KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This agreement made and executed into this ____ day of 2018 by and among:

The **CITY OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, a local government unit (LGU) in the Region, duly established under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with address at Capistrano St., Cagayan de Oro City, herein represented by its City Mayor, **HON. OSCAR S. MORENO**, hereinafter referred to as the **“IMPLEMENTING PARTNER”**.

-and-

CAGAYAN DE ORO WATER DISTRICT (COWD), a government-owned and controlled corporation and duly organized entity under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at Corrales Avenue, Cagayan de Oro City, represented in this act by its Acting General Manager, **BIENVENIDO V. BATAR, JR.**, hereinafter referred to as the **“IMPLEMENTING AGENCY”**.

-WITNESSETH-

WHEREAS, Bottom – up Budgeting (BUB) program is a grand design of the present administration in attaining the Philippine Development Plan’s goal of inclusive growth, poverty reduction and promotion of good governance at the local level;

WHEREAS, the BUB seeks to enhance the budget and the planning process through the involvement of grassroots organizations and LGUs, thus making the national budget more responsive to the local needs;

WHEREAS, various projects were identified and included in CY 2016 Budget of Participating National Government Agencies;

WHEREAS, the **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** is a recipient of the 2016 BUB project implementation;

WHEREAS, the **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER**, through its **Local Poverty Reduction Action Team (LPRAT)** proposed for the project Enhanced Community-Based Water System for Sitio Tipolohon, Barangay Camaman-an; Repair projects to be co-funded by the national and local government agencies.

WHEREAS, the **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY** (being the city’s water provider), has an existing water system facility in the proposed project site of which the **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** will establish a linkage, through tapping into its already functional and operational water pipelines, thus, making the said entity eligible to implement the said project, subject to the standards and policies set by National Government which are applicable to all phases of subproject preparation and implementation;

WHEREAS, the **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY** has established a partnership agreement with the **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** over the former’s various Waterworks Projects for the latter to implement the project;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties to this Agreement do hereby agree on the following terms and conditions:

Article I

SCOPE

- Section 1.1** This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) covers the implementation of the 2016 BUB Subproject of the **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** - Enhanced Community-Based Water System for Sitio Tipolohon, Barangay Camaman-an with the total project cost of **ONE MILLION PESOS** (Php 1,000, 000.00)
- Section 1.2** Of the total project cost, the **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** shall make available to the **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY** the amount of **ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS** (Php 1,000, 000.00) sourced from the **LGSF** of the National Government.
- Section 1.3** Any variation to the subproject/s design during the course of implementation should first seek the review and conformity of the **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** and should only be limited to the subproject allocation stipulated in Section 1.1 above. Any Variation Order resulting to an increase in the subproject allocation cost shall be borne by the **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER**.

Article II

OTHER COVENANTS

- Section 2.1** The **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY** shall take out and maintain with responsible insurers such insurances, against such risk and in such amounts as shall be consistent with appropriate government and/or business practices to cover.
- a. Hazards incidental to acquisition, transportation and delivery of goods financed out of the Fund to the place of installation.
 - b. Risk of fire, flood and other damages to the facilities constructed in whole or part out of the Fund.
- Section 2.2** Any notice or request or permit to be given or made in this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given or made when it is delivered, in this case if **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER**, to Cagayan de Oro City Hall, Capistrano St., Cagayan de Oro City and in the case of the **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY**, to Cagayan de Oro Water District, Corrales Avenue, Cagayan de Oro City, or such other addresses which the parties hereto may specify in writing.
- a. Any actions required or permit to be taken, and any documents required or permitted to be executed under this Agreement on behalf of **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** may be taken or executed by **City Mayor Oscar S. Moreno** or such persons as he shall designates in writing.
 - b. Any action required or permits to be taken, and any documents required or permitted to be executed under this Agreement on behalf of **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY** may be taken or executed by the **ENGR. BIENVENIDO V. BATAR, JR** or such persons as she shall designate in writing.
- Section 2.3** By mutual consent, this Agreement or any part thereof may be changed, modified, revised and amended or supplemented for the purpose of effective implementation and management of the Subproject/s. All other parties concerned shall be notified/ informed or of such changes, revisions and amendments.

Section 2.4 all disputes or controversies between the parties arising out or in connection with this Agreement, which is not settled, between the parties shall be elevated to appropriated competent authorities;

Article III

TERMINATION OR SUSPENSION

Section 3.1 The **IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** reserves the right to:

a. Terminate/Cancel the implementation of the subprojects in the following instances:

- **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY's** non – compliance to prescribed processes, standards and requirements;
- Occurrence of fraudulent practices;
- Occurrence of force majeure where it becomes improbable for the projects to continue to be carried out;

In such case that the subproject/s are partially or fully cancelled due to the fault of the **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY**, the **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY** shall be obliged to return the spent amount and the unexpected balance of the released portion of the funds of the pertinent portions related to the cancelled component.

b. Suspend/Withhold the release of the final tranche in the following occurs:

- The **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY** is performing unsatisfactory in the implementation and execution of the project or in the event that substantial slippage in implementation is incurred.
- Extraordinary conditions such as force majeure, fortuitous events and the like which shall make it necessary to suspend the implementation of the project.

Section3.2 The **IMPLENTING AGENCY** will be given one month to resolve the issue, improve performance or remedy the situation. However, termination will be resorted to only, if the **IMPLEMENTING AGENCY**, having been duly notified, does not make any effort to institute measure that will address issues at hand.

Article IV

ANTI-GRAFT AND CORRUPTION PRACTICES ACT

Section 4.1 Neither of the parties of this Agreement shall unduly benefit from each other nor gain anything which is disadvantages to the Government, and in violation of Republic Act No. 3019, as amended, otherwise known as the Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act.

Article V

EFFECTIVITY OF THE AGREEMENT

Section 5.1 This Agreement shall take effect immediately upon approval and signing by the contracting parties and shall remain in force and effect until the completion of the subproject/s and the requirements stipulated under this MOA and the accompanying Guidelines in the Management of BUB Subprojects, unless sooner terminated.

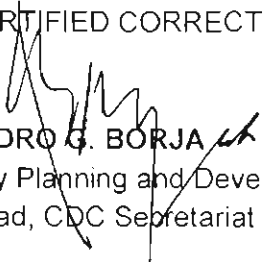

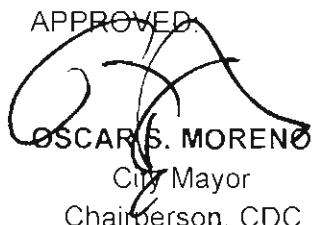

"JUDGMENT

Parties submitted to this court a Compromise Agreement which states as follows:

In the scheduled Preliminary Conference, parties however entered into a settlement under the following terms and conditions:

1. That the defendants undertake to vacate the property subject of the complaint on or before April 15, 2011;
2. That as soon as defendants vacate, plaintiff undertakes to extend to the said named defendants by way of assistance an amount of ₱ 2,500.00;
3. That of the named defendants the following, however, believes that the respective structures were outside of the property subject of this complaint hence, a survey shall be conducted by the City Government to determine whether or not their structures were inside the property and shall be established that they are inside the said defendants undertake to vacate or remove their structures

6. That the parties pray for the approval of the compromise agreement and that the approval of the same shall put an end to this litigation except for purposes of execution in case of non-compliance of the above-stated conditions.

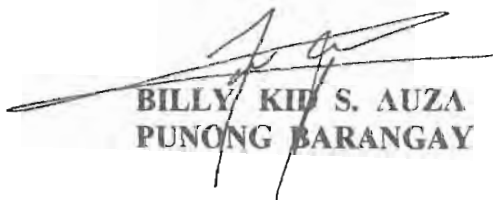
