**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
ESTABLISHMENT OF GO URBAN GARDENING: MAKING FOOD AVAILABLE (GUGMA)
COMMUNAL GARDEN**

This Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") is made and executed this _____ in _____, Philippines, by and between:

THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (DA), through the **AGRICULTURAL TRAINING INSTITUTE (ATI)-REGIONAL TRAINING CENTER 10**, with an official address at Poblacion, El Salvador City, Misamis Oriental, represented herein by **DIRECTOR MARIA LYDIA A. ECHAVEZ**, herein referred to as "**Grantor**";

and

LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, with an official address at City Hall, Hayes Street, Cagayan de Oro City, represented herein by **MAYOR ROLANDO A. UY**, herein referred to as "**Grantee**";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY** recognizes the importance of promoting urban agriculture as a measure to address stability of food supply, alleviate poverty, foster social integration among communities, and protect the environment through eco-friendly methods and other alternative and innovative gardening methods;

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture (DA) in partnership with **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY**, implements the Urban Agriculture (UA) program as one of the modalities that renders safe food available, accessible, affordable, and provides additional income to households and communities in urban areas;

WHEREAS, the DA, through the ATI, spearheads the implementation of the UA program;

WHEREAS, the DA, through the ATI, encourages household crop production and showcases food production using various technologies;

WHEREAS, the DA, through the ATI, has allocated funds for the provision of starter kits which include agricultural inputs and technical assistance if required for household beneficiary and integrated UA gardens;

WHEREAS, the DA, through the ATI, will utilize the integrated UA garden developed, as venue for hands-on training to showcase various urban agriculture techniques in order to sustain production that can lead to enterprise development;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties have agreed, within the limits of the law governing their existence, on the following:

**ARTICLE 1
Title of the Program**

Section 1. The program is titled "**GO URBAN GARDENING: MAKING FOOD AVAILABLE (GUGMA)**" in support to the National Urban and Peri-Urban Agriculture Program (NUPAP) herein referred to as the "Program"

**ARTICLE 2
Obligations of the DA-ATI**

Section 1. The DA through the ATI, shall implement the program, through the following acts:

- a. For integrated UA garden, provide technical assistance and initial agricultural inputs such as vegetable seeds, plastic drums, garden tools, and organic inputs that will be used for the establishment/enhancement of the communal garden;
- b. For individual households, provide starter kits that will include seeds of common vegetables suited in the area, compost, seedling tray, polyethylene bags and information, education and communication (IEC) materials to start their own container or home/backyard garden;
- c. Spearhead capability building activities;
- d. Lead in the advocacy campaign for Integrated Urban Agriculture;
- e. Provide IEC materials on UA techniques;
- f. Provide continuous assistance to community/school/university/public office garden in the maintenance and sustenance of the site; and
- g. Conduct regular monitoring of the community/school/university/public office garden.

ARTICLE 3 Obligations of the (Grantee)

Section 1. The **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY**, shall participate in the program, through the following acts:

- a. Provide the required area for the establishment/enhancement of the integrated GUGMA communal garden;
- b. Assign a coordinator/facilitator who will manage the integrated GUGMA garden and identify people who are going to be trained as trainees;
- c. Attend DA-ATI required capability building interventions;
- d. Ensure availability of water supply and secure an Agricultural Technician (AT) personnel who will provide the technical assistance;
- e. Ensure project sustainability by providing necessary supplies, inputs, and implements to the community garden production activities;
- f. Promote GUGMA in their constituents;
- g. Assist in the monitoring and evaluation system of DA-ATI;
- h. Maintain operation records: production and sales/utilization data, technologies developed/shared farm activities undertaken, farm visitors and trainees served, problems encountered and other relevant accomplishments including photo documentation;
- i. Submit semestral accomplishment report to DA-ATI on the program; and
- j. Sustain the operation as a community/university/school/public office garden.

ARTICLE 4 Effectivity and Duration of Agreement

Section 1. This Agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing of both parties and will be binding for a period of three (3) years from 2023 to 2026, unless sooner terminated by any party for any reason by giving written notice within thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of

termination. Likewise, this agreement may be renewed by mutual written agreement of the parties.

**ARTICLE 5
Miscellaneous Provisions**

Section 1. Subsequent amendments, modifications, revisions or supplements to this Agreement shall be made in writing upon mutual agreement of the parties, which shall be attached to and made integral part of the original of this instrument.

Section 2. Any portion or provision of this Agreement that may be prohibited or unenforceable under Philippine laws shall be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition or unenforceability, without affecting the validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions hereof.

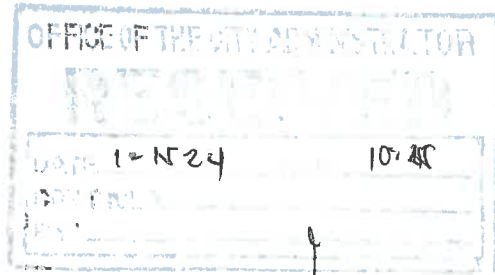



DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES 10, a government agency created under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with office address at Puntod, Cagayan de Oro City, herein represented by its Regional Executive Director, **HENRY A. ADORNADO, Ph.D.**, hereinafter referred to as the **DENR 10**;

and

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF MISAMIS ORIENTAL, a public corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with office address at Provincial Capitol Office, Cagayan de Oro City, herein represented by its Governor, **PETER M. UNABIA**, herein referred to as the **PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT**;

and

CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, a public corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with office Address at City Hall, Cagayan de Oro City, represented by its City Mayor, **ROLANDO A. UY**, herein referred to as **CITY GOVERNMENT**;

Witness that:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XII, Sec 2 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect the nation's marine wealth in its archipelagic waters, territorial sea, and exclusive economic zone, and reserve its use and enjoyment exclusively to the Filipino Citizens;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order No. 192, the DENR is the primary government agency mandated to conserve and manage the country's Environment and Natural Resources;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 20, 447 and 468 of RA 7160 or otherwise known as Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Government Units (LGUs) have the development control over the foreshore and coastal resources;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the DENR DAO No. 34-99 and its amendments, the DENR provides administrative regulations governing the administrative and management of the foreshore lands in order to rationalize the utilization and occupation of foreshore resources;

WHEREAS, there is an imperative need to formulate a planning document prompted by the DENR, in close coordination with the LGUs and other stakeholders, to formulate "Foreshore Management and Development Plan (FMDP)" to serve as the framework in the development

and management of the foreshore resources in the Province of Misamis Oriental and City of Cagayan de Oro;

WHEREAS, the DENR, Provincial Government, and City Government, willingly coordinated with each other and gave its utmost cooperation in the formulation and implementation of FMDP;

WHEREAS, the FMDP should be adopted by the Provincial Government and City Government as part of the legitimate planning documents in the management and development of the foreshore areas within their respective administrative jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the herein PARTIES agree to perform their duties and responsibilities with utmost diligence and efficiency;

NOW THEREFORE, premised considered, the PARTIES agree to cooperatively manage the foreshore areas of Misamis Oriental and Cagayan de Oro and implement the management and development programs and projects as reflected under the FMDP and hereby agree, upon the terms and conditions set forth as follows:

SECTION 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. After the signing of this Agreement, the herein PARTIES shall create the Misamis Oriental-Cagayan de Oro Foreshore Development and Management Council to be composed of the following:

2. The Misamis Oriental-Cagayan de Oro Foreshore Management and Development Council shall be the governing council for the implementation of the FDMP;
3. A Project Administrative Manual (PAM) shall be the FDMP of Misamis Oriental-Cagayan de Oro in the availability of the funding of project implementation;
4. The PAM shall serve as the main guide in the implementation and execution of all activities and financial transactions under the Partnership Agreement.

SECTION 2: RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DENR

The DENR shall:

1. Coordinate and communicate closely with the Provincial Government and City Government in the implementation and execution of this Agreement;
2. Assist in the formulation of the FMDP;
3. Organize the Foreshore Development Management Council immediately upon presentation of the FMDP;
4. Collaborate with Non- Government Agencies (NGA), stakeholders, and partners in monitoring and evaluating the biophysical and socio-economic conditions, coastal law enforcement and other aspects in the implementation of FDMP;
5. Provide technical support in the implementation of the FMDP;
6. Facilitate the conduct of FMDP planning and coordination with other national governments agencies in the province and in the city and stakeholders of foreshore areas in the implementation of foreshore projects and programs, particularly during trainings, conferences, consultation, seminars, and any other activities and programs;
7. Lead in the formulation of projects administration manual for specific projects to be implemented with the foreshore; and
8. Spearhead any other relevant planning activities and support programs and projects within its mandate as the leading government agency exercising jurisdiction in management, development, regulation and protection of the foreshore areas.

SECTION 3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT

The Provincial Government shall:

1. Abide with the provisions stipulated in this Agreement;
2. Enact provincial ordinances and other regulatory policies and regulations consistent with the existing foreshore laws and regulations;
3. Take responsibility in the implementation of the Partnership Agreement and any project/s involving the foreshore management within its respective coastal municipalities;
4. Ensure and encourage the participation of the coastal municipalities and appoint Foreshore Management Officer for every coastal municipality;
5. Ensure the effective implementation of FMDP for coastal municipality;
6. Provide each coastal municipality financial resource for the protection, conservation, and management of the foreshore area of the Province thru their Municipal Government, whenever needed;
7. Provide technical help to each coastal municipalities, as the need arises;
8. Provide conducive investment environment to encourage private sectors and entrepreneurs to invest in the implementation of FMDP;
9. Actively participate in the implementation of foreshore development and management project thru the Municipal Foreshore Management Officer within their respective territorial jurisdiction; and
10. Provide such other support and services in the effective delivery of development and management of the foreshore area in its respective territories.

SECTION 4. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT

The City Government shall:

1. Abide with the provisions stipulated in the agreement;
2. Enact ordinances and other regulatory policies and regulations consistent with the existing foreshore laws and regulations;
3. Appoint a City Foreshore Management Officer who shall:
 - a. Take responsibility in the implementation of this Partnership agreement and any project involving the foreshore within its respective jurisdiction;
 - b. Coordinate with the Misamis Oriental-Cagayan de Oro Foreshore and Management Council;
 - c. Create programs, project and/or activities to raise awareness among its constituents on the importance of foreshore resources;
 - d. Actively participate in the implementation of foreshore development and management project within their respective territorial jurisdiction; and
 - e. Ensure the effective implementation of FMDP within foreshore areas.
4. Provide manpower and financial resources for the protection, conservation and management of foreshore areas;
5. Provide technical support to City Foreshore Management Officer, as the need arises;

6. Provide conducive investment environment to encourage private sectors and entrepreneurs to invest in the implementation of FMDP; and
7. Provide such other support and services in effective delivery for development and management of the foreshore area in its respective territories.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be revised, amended or modified by the parties only through an instrument duly executed and signed by the parties but not later than the end of the validity Agreement.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY AND TERMINATION

Effectivity. This Agreement shall take effect immediately upon its signing thereof and within three (3) days following the signing of this Agreement, the local legislative body shall enact an ordinance that would formally integrate the FMDP in the CLUP or in a separate planning document of the Province or the City.

Termination. This Agreement shall terminate in the following instances:

1. Upon mutual written agreement of both parties; and
2. Failure of any of the party to comply with the terms and conditions of this Agreement and of the project development plan. In which case, all improvements made on the area shall turned over in favor of the government including all rights attached to the MOPA.

SECTION 7. MISCELLANEOUS

- a. If any clause, sentence or provision of this Agreement shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, its remaining parts shall not be affected thereby;
- b. The covenants, terms, conditions, and undertaking in this Agreement or any modifications, supplements or revisions thereof shall extend to and be binding upon successors or assignors;
- c. In case of disputes, claims, controversies due to the non-compliance with the terms of this Agreement, the Parties agree to submit voluntary arbitration before resorting to court action;
- d. Should either Party violates any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the aggrieved Party shall have the right to terminate or rescind this Agreement without prejudice to any claim arising therefrom;
- e. Suits for any breach of this Agreement shall be instituted in the court of competent jurisdiction in Cagayan de Oro City;
- f. Either Party may terminate the Agreement for violation of the terms and conditions embodied herein by giving the other Party (30) day notice in writing. If such is terminated for whatever cause and for violation of any of the provision herein, any rights and obligations of any Party, which have arisen on or before such any rights and obligation of any rights and obligations of any party, which have arisen on or before such termination, shall remain unaffected.

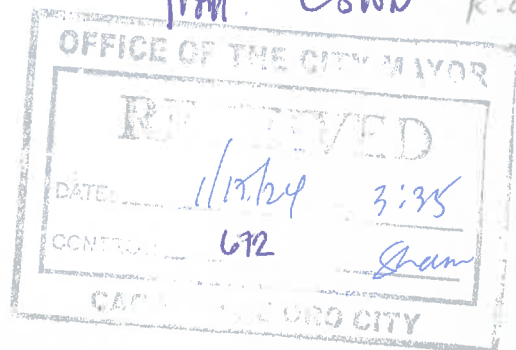

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (the "MOA")** is executed this _____, in Cagayan de Oro City, by and between:

AYALA FOUNDATION INC., a non-stock, non-profit corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with its office at the 8th Floor, 111 Paseo de Roxas Building, Paseo de Roxas corner Legaspi Street, Legaspi Village, Makati City, Philippines, and herein represented by its Attorneys-in-Fact, **CELERINA ASUNCION R. AMORES** and **ROSALLIE A. DIMAANO**, hereinafter referred to as "**AFI**";

and

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, through the **CITY SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE**, a local government unit organized and existing by its Charter under Republic Act No. 521 and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, with office address at the City Hall Compound at Gen. Capistrano and Justo Gaerlan Streets, Cagayan de Oro City, duly represented herein by its Local Chief Executive, **HON. ROLANDO "KLAREX" A. UY**, hereinafter referred to as the "**CSWD-CDO**".

Collectively, herein referred to as the "Parties" and individually, as "Party".

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, **AFI** is the expression of commitment of the Ayala conglomerate to national development and is committed to developing communities to be productive, creative, self-reliant, and proud to be Filipino, and implements vital programs in Education, Youth Leadership, Sustainable Livelihood, and Arts and Culture.

WHEREAS, **AFI** supports the *Hapag Movement Program* of Globe Telecom, Inc. which aims to provide support for vulnerable families through hunger alleviation and sustainable livelihood programs.

WHEREAS, **CSWD-CDO** desires to collaborate with **AFI** in the implementation of the *Globe Hapag Movement Program* in Cagayan de Oro City.

WHEREAS to achieve the Parties' goals, **AFI** and **CSWD-CDO** will work together in the implementation of the *GLOBE HAPAG MOVEMENT PROGRAM* or *Hapag Program* for no more than six (6) weeks from July 21 to August 31, 2023, for 400 families with livelihood initiatives aimed primarily at providing supplemental livelihood kits for the households in Cagayan de Oro City.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and their mutual covenants, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

I. Program Details and Duration

1. *Hapag Program* will be implemented from July 21 to August 31, 2023, in areas selected by CSWD-CDO which aims to produce 400 household representatives that have either completed livelihood training or are currently undergoing livelihood training to be recipients of the supplemental livelihood kits.

II. Roles and Responsibilities of the PARTIES

1. AFI, as a lead convenor of the program, will assist in the implementation of the *Hapag Program* in partnership with CSWD-CDO, such as the following:
 - a. Act as the Project Lead for *Hapag Program*.
 - b. Be the main point of contact with Globe Telecom, Inc. (Globe) and Ayala Group.
 - c. Set direction and guidance for the conduct of the Program, based on Globe's directions.
 - d. Finalize and approve locations to be covered by the Program.
 - e. Supply and/or deliver livelihood kits valued at Six Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP600,000.00) to CSWD-CDO holding area, subject to execution of acknowledgment receipt by the latter.
 - f. Act as the main channel for submission of reports and other documentation requirements to Globe.
2. CWSD-CDO, as the lead convenor, will act as the Community Implementation Lead of the *Hapag Program* Cagayan de Oro and perform the following:
 - a. Directly deal and be the main point of contact with communities and other possible implementation partners which may include other organizations and Local Government Units.
 - b. Oversee actual implementation of the Program on the ground including but not limited to procuring, negotiating, contracting, and coordinating with communities, potential suppliers, and implementors.
 - c. Identify and endorse project beneficiaries and monitor their participation and/or cooperation with the Program.
 - d. Prepare and submit documentation on receipt and distribution of the livelihood kits to AFI within thirty (30) days from completion of distribution.
 - e. Perform all necessary due diligence to assure that any and all support from AFI is used for the purpose of the fulfillment of its obligations under this Agreement in compliance with the Laws.

III. Publicity and Confidentiality

The Parties shall preserve in strict confidence any information which they may obtain, produce or exchange during the performance of their obligations under this Agreement including, but not limited to, any marketing, operational, employee/staff, technical, or financial information (the "**Confidential Information**").

No Party shall disclose any Confidential Information to any person or entity, including its officers, directors/trustees, or employees, except to its Representatives and Affiliates, nor used for any purpose other than the Program and this Agreement.

"Representatives" as used in this Agreement shall include directors, officers, employees, auditors, counsels, consultants, and other authorized agents. "Affiliate" as used in this Agreement means any corporation, company, or other entity that directly or indirectly controls is controlled by, or is under common control with a Party to this Agreement. No Party shall use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than to perform the obligations of the Parties under this Agreement.

Subject to the foregoing, each Party may publicly disclose the fact and nature of its own participation in the Agreement in its press releases and other materials, on condition that all such disclosures are truthful and accurate. The Parties shall not, in contributing to, delivering, and/or promoting the program (or in any other way) do any act which would or could reasonably be expected to exploit the other Party or bring it into disrepute.

IV. Term and Termination

A. This Agreement shall be effective upon its execution and shall be in full force and effect for a period of three (3) months from execution but not later than six (6) months without prejudice to the performance by the relevant Parties of their respective obligations under this Agreement.

B. In case of suspension for reasons beyond the control of the Parties, the effectivity of this Agreement shall extend for the same period as the suspension without the need of a written renewal or extension unless Parties agree to the contrary.

C. In case of breach by any Party of any warranty, representation, condition, or obligation herein, and the breach is not remedied within fifteen (15) days from written notice from the non-breaching Party, the non-breaching Party may terminate this Agreement upon five (5) days written notice, without need of judicial action, and without prejudice to the non-breaching Party's rights or remedies in law or equity.

D. For any reason other than a breach of this Agreement any Party may terminate this Agreement without need of judicial action upon sixty (60) days' prior written notice to the other Party.

V. Representation and Warranties. The Parties represent and warrant to each other that:

A. They are duly organized, validly existing, and in good standing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines. The Parties each have all necessary power and authority to carry on its operations as presently conducted and to enter into and perform its obligations under this Agreement. Each Party is duly qualified and licensed to do business in the Philippines. All relevant governmental approvals, permits, and consents required for the conduct of their respective businesses and affairs have been obtained and are in full force and effect. It has all necessary power and authority to execute, deliver, and perform its obligations under this Agreement.

B. The execution, delivery, and performance of this Agreement have been duly authorized by all necessary actions and will not result in any breach or violation of any of their existing charter documents, contracts, licenses, permits, and authorizations.

C. This Agreement constitutes the legal, valid, and binding obligation of each Party and its successors-in-interest and assignees and shall be enforceable in accordance with its terms.

VI. Compliance with Laws, Right to Audit

A. Compliance with Data Privacy Laws

The Parties agree to comply with, and have adequate measures in place to ensure that its directors, officers, employees, and representatives comply at all times with:

- (a) the provisions and obligations contained in Republic Act No. 10173 or the "Data Privacy Act of the Philippines" and its implementing rules and regulations, and
- (b) other applicable data privacy laws and regulations, as may be promulgated and/or amended from time to time.

By agreeing to execute and enter into this Agreement, the Parties agree that any information exchanged between them may be collected, processed, shared, and used but only for purposes relevant to the Transaction.

Each of the Parties agrees to hold the other free and harmless from any costs or liability arising from its failure to comply with the requirements of the Data Privacy Act of the Philippines.

B. Compliance with Other Laws.

The Parties agree to perform their respective obligations under this Agreement in compliance with:

- a. Anti-bribery laws, rules and regulations relevant to the execution and performance of this Agreement, which may include the Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act of the Philippines (Republic Act 3019), the United States Foreign Corrupt Practices Act of 1977 as amended, the United Kingdom Bribery Act 2010 or other applicable national, regional, provincial, state, municipal or local laws and regulations that prohibit the bribery of, or the providing of unlawful gratuities or other benefits to, any government official or any other person (herein referred to as the "Anti-Bribery Laws");
- b. Other applicable laws, regulations, rules, and executive orders relevant to the execution and performance of this Agreement are not mentioned in the foregoing (herein referred to as "Other Relevant Laws").

(The "Anti-Bribery Laws", "Anti-Terrorist and Money Laundering Laws" and "Other Relevant Laws" shall herein collectively be referred to as the "Laws".)

VII. General Provisions

A. No Party shall be liable to the other Party in the event that it is unable to perform an obligation under this Agreement because of any cause outside of its reasonable control, including acts of God, industrial action, default, or failure of a third party, failure of equipment, transmission difficulties, governmental action, or interruption of services.

B. The Parties agree to perform all such acts and to execute and deliver such other documents or instruments as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Agreement.

C. This Agreement is the complete and exclusive statement of the agreement between the Parties, and supersedes all understandings or prior agreements, whether oral or written and all representations or other communications between the Parties in relation

to the subject matter contemplated herein. This Agreement is executed by the Parties for and in consideration of the terms and conditions stated herein.

D. If any provision of this Agreement is found by any court or administrative body of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such provision shall not affect the other provisions of this Agreement, and all provisions not affected by such invalidity or unenforceability shall remain in full force and effect. The Parties agree to substitute any invalid or unenforceable provision with a valid or enforceable provision which achieves, to the greatest extent possible, the objectives of the invalid or unenforceable provision. In the absence of such an agreement within thirty (30) days after commencing negotiations, a Party shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement effective after seven (7) days from written notice to the other Party.

E. The waiver by a Party of a breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement by the other Party shall not be construed as a waiver of any succeeding breach of the same or other provisions; nor shall any delay or omission by a Party in exercising any right that it may have under this Agreement operate as a waiver of any breach or default by the other Party.

F. This Agreement does not transfer to any Party any ownership or proprietary rights in the Intellectual Property/ies or any work or any part thereof, and all right, title, and interest in and to such property/ies will remain solely to the respective Parties.

G. No modifications, amendments, or supplements to this Agreement shall be effective for any purpose unless in writing signed by each Party. Approvals or consents hereunder by a Party shall also be in writing.

H. Any notice or other communication to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing and may be served by e-mail, personal delivery, or by sending it by pre-paid post to the addresses of the Parties specified in this Agreement, or as notified in writing by a Party to the other Party from time to time.

I. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed as constituting or evidencing any partnership, joint venture, agency, or contract of employment between the Parties.

J. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each such counterpart being deemed to be an original instrument, and all such counterparts shall together constitute an integrated instrument enforceable in its entirety.

K. The venue of any action among the Parties to this Agreement shall be brought solely and exclusively in the proper courts of Cagayan de Oro City.
