WHEREAS, in a landmark legal ruling by the Permanent Court of Arbitration in 2016, the tribunal unequivocally declared that the maritime entitlements in the South China Sea, as defined by the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS), should not exceed the limits set by the Convention, rejecting China's claims within the 'nine-dash line';

WHEREAS, from that decision the Scarborough Shoal, Gaven Reef (North), McKennan Reef, Johnson Reef, Cuarteron Reef, Fiery Cross Reef and other features in the West Philippine Sea are features which the Philippines has sovereign rights;

WHEREAS, the efforts of the Philippine government in asserting its rights in the West Philippine Sea are in line with the principles of international law, as affirmed by the aforementioned arbitral tribunal's ruling, which found China in breach of its obligations under the UNCLOS, thus necessitating collective support by every peace loving Filipino;

WHEREAS, the West Philippine Sea, encompassing areas claimed as part of the country's exclusive economic zone (EEZ), holds significant historical and legal importance, as underscored by various laws such as the Administrative Order No. 29 titled the "*Naming The West Philippine Sea Of The Republic Of The Philippines*", Presidential Decree No. 1599 titled "*Establishing An Exclusive Economic Zone And For Other Purposes*", and Republic Act No. 9522 titled "*An Act To Amend Certain Provisions Of Republic Act No. 3046, As Amended By Republic Act No. 5446, To Define The Archipelagic Baselines Of The Philippines*,"

And For Other Purposes” which national policies delineated baselines and established the Philippine EEZ;

WHEREAS, the increasing territorial disputes and incursions by People’s Republic of China in the West Philippine Sea pose imminent threats to the nation’s sovereignty, security, and economic interests, with recent provocations by China, including the hindrance of Philippine Coast Guard resupply missions and the establishment of a floating barrier near Scarborough Shoal;

WHEREAS, the people of Cagayan de Oro recognize the urgent need for collective support and solidarity among local government units in defending the West Philippine Sea, as territorial integrity is essential for the nation’s identity and pride;

WHEREFORE, On motion of Vice Mayor Jocelyn B. Rodriguez, it was,

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, on behalf of the people of Cagayan de Oro, this Sanggunian expresses strong support for the Philippine government’s efforts in protecting the West Philippine Sea, urging all other *Sanggunians* in Northern Mindanao to join in solidarity for the defense of the nation’s sovereignty and territorial integrity.

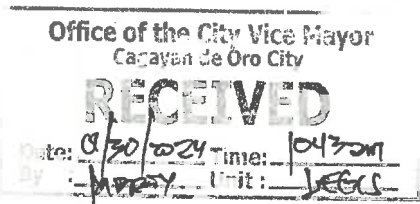

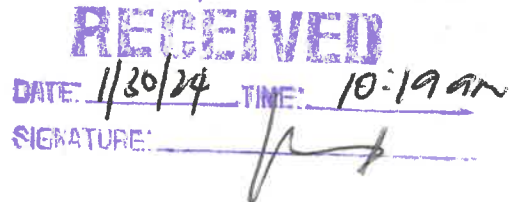

WHEREAS, forwarded to this Sanggunian for consideration is Resolution No. 325 of the 15th Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Aurora, entitled: "A Resolution Urging all Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Sangguniang Panglungsod, Sangguniang Bayan and Sangguniang Barangay to Express Collective Support for the Philippine Government's Efforts in Protecting the West Philippine Sea";

WHEREAS, the West Philippine Sea refers to the portions of the South China Sea which the Philippine government claims to be part of the country's exclusive economic zone (EEZ). The naming of the area became official through Administrative Order No. 29 issued by then-President Benigno Aquino III on September 5, 2012. The order also cites Presidential Decree No. 1599 which was issued in 1978 during the tenure of then President Ferdinand Marcos which established the Philippine EEZ as well as the Republic Act No. 9522 or the Baselines Law which was enacted into law in 2009 during the administration of then-President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo which delineated the baselines of the Philippine archipelago;

WHEREAS, the West Philippine Sea is currently facing territorial disputes and incursions by foreign entities which poses significant threat to the sovereignty, security and economic interests of the country;

WHEREAS, from harassing Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) resupply missions in Philippine waters and announcing its "10-dash line" map to setting up a floating barrier near the Scarborough Shoal in September, China has been increasing its provocations against Philippines' sovereignty and sovereign rights in the West Philippine Sea;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian recognizes the urgent need for collective support and solidarity among local government units in protecting our sovereign rights and interests in the West Philippine Sea;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Patricio F. Dumlao, Jr., unanimously seconded by all the Members, be it, -



4. **LANDBANK** shall shoulder the cost of the installation of the ATM and the renovation of the space where (ATM) will be installed;
5. **LGU CDO** shall allow the electric installation for the ATM unit on its premises;
6. **LGU CDO** shall allow the installation of data line/communication line to be connected to the ATM unit and any charge or billing therefore shall be for the account of **LANDBANK**;

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by and between:

The **CITY OF CAGAYAN DE ORO LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT** represented by its Mayor **HON ROLANDO A UY**, herein referred to as "**CITY LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT**"

The **XAVIER UNIVERSITY-ATENEO DE CAGAYAN**, Cagayan de Oro City represented by its President, **FR MARS P TAN SJ** herein referred to "**XU**"

and

Witnesseth:

WHEREAS, CITY LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT is mandated by the Local Government Code (Book III Chapter 4, Sec. 390/17) "to organize regular lectures, programs, or fora on community problems such as sanitation, nutrition, literacy, and drug abuse, and convene assemblies to encourage citizen participation in government;"

WHEREAS, CITY LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT through the City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office (CLENRO) pursuant to Republic Act 9003 also known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 is mandated "to adopt a systematic, comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program" as an area for improvement for constituents to highly abide by;

WHEREAS, XU as a Higher Education Institution is mandated by law to implement RA 9163 or the National Service Training Program (NSTP) law to enhance civic consciousness and defense preparedness in the youth by developing the ethics of service and patriotism in them while undergoing training in any of its three (3) program components: (1) Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS); (2) Literacy Training Service; and (3) Reserved Officers' Training Corps (ROTC);

WHEREAS, XU through the NSTP facilitates community exposure, skills training and service to the community in the conduct of the CWTS and LTS components as its way of developing the values stated under the NSTP law;

WHEREAS, XU through the NSTP can complement the CDO - LGU through the City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office (CLENRO) in conducting the Information Education Campaign on Solid Waste Management as the societal engagement of the students.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises herein set forth, the parties have agreed to work together in the implementation of the Information Education Campaign on Solid Waste and to undertake the following responsibilities:

1. **CITY LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT** will
 - a. Set a timeline of the implementation of the societal engagement as agreed by XU through NSTP unit;
 - b. Designate a contact person who will:
 - i. Assist in monitoring the implementation of the student's societal engagements;
 - ii. Identify a member from the Solid Waste Management Committee as coordinator from each barangay where the engagements with the CDO - LGU on Solid Waste Management is implemented;

- iii. Ensure that the Solid Waste Committee will directly monitor the students' societal engagement and performance, validate the students' attendance in the area, notify XU-NSTP immediately in case untoward incidents happen to students in the conduct of their community work and;
 - iv. Guide the students in the completion of their community work targets;
 - v. Attend the periodic assembly for evaluation of the program implementation with NSTP, and avail of capacity development trainings and workshops to enrich their skills in facilitating the NSTP-related tasks;
- c. Ensure the safety and security of the students during the scheduled area work;
2. XU through the National Service Training Program will:
- a. Meet the Contact Person/s and members of the Barangay Solid Waste Management Committees for thorough understanding/s and clarification of the roles and responsibilities in the implementation of the Information Education Campaign on Solid Waste Management through the CDO - LGU and Natural Resources Office (CLENRO) with the XU-NSTP students;
 - b. Assign, orient and prepare the students for area integration before their actual engagement on Solid Waste Management;
 - c. Provide the CDO - LGU through CLENRO with the complete names of NSTP students, formators, and class facilitators;
 - d. Oversee the performance of the students during the duration of their societal engagement;
 - e. Assign a Class Facilitator who will guide the NSTP team leaders in their activities during their societal engagement;
 - f. Oversee the checking of the students' attendance and behavior through a Formator and/or Class Facilitator to ensure that the policies and guidelines set by XU-NSTP and CDO LGU are observed at all times during the students' societal engagement;
 - g. Monitor the performance of the students;
 - h. Coordinate regularly with the Contact Person/s, for the smooth implementation of the program;
 - i. Conduct capability trainings and workshops for members of the Barangay Solid Waste Management Committee, contact person/s to enrich their ability to facilitate and respond to their NSTP related roles.
3. Amendments. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended or revoked upon mutual understanding of both parties, provided that all amendments shall be covered by supplemental provisions signed by both parties which shall be incorporated as integral parts of this Memorandum of Understanding.
4. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective for three academic years, subject to review every year.
5. No Employer-Employee Relationship Clause.

"There shall be no employer-employee relationship between City Government of Cagayan de Oro (LGU-CDO) and the faculty and students of Xavier University thru the National Service Training Program (XU- NSTP) students. Xavier University (XU) shall have exclusive control and supervision of its faculty and students in the performance of the obligations herein agreed upon. XU shall be solely responsible for all acts and/or omissions of its faculty members and students allowed by it to have access to the premises for any damage which may be caused to persons or property while remaining either casually or in business in any part therein.

6. Non-Liability of CDO – LGU.

Xavier University (XU) shall have exclusive control and supervision of its faculty and students in the performance of the obligations herein agreed upon. XU shall be solely responsible for all acts and/or omissions of its faculty members and students allowed by it to have access to the premises for any damage which may be caused to persons or property while remaining either casually or in business in any part therein. Any accident, injury or sickness of any kind, or death that may occur to any member of the faculty and the students during or any of the activities shall likewise be the XU's sole responsibility, XU further binds itself to hold CDO – LGU free and harmless from any claim on account of the aforementioned injury or damage."

7. Confidentiality

All information, data, documents and papers exchanged between CDO - LGU and XU in relation to the preparation, negotiation and execution of this Memorandum of Agreement shall be treated by the Parties with utmost confidentiality and shall not be divulged or shared with any third party, without the prior written consent of either of the Party.

The Parties further acknowledge and agree that for the purposes of this Agreement, each is responsible for compliance with all obligations and duties applicable under the Data Privacy Act of 2012 with respect of any Personal Data which the parties may process in delivery of the Services.

8. Venue of Actions

"In case of litigation arising from or in connection with the Memorandum of Agreement, the parties agree that the venue of action shall be at the proper court in the City of Cagayan de Oro only."

9. No Assignment of Rights

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Memorandum of Agreement, neither this Memorandum of Agreement nor any rights granted herein shall be assignable by the parties of the contract.

10. Termination

The Parties may, by mutual agreement expressed in writing, terminate this Memorandum of Understanding.

11. Parental Responsibility and Parental Consent

All acts and/or omissions of students done in the premises or for any damage which may be caused to persons or property while remaining either casually or in business in any part therein shall be the sole responsibility of their respective parents. The parent's responsibility includes any accident, injury or sickness of any kind, or death that may occur to any of the students during or any of the activities.

Individual parental consent shall be required before a student can participate for any activities pertaining to this understanding.

12. Diligence required

All faculty members and students are required to observe the diligence of a good father of the family in terms of their individual safety during and in any other activities.

This pertains to the draft ordinance entitled, ***'An Ordinance Institutionalizing the Purok Development Program of the City Government of Cagayan de Oro, Appropriating Funds thereof and For Other Related Purposes,'*** forwarded to this office for review, comment and recommendation.

At the onset, we find coherence of said Ordinance. Nonetheless, we have identified some observations/comments and recommendations, as hereunder quoted, for consideration, to wit:

<p>Section 11. PUROK FEDERATIONS. <i>On the creation of City Federation of Purok Presidents.</i></p>	<p>In light of the potential necessity for additional compensation corresponding to added responsibilities and taken into consideration the substantial funding commitments already earmarked for the Purok Presidents and Barangay Federations, it is recommended to reconsider the imperative for establishing the City Federation.</p> <p>Furthermore, it is worth noting that City Purok Consultants are to be appointed by the City Mayor pursuant to Section 2 of the same ordinance, with functions that may overlap with those of the City Federation as outlined therein."</p>
<p>Section 15. PUROK INCENTIVE SYSTEM. <i>On the monthly incentive to be received by Purok Presidents.</i></p>	<p>Given the duties of Purok Presidents outlined in Section 5 of the said ordinance, it is important to compensate them fairly for their work, hence, it is recommended that Purok Presidents are entitled to receive financial assistance amounting to PhP 3,000.00 per month, drawn from the General Fund of the City. Additionally, the President of the Barangay Federation of Purok Presidents shall receive an additional PhP 3,000.00 per month, resulting in a total financial assistance of PhP 6,000.00 per month.</p>



<p>Section 15. PUROK INCENTIVE SYSTEM. <i>On the rewards to be provided for the Search for Outstanding Puroks and Barangays.</i></p>	<p><i>Purok Winners to be provided by Barangay LGUs:</i></p> <p>Given the varying capacities among barangays to provide consolation prizes, it is deemed fair to omit its inclusion entirely.</p> <p><i>Barangay Winners to be provided by the City Government:</i></p> <p>Considering the funding requirements earmarked for the other provisions of this ordinance, it is recommended to no longer include the consolation prizes.</p> <p>Furthermore, priority projects to be awarded shall be determined by the winning barangays and shall not be in form of assistance-based initiatives. The Special Committee, as provided in Section 18 of the Ordinance, shall include in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the said ordinance the Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of the awarded priority project.</p>
<p>Section 16. SEARCH PARAMETERS, CRITERIA, AND POINT SYSTEM.</p>	<p>In view of the role of LGUs in the implementation of the Universal Health Care Act (RA 11223) at the grassroots level on ensuring that their residents are enrolled in the National Health Insurance Program, it is highly recommended to include in the search parameter the "Percentage of Purok Residents profiled and enrolled in National Health Insurance Program through PhilHealth Membership."</p>

1 **PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2024- _____**

2 **AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND INSTITUTIONALIZING THE PUROK SYSTEM IN THE**
3 **DELIVERY OF DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS IN EVERY BARANGAY OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**
4 **CITY, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

5 *Introduced by Councilors Yan Lam S. Lim, Kenneth John D. Sacala & Edgar S. Cabanlas*

6 *Whereas*, under the local governance system, puroks are sub-units of the barangay, which
7 is the basic political unit of the government. Traditionally, puroks are considered geographical
8 groupings of households within the barangays for the delivery of basic government services and to
9 promote Bayanihan in the community;

10 *Whereas*, the City Government of Cagayan de Oro City intends to transform the "Purok" as
11 a powerful tool for community mobilization and action, through institutionalization of a purok
12 development system in every barangay of the city to further improve the delivery of services to the
13 constituents;

14 *Whereas*, Section 384 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government
15 Code of 1991, provides the role of the barangay to serve as the primary planning and implementing
16 unit of government policies, plans, programs, projects, and activities in the community and a forum
17 wherein the collective views of the people may be expressed, crystallized and considered, and where
18 disputes may be amicably settled;

19 *Whereas*, the establishment of Purok is provided for in Paragraph (16), Section 391 of RA
20 7160, states that the "Sangguniang Barangay can provide for the organization of Community
21 Brigades, Barangay Tanod, or Community Service Units as may be necessary."

22 **NOW, THEREFORE:**

23 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the 20th City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) in session duly
24 assembled that:

25 **ARTICLE I - TITLE AND DECLARATION OF POLICY**

26 **SECTION 1. Title.** - This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Purok Development Program**
27 **Ordinance of 2024**".

28 **SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy.** - It is hereby declared the policy of the city
29 government to adopt the Purok System as a holistic approach to the delivery of basic services to
30 the constituents and a feedback mechanism to facilitate the development of all barangays of the
31 City. It shall likewise endeavor to promote strong cooperation among residents through active
32 engagement in community governance.

33 **SECTION 3. Definition of Terms** – For purposes of this Ordinance, the term *Purok* shall
34 refer to a district or zone division within a barangay composed of not less than fifty (50) households
35 contiguous to each other as maybe delineated by the Sangguniang Barangay.

36 **ARTICLE II – PUROK ORGANIZATION**

37 **SECTION 4. Purok Organizations.** There shall be established and institutionalized puroks
38 in every barangay. The number of puroks shall depend on the number of households in the
39 barangay. The barangay officials headed by the Punong Barangay shall divide the barangay into
40 areas called puroks.

41 All households situated in the delineated or defined area shall be registered as the purok
42 residents represented by the head of the family.

43 The population size and accessibility of government services shall be the primary
44 considerations in organizing additional purok.

45 **SECTION 5. City Purok Consultants.** There shall be City Purok Consultants to be appointed
46 by the City Mayor that will be responsible in the organization, strengthening, expansion of purok,

47 and supervision in the conduct of election of purok officers in coordination with the barangay
48 officials.

49 **SECTION 6. Purok Certification.** A Purok Certification that shall be issued by the Purok
50 President may be a pre-requisite in securing Barangay Clearance. It shall indicate that the applicant
51 is a registered and a member-in-good standing of Purok where he/she resides.

52 **SECTION 7. Purok Officers.** There shall be Purok Officers that will perform the duties and
53 responsibilities assigned to them. It shall be composed of the following: President, Vice President,
54 Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor, Purok Information Officer, and Sgt.-at-Arms. These officers shall
55 constitute as the Purok Executive Committee.

56 In case of a vacancy in any of the positions, except for the President, the vacant position
57 shall be filled by appointment by the Purok President upon recommendation of the Purok Executive
58 Committee. In the event the Purok President cannot fulfill his/her entire term of office due to valid
59 reasons except removal, the Purok Vice-President will assume his/her responsibilities for the
60 remainder of his/her term.

61 **SECTION 8. Functions of Purok Officers.**

62 8.1 **President** - shall be the official spokesperson of the Purok and shall have general supervision
63 of the Purok affairs. The Purok President, or his/her designate shall preside at all meetings.
64 He/she shall act as the Purok Coordinator that will serve as the link of the Municipal Purok
65 Consultants on matters related to Purok Development Program.

66 8.2 **Vice President** - shall fill the position of Purok President at any time that he/she may be absent
67 or unable to fulfill the duties as Purok President and shall perform such other duties assigned
68 to him/her.

69 8.3 **Secretary** - shall keep an accurate written record and a synopsis of the minutes of all
70 meetings. The Secretary shall issue all notices of meetings and any other such notices. He/she
71 shall prepare and keep on record a file of all Purok members. The Secretary shall record and
72 keep the record of all Purok activities.

73 8.4 **Treasurer** - shall keep full and accurate records of receipts and disbursements in books
74 belonging to Purok. A full report of the Purok's financial status will be required at each
75 meeting. The Treasurer shall deposit all monies to the credit of the Purok in a suitable banking
76 institution and shall disburse funds as approved by the Executive Committee. He/she shall
77 also receive and keep records of all dues, contributions and prizes collected.

78 8.5 **Auditor**- shall see to it that all financial disbursements are in accordance with its purpose.

79 8.6 **Purok Information Officer** - shall be responsible for the dissemination of all relevant
80 information to all purok residents.

81 8.7 **Sergeant-at-Arms** - shall see to it that all purok meetings are done in peaceful manner.

82 **SECTION 9. Qualifications.** No person shall be eligible to run or be a candidate for any
83 Purok Officer position unless if he/she is a member-in-good standing and a permanent resident of
84 the purok where he/she will be area under the purok jurisdiction.

85 **SECTION 10. Purok Officers Election.** The election of Purok Officers shall be held annually
86 on the 1st Friday of January. In instances that a new purok is established, the date of election of
87 officers thereof shall be determined by the concerned Sangguniang Barangay.

88 In case of *force majeure*, the Sangguniang Barangay in coordination with the City Purok
89 Consultants shall set the election of purok officers on the next proximate Friday.

90 **SECTION 11. Place of Election.** The election of Purok Officers shall be held at the Purok
91 Multipurpose Center, or in the absence thereof at the nearest public place to be determined by the
92 Sangguniang Barangay.

93 **SECTION 12. Process of Election.** The purok officers shall be elected by the members-in-
94 good standing by *viva voce*. No absentee or proxy voting shall be allowed.

135 **SECTION 20. Purok Aid.** All purok organization is entitled to an annual purok aid in the
136 amount not less than Three Thousand Pesos (₱3,000.00) for the operation of the said purok. The
137 Sangguniang Barangay may increase the incentives as the need arises and when funds so warrant.

138 **SECTION 21. Purok Incentives.** Purok officials acting as peace officer of their respective
139 purok shall be entitled to an incentive or honorarium of not less than Three Thousand Pesos
140 (₱3,000.00) annually. The Sangguniang Barangay may increase the incentives as the need arises and
141 when funds so warrant.

142 **SECTION 22. Automatic Membership of Lupong Tagapamayapa.** All elected Purok
143 President shall be automatically an ex-officio member of the Lupong Tagapamayapa and as such
144 he/she shall be entitled to all privileges accorded to such office like annual incentive, honorarium,
145 and insurance.

146 **SECTION 23. BHW and CVO Assigned to Purok; Annual Incentives.** Every purok
147 organization shall have its own BHW and CVO to assist the purok officials in the delivery of health
148 services and maintain peace and order. All Purok BHW shall be entitled to an annual incentive of
149 not less than One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (₱1,200.00). The Sangguniang Barangay may
150 increase the BHW incentives as the need arises and when funds so warrant. All CVO members is
151 likewise entitled to an incentives as provided by existing local ordinance.

152 **SECTION 24. Purok Membership; Rules on Transferees.** Purok membership and
153 transferees shall be governed as follows:

154 a) No member of any purok shall be accepted unless he/she is an actual resident of the said
155 purok;

156 b) Residents who are not actually living under the jurisdiction of the purok shall be allowed to
157 be a member of any purok provided that he/she has acquired a property in that particular
158 purok. Provided further that he/she can avail only once during her/his entire membership.
159 Provided finally that once a member has sold her/his property of that particular purok,
160 her/his membership shall automatically transfer to his/her actual residency; and

161 c) No transferee shall be accepted without securing first a Purok Clearance from the previous
162 purok.
