BARANGAY ORDINANCE NO. 003 SERIES OF 2021

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND IMPLEMENTING THE GUIDELINES FOR THE PERSON WITH DISABILITY FRIENDLY SEAL FOR BUILDINGS, INSTITUTIONS, ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN BARANGAY-14.

WHEREAS, the Rules and Regulations set forth herein provide for minimum requirements and standards to make buildings, facilities and utilities for public use accessible to disabled persons, pursuant to the objectives of Batas Pambansa Bilang 344, An Act to Enhance the Mobility of Disabled Persons by Requiring Certain Buildings, Institutions, Establishments and Public Utilities to Install Facilities and Other Devices;

WHEREAS, this program is to ensure that business establishments, buildings and institutions are accessible to all persons with disability;

WHEREAS, The seal is given to friendly establishment or building/facilities, wherein the main function of the establishment, must be fully accessible to PWDs, including compliance to all architectural features and facilities within the common areas, as provided to the general public. This also includes accessible areas designated to PWDs (Persons with Disability).

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay-14 in session assembled, that:

RULE 1

GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. TITLE this proposed ordinance shall be name as **CREATING AND IMPLEMENTING THE GUIDELINES FOR THE PERSON WITH DISABILITY FRIENDLY SEAL FOR BUILDINGS, INSTITUTIONS, ESTABLISHMENTSWITHIN BARANGAY-14.**

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. The purpose of the ordinance is to ensure that the establishments and offices within the jurisdiction of the barangay are accessible and user friendly to all Person with Disability and to give credit and due recognition to any establishment and offices who complies with the guidelines set by this ordinance and other existing laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

SECTION 3. SCOPE. These guidelines shall apply to all private business establishments, offices, both in the private and public.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS

A. Issuing Authority- the Barangay Council of Barangay-14 vested under these guidelines with the authority to issue the certification and award the Safety Seal

B. PWD Friendly Seal Certification Program - a certification scheme affirming that an establishment or office has been inspected by the Inspection Team and was found compliant with the guidelines set by the Barangay-14 Council.

RULE II

THE PWD FRIENDLY SEAL

SECTION 1. THE PWD FRIENDLY SEAL. The PWD Friendly Seal affirms that an establishment has been found compliant with the guidelines set by the Barangay in relevance to the Batas Pambansa Bilang 344, An Act to Enhance the Mobility of Disabled Persons by Requiring Certain Buildings, Institutions, Establishments and Public Utilities to Install Facilities and Other Devices ,The seal shall be displayed conspicuously at all entrance points according to prescribed dimensions. Obtaining the Safety Seal shall be at no cost to the establishment.

SECTION 2. GUIDELINES. the following guidelines are present and complied by the establishment and or office that has undergone a physical inspection by the PWD Friendly Seal Inspection Team created by the Barangay:

1. ACCESSIBLE RAMP

Gradient is 1:12 (maximum), located at/near the main entrance, with at least 1 handrails on 1 side 700mm/900mm, maximum length – 6.00m (with landing area) width of ramp – 1.20m (minimum). location is not dangerous to user, a 300mm long extension of the handrail should be provided at the start and end of ramps and stairs.

2. WASHROOMS AND TOILETS

Cubicle dimension (minimum 1.70m X 1.80m), width of door – 800mm (minimum), permit easy passage of wheelchair (1.50m turning space), one movable grab bar with 800mm mounting height one fixed to the adjacent wall with 800mm mounting height, lavatory with 800mm mounting height 650mm vertical leg room space, center of water closet is 400mm to the finished face of the adjacent wall. A 300mm long extension of the handrail should be provided at the start and end of ramps and stairs.

3. PARKING AREAS/ STALLS

Located at the nearest entrance with signage (@ pavement/upright), stall width – 3.70m (minimum)

4. SIGNAGE (DIRECTIONAL AND INFORMATIONAL SIGNS)

At toilet, ramp, parking, Mounting height for toilet door, bottom 1.40m and upper 1.60m, 2.0m headroom clearance for Protruding wall mounted signage, UN symbol of accessibility, Refer to Rule 2 of IRR of BP344 for standards and dimensions, toilet door signage dimension as 200mm by 200mm.

5. NON-SKID FLOORING

Toilet and ramp floor surfaces with slip-resistant material.

6. ELEVATORS (for offices having more than 1 storey area)

Must be located not more than 30.00m from the entrance and easily locate with the aid of signage shall have a minimum dimension of 1.10m depth x 1.40m width. Control panels and emergency system shall be within reach of a seated person (centerline of topmost buttons shall be 900mm – 1.20m from the floor). Button controls shall be provided with Braille contractions.

7. STAIRS - Tread surfaces, slip-resistant material and slanted nosings are preferred than projecting nosings.

SECTION 4. ELIGIBILITY. The following are the eligible establishments and offices that can qualify for the PWD Friendly Seal certification:

1. Display Centers
2. Hotels and Inn
3. Hospitals, Clinic, Birthing Homes and Medical Related Facilities
4. Fast food, Restaurant, Carenderia and Coffee Shops
5. Gyms, Spa and Massage Clinics
6. Banks, Remittance Centers and Money Changer
7. All other Establishments that are open to the public
8. Government Offices

SECTION 5. CHECKLISTS. The Issuing Authority shall develop checklists that will enumerate the eligibility requirements in an easy-to-understand format.

SECTION 6. VALIDITY. The PWD Friendly Seal shall be valid for six (6) months from the date of issuance, The PWD Friendly Seal shall be renewable subject to continued compliance with the eligibility requirements set forth herein.

RULE VI

ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISION

SECTION 1. PROVISION OF FUNDS. The Barangay Council must allocate funds annually to cover operational expenses relative to this ordinance

RULE VII

FINAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any clause, provision, paragraph or part thereof shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, invalidate or impair any other part hereof but such judgement shall be merely confined to the clause, provision, paragraph or part directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment has been rendered.

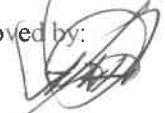

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8550, otherwise known as the "*Philippine Fisheries Code of 1998*", as amended by RA 10654 mandated BFAR to provide fishery livelihood projects with the aim of providing support to marginal fisherfolk in the exercise of their preferential rights to benefit from the country's fisheries resources, especially in municipal waters;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "*Local Government Code of 1991*", mandates the LGU to provide its constituents extension facilities related to agriculture and fishery activities which include water and soil resource utilization and conservation projects and enforcement of fishery laws in municipal waters;

WHEREAS, the BFAR is mandated by law to improve fisheries productivity and empower stakeholders toward food security, global competitiveness and climate change adaptation;

WHEREAS, the provision of fishery livelihood interventions like grow-out culture of milkfish in floating cage is part of the on-going collaboration between BFAR and the BENEFICIARY through the CLGU (hereinafter collectively dubbed as
