This DATA USE AGREEMENT ("Agreement"), entered into this [day] day of [date] in Cagayan de Oro City, Philippines, by and between:

**EPIMETRICS, INC.**, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office at 4 Dama de Noche St., United Parañaque City, represented herein by Dr. John Wong, hereinafter referred to as "EpiMetrics"

and

CITY OF CAGAYAN DE ORO, a local government unit located in the Republic of the Philippines, with address at City Hall, Cagayan de Oro, Misamis Oriental represented herein by Honorable Mayor ROLANDO "KLAREX" UY, hereinafter referred to as "LGU-CDO"

WHEREAS, EpiMetrics is one of the partners of Thinking Machines Data Science, Inc. ("Thinking Machines") in completing the project entitled "Linking Village-Level Data on Climatic Impact-Drivers, Socioeconomic Vulnerability, and Environmental Conditions to Health Impacts Across 12 Philippine Cities" (the "Project"). Thinking Machines is a leading-edge data technology consultancy with operations in Manila, Singapore, and Bangkok. Thinking Machines transforms organizations by building enterprise AI and cloud data platforms;

WHEREAS, other partners in the Project include EL OBSERVATORIO DE MANILA INC. ("MO") and PHILIPPINE ACTION FOR COMMUNITY-LED SHELTER INITIATIVES, INC. ("PACSII") (Thinking Machines, MO and PACSII are collectively referred to "Partners"). MO is a Jesuit scientific research institution working on atmospheric and earth science in the Philippines and the Southeast Asian region. It advocates a science-based approach to sustainable development and poverty reduction through its principal focus on the areas of climate change and disaster science. PACSII is a non-governmental organization that serves as the intermediary support institution of the Homeless People's Federation Philippines through capacity-building, research and advocacy, resource mobilization and fund management;

WHEREAS, as one of the collaborators in the Project, EpiMetrics is tasked, among others, to liaise with relevant local government units and/or national government agencies that possess relevant information and/or datasets which will be used in completing the work product of the Project;

WHEREAS, the LGU will be the source and provider of the data requested by EpiMetrics;

WHEREAS, EpiMetrics and the City Government of Cagayan de Oro have agreed to the following:

1. Obligations of the LGU. The LGU shall provide access to EpiMetrics data sets relating to the following (collectively, the "Data Sets"): barangay-level data at weekly intervals of the number of cases and deaths on the following diseases: Cholera, Acute Bloody Diarrhea, Hepatitis A, Rotavirus, Typhoid Fever, Dengue, Chikungunya, Leptospirosis, Rabies, Heat Stroke, Asthma, Ischemic Heart Diseases, Hypertensive Heart Diseases, and Ischemic Stroke.

- 2. Obligations of EpiMetrics. EpiMetrics shall collect, encode, and process the data to be provided as inputs to, and shared with the Partners of EpiMetrics for, the development of a linked dataset of climate, environmental, socio-economic, and health indicators, and an outbreak prediction model, and for the completion of the Project.
- 3. Obligation on Data Use and its Confidentiality. The LGU agrees and understands that EpiMetrics shall share the Data Sets to its Partners for the completion of the Project. The Parties understand that the Data Sets shall not contain any identifiable markers and/or sensitive personal information (e.g., names, addresses, and sex of participants), and shall only be limited to aggregated data.

EpiMetrics agree that it shall not identify or attempt to identify the individuals from whom or about whom the data apply, and not to attempt to identify the information contained in the Data Set. EpiMetrics further agrees that it shall, at all times, abide by the Data Privacy Act of 2012 and all relevant rules and regulations.

- 4. <u>Intellectual Property</u>. The Parties understand and agree that the work product, the documentation, the Data Sets and other data sets used for and/or derived from the development of the research product shall be released under a permissive open-source licensing structure such as Apache 2.0 (<a href="https://opensource.org/licenses/Apache-2.0">https://opensource.org/licenses/Apache-2.0</a>) for any code or other inventions, or CC-BY 4.0 International (<a href="https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/">https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/</a>) for any other intellectual property (e.g., creative works that are not code, or patentable); provided that, on a case-by-case basis, Technical Advisory Panels may exercise reasonable discretion regarding more restrictive licensing structures in order to protect privacy, prevent harm, or otherwise maximize the potential for responsible release and downstream use.
- 5. <u>Term and Termination.</u> This Agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year commencing from [date] ("Term"). Each Party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement prior to the end of the Term upon thirty (30) days' written notice.
- 6. Extent of Liability. The City Government of Cagayan de Oro shall be free and harmless from all liabilities arising from the loss or damage in connection with, or arising from, or any breach of, this Agreement.
- 7. Governing Law and Venue of Actions. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines. All actions arising from this Agreement shall be exclusively brought before the courts, tribunals and quasi-judicial bodies of Cagayan de Oro.

8. <u>Notices.</u> All notices arising from or in connection with this Agreement shall be sent to the following persons and addresses:

The performance serves as an academic enhancement for students not just for Xavier University but the entire Cagayan de Oro Community. The play can supplement subject such as Arts Appreciation, English and Literature.
