ORDINANCE NO. 14146-2021

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ALTERATION OF PLAN OF A PORTION OF CAGAYAN DE ORO RESETTLEMENT AND SOCIALIZED HOUSING PROJECT-5 (CDORSHP-5), PHASE 1, LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAN SIMON, THIS CITY, COVERING AN AFFECTED AREA OF 36,123 SQ.M., BY WIDENING THE 6.5-METER ROAD LOTS TO 8.0 METERS TO CONFORM TO THE CITY'S MINIMUM DESIGN STANDARD FOR ROADS, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 6629-98, AS APPLIED FOR BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO, REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR OSCAR S. MORENO; AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE ORDINANCE NO. 13916-2020

BE IT ORDAINED by the 19th City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) of Cagayan de Oro in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. The Alteration of Plan of a portion of Cagayan de Oro Resettlement and Socialized Housing Project-5 (CDORSHP-5), Phase 1, located in Barangay San Simon, this City, covering an affected area of 36,123 sq.m., by widening the 6.5-meter Road Lots to 8.0 meters to conform to the City's minimum design standard for roads, pursuant to Ordinance No. 6629-98, as applied for by the City Government of Cagayan de Oro, represented by the City Mayor Oscar S. Moreno, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. For this purpose, Ordinance No. 13916-2020, entitled: *An Ordinance Approving the Development Permit of the Cagayan de Oro Resettlement and Socialized Housing Project 5 (CDORSHP) located in Barangay San Simon, this City, with an area of 112,198 Sq.M., more or less, containing 833 lots/units, as applied for by the City Government of Cagayan de Oro, represented by Honorable City Mayor Oscar S. Moreno; subject to the conditions imposed by the City Engineering Office (CEO) and City Housing and Urban Development Department (CHUDD)*, is hereby amended accordingly.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 14147-2021

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND DESIGNATING MOTORCYCLE LANES IN SELECTED MAJOR THOROUGHFARES IN CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY FOR MOTORCYCLES, PROVIDING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS THEREFOR, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, a significant portion of motor vehicle accidents in the City involve motorcycles;

Whereas, many residents of the city use motorcycles as their preferred mode of transportation because it is easier to afford and maintain compared to a 4-wheel vehicle;

Whereas, there is a need to ensure the safety of these motorists;

Whereas, with heavy vehicular traffic, having a separate lane for motorcycles in our national roads would force motorcycles to occupy only one part of the road;

Whereas, the separation of motorcycles from other types of vehicles will lessen their exposure to those other types of vehicles, thereby reducing risk of accidents occurring between these different types of vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the 19th City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) of Cagayan de Oro in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title. – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the Motorcycle Lane Ordinance of 2019.

SECTION 2. Definition of Terms. – The following terms shall be construed to mean as:

- (a) **Motorcycle** – two-wheeled motor vehicle having one or two riding saddles.
- (b) **Public Utility Vehicle** – any motorized vehicle as herein defined with franchise issued by the following granting authorities only; *i.e.*, (i) City Government of Cagayan de Oro, (ii) Department of Transportation (DOTr), and/or (iii) Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB);
- (c) **Motor Vehicles** – any vehicle propelled by any power other than muscular power using the public highways, except road rollers, trolley cars, street -sweepers, sprinklers, lawn mowers, bulldozers, graders, fork-lifts, amphibian trucks, and cranes if not used on public highways, vehicles which run only on rails or tracks, and tractors, trailers and traction engines of all kinds used exclusively for agricultural purposes. Trailers having any number of wheels, when propelled or intended to be propelled by attachment to a motor vehicle, shall be classified as separate motor vehicle with no power rating.
- (d) **Lane Splitting** – using or sharing a lane already occupied by one vehicle by another vehicle such as a motorcycle in a road or highway;
- (e) **Lane Filtering** - when operating a motorcycle, the act of overtaking and passing another vehicle that is stopped in the same direction of travel in the same lane;



SECTION 3. Establishment. – The outer lanes parallel and adjacent to the sidewalks/road shoulders on both sides of the following major thoroughfares in the City of Cagayan de Oro, with a minimum width of 2.5 meters, are hereby designated and established as motorcycle lane, to wit:

- (a) National (Maharlika) Highway from Kinasanghan, Barangay Iponan to Barangay Bugo (boundary of Cagayan de Oro City with the Municipality of Tagoloan);
- (b) National Highway from crossing Puerto Flyover to Upper Puerto;
- (c) Velez Street from Rodelsa Circle up to Parola, Macabalan area;
- (d) Entire stretch of JR Borja Extension;
- (e) Entire stretch of Masterson Avenue;
- (f) Entire stretch of PN Roa Avenue (Patag Road);

Provided, That the laws, rules and regulations of implementing agencies of traffic and transportation-related laws such as the Department of Transportation (DOTr), Land Transportation Office (LTO), Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), among others, shall still be followed in using the established motorcycle lanes;

Provide further, That motorcycles that serve as public utility vehicles shall abide by the terms and conditions of their franchise.

SECTION 4. Markings – The aforesaid motorcycle lanes shall be demarcated with blue paints subject to compliance with the international standards on road markings.

SECTION 5. Requirements; Prohibitions. –

- a) All drivers of motorcycles have priority to use the designated motorcycle lanes enumerated in Section 3 hereof.
- b) All motorcycles are entitled to the full use of a lane. A person shall not drive a motor vehicle in such a manner as to deprive any motorcycle of the full use of a lane.
- c) The operator of a motorcycle shall not overtake and pass in the same lane occupied by the vehicle being overtaken.
- d) A person shall not operate a motorcycle between the lanes of traffic or between adjacent rows of vehicles. This is commonly known as Lane Filtering and Lane Splitting.
- e) In the event that an accident occurs on the motorcycle lane between a motorcycle and a motor vehicle, its occurrence thereat shall be *prima facie* evidence of the negligence of the driver of the motor vehicle;
- f) In event that an accident occurs on the regular lane between a motorcycle and a motor vehicle, its occurrence thereat shall be *prima facie* evidence of the negligence of the driver of the motorcycle;
- g) Subsections (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) hereof shall not apply to peace officers and emergency staff in the performance of their official duties.
- h) Motorcycles may deviate from the Motorcycle Lane when making a turn or U-turn at authorized streets or U-turn slots; *Provided,* That the said vehicles shall gradually shift



to the side of the road, highway or street without swerving, and shall begin shifting lanes not less than fifty (50) meters from the relevant street or U-Turn slot, making the appropriate signals and observing all other traffic rules and regulations.

- i) Motorcycles shall not pass through or encroach on designated/established Bicycle Lanes in major thoroughfares, instead motorcycles maybe allowed to share and merge with motor vehicles along the regular lanes;
- j) Designated motorcycle lanes maybe utilized or shared by motor vehicles only when there is no motorcycle passing the same;
- k) Parking of all types of vehicles is strictly prohibited within the designated motorcycle lanes;

SECTION 6. Fines and Penalties. - Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance, or any of the acts or omissions enumerated in this Section which shall constitute violations of traffic rules and regulations in the City of Cagayan de Oro, shall be penalized with the following administrative fines:

b) Lane Splitting / Lane Filtering	1,500	3,000	5,000

SECTION 7. Judicial Penalty. - In the event the person who was issued citation ticket fails to pay the traffic fine stated in the citation ticket at the office of the Roads and Traffic Administration, or to not render community service in lieu of payment of administrative fine as provided under this Ordinance, within seventy-two (72) hours from time of issuance of the citation ticket, the Roads and Traffic Administration shall immediately file a complaint against such person before the courts, and if found guilty of the offenses shall be penalized with a fine of not less than ₱3,000.00 but not more than ₱5,000.00 or imprisonment of not less than eight (8) months but not more than one (1) year, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 8. Implementing Office; IRR. - The Roads and Traffic Administration shall be primarily responsible in the implementation of this Ordinance.

The Traffic Management Board and the City Legal Office shall be responsible in the preparation of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) thereof, which shall be issued by the City Mayor through an Executive Order.

SECTION 9. Supplemental Rules. - The pertinent provisions of Ordinance No. 10551-2007, otherwise known as the Traffic Code of Cagayan de Oro City, as applicable, shall be supplementary to this Ordinance insofar as they are not inconsistent herewith.

In case of conflict, however, between the provisions of this Ordinance and the Traffic Code, the former shall prevail.

SECTION 10. Repealing Clause. - All ordinances, provisions of local ordinances, executive orders, and similar issuances that are contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.



In case of conflict, the provisions of the national laws shall prevail.

SECTION 11. Severability. If any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by competent authorities, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other parts or provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 12. Effectivity. – This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its posting for three (3) consecutive weeks in conspicuous public places in the City and its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation.
