



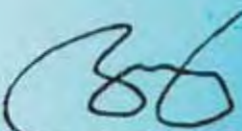

ORDINANCE NO. 13459-2018

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING ADDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES AS SPECIFIED HEREIN ON HOSPITALS OR MEDICAL CLINICS IN CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY WHOSE OFFICIAL, MEDICAL PRACTITIONER OR EMPLOYEE REFUSES TO ADMINISTER APPROPRIATE INITIAL MEDICAL TREATMENT AND SUPPORT IN EMERGENCY CASES IN VIOLATION OF R.A. NO. 8344

Whereas, Section 10 in the Declaration of Principles and State Policies of the Constitution provides: “The State shall provide social justice in all phases of national development”;

Whereas, Section 15 of Article II of the Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

Whereas, Article XIII, Section 11 of the Constitution further provides that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children;

Whereas, R.A. No. 8344 penalizes the refusal of hospitals and medical clinics to administer appropriate initial medical treatment and support in emergency or serious cases;

Whereas, it is imperative to strengthen the implementation of RA 8344 in Cagayan de Oro City;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the 18th City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) of Cagayan de Oro in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the “**Enhanced No Deposit Ordinance of 2018**”.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION. – As far as practicable, the pertinent provisions of R.A. 8344, entitled: “*An Act Penalizing the Refusal of Hospitals and Medical Clinics to Administer Appropriate Initial Medical Treatment and Support in Emergency or Serious Cases, Amending for the Purpose Batas Pambansa Bilang 702, Otherwise Known as "An Act Prohibiting the Demand of Deposits or Advance Payments for the Confinement or Treatment of Patients in Hospitals and Medical Clinics in Certain Cases"*”, are hereby adopted by reference.

SECTION 3. PENALTIES. – (A) Any official, medical practitioner or employee of the hospital or medical clinic in Cagayan de Oro City who violates the provisions of RA 8344 by failing to administer appropriate initial medical treatment and support in emergency or serious cases shall be penalized in the manner prescribed by Section 4 of RA 8344.

(B) In addition, there shall be imposed the following administrative penalties on hospital or medical clinic in Cagayan de Oro City whose official, medical practitioner or employee is found violating the provisions of RA 8344, to wit:

- (a) First Offense - a fine of ₱5,000.00 plus stern warning;



- (b) Second Offense - a fine of ₱5,000.00 plus suspension for five (5) days of business permit;
- (c) Third & Subsequent Offenses - a fine of ₱5,000.00 plus suspension for ten (10) days of business permit;

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. – If any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by competent authority, other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All provisions of ordinances and local orders including rules and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. – This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation.

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING made and entered into by and among:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, a local government unit, established and organized under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at City Hall, Cagayan de Oro City, herein represented by **Hon. OSCAR S. MORENO**, City Mayor, authorized to enter this Memorandum of Agreement (MOU) pursuant to Resolution No. _____ Series of 2018, of the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* of Cagayan de Oro, and hereinafter referred to as "CDO";

and

The **CITY SCHOOLS DIVISION OF CAGAYAN DE ORO** of the DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DEPED), a national government agency established and organized under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at Fr. William Masterson's Elementary School, Upper Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, herein represented by **Dr. JONATHAN S. DELA PEÑA, PH.D.**, Schools Division Superintendent, and hereinafter referred to as "DepEd";

WITNESSETH: That,

WHEREAS, CDO, under the present administration considers Education as a crucial component under its Eight-point Agenda;

WHEREAS, CDO is committed to promote quality basic education in the local government unit, particularly, for the benefit of young children belonging to the marginalized sector;

WHEREAS, CDO is desirous to collaborate with the stakeholders to address the need to bring basic education at the relocation sites of the city government;

WHEREAS, DepEd "formulates, implements, and coordinates policies, plans, programs and projects in the areas of formal and non-formal basic education";

WHEREAS, DepEd, pursuant to its mandate and in compliance with the pertinent provisions of R.A. 10533, otherwise known as the "Education Act of 2013" and R.A. 10157, otherwise known as the "Kindergarten Education Act", respectively, is eager to collaborate with CDO in its local education program;

WHEREAS, CDO, owns a six (6) classroom school building at its relocation site at Oro Habitat Phase I, five of which can be used for Kindergarten and Grade 1 pupils at;

WHEREAS, DepEd is willing to operate the above-mentioned school and provide teaching staff and other required facilities thereat;

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is needed to establish the respective undertakings of the **PARTIES** intended to address the needs of the said school and its pupils;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the above named PARTIES agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1

OBJECTIVE

The overall objective of the collaboration is to enhance and strengthen the quality of early education of the young learners at Habitat Phase I and Phase II, Brgy. Indahag, this city;

ARTICLE 2

OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONCERNED PARTIES

Section 1. Joint Obligations and Responsibilities of CDO and DepEd:

- 1. Ensure that the schools would be compliant with government standards;
- 2. Ensure the safety of the pupils, teachers and the school facilities; and
- 3. Forged strong linkages with the stakeholders to address the needs of the school and its pupils.

Section 2. Obligations and Responsibilities of CDO:

- 1. Allow DepEd the use of five of the six classrooms of its building located at Habitat Phase I Relocation site for Kindergarten and Grade One pupils from the said area;
- 2. Assign security personnel at the building; and
- 3. Undertake the necessary repairs and maintenance works on the buildings and its premises.

Section 3. Obligations and Responsibilities of DepEd:

- 1. Provide the needed Teaching staff at the said school;
- 2. Pay the water and electric bills to be taken from the funds under the Maintenance and other Operating Expenses budget of the Indahag Elementary School; and
- 3. Submit to CDO regular updates on the progress/development of the school, including other appropriate recommendation.

Section 4. No Employer-Employee Relationship. This MOU does not create an employer-employee relationship between the CDO and its officials with Teaching staff and other personnel provided by DepEd.

Section 5. Right to Revoke, Revise, Amend or Rescind. Either party may revoke, revise, amend or rescind the MOA by giving at least six (6) months prior notice to the other PARTY.

Section 6. Right to Renew. This MOU is subject to review and renewal every two (2) years from its effectivity.

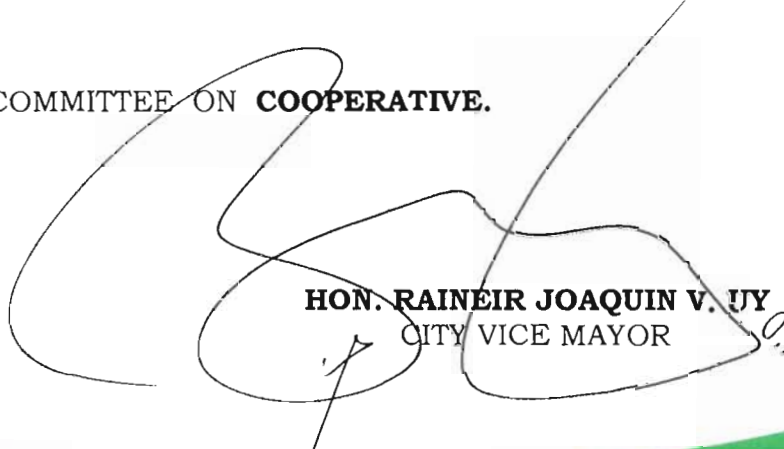

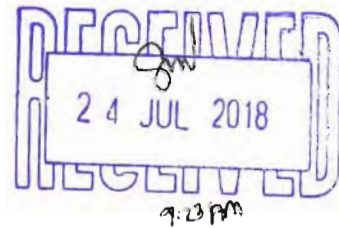

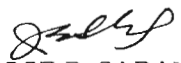

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. _____, dated _____, passed by the *Sangguniang Panlungsod*, City Mayor Hon. Oscar S. Moreno, has been authorized to sign, execute and deliver this Deed of Usufruct for and in behalf of the **OWNER**;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. _____, dated _____, passed by the **USUFRUCTUARY**, Chairman Quirino Ravelo has been authorized to enter into, sign and accept in behalf of the said cooperative;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the **PARTIES** hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. **TERM** - The term of the usufruct shall be for ten (10) years, renewable at the discretion of the **OWNER**. The **USUFRUCTUARY** is hereby given the right and privilege to use the above-mentioned lot as the area where it will construct its building and establish its office, and conduct livelihood projects. The facility is intended as an appropriate working area to enhance the efficiency and productivity to its members;
2. **OWNERSHIP** - while the usufruct and/ or the beneficial use of the Area is transferred to **USUFRUCTUARY**, the ownership and title of the land remains with and continues to be in the name of the **OWNER**. Upon the expiration or non-renewal of the contract, improvements introduced on the Area shall accrue to the City Government;
3. **PURPOSE** - The establishment of the usufruct is to support the livelihood projects/ activities for the common benefit of **USUFRUCTUARY** members, and shall remain as such throughout the duration of this contract. No person nor member of the **USUFRUCTUARY** will be allowed to reside within the premises of the Area;
4. **NON-USAGE** of the Area by the **USUFRUCTUARY** for the maximum period of three (3) years will automatically revert the property back to **OWNER**, as well as the right of possession thereon;
5. **OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS**:

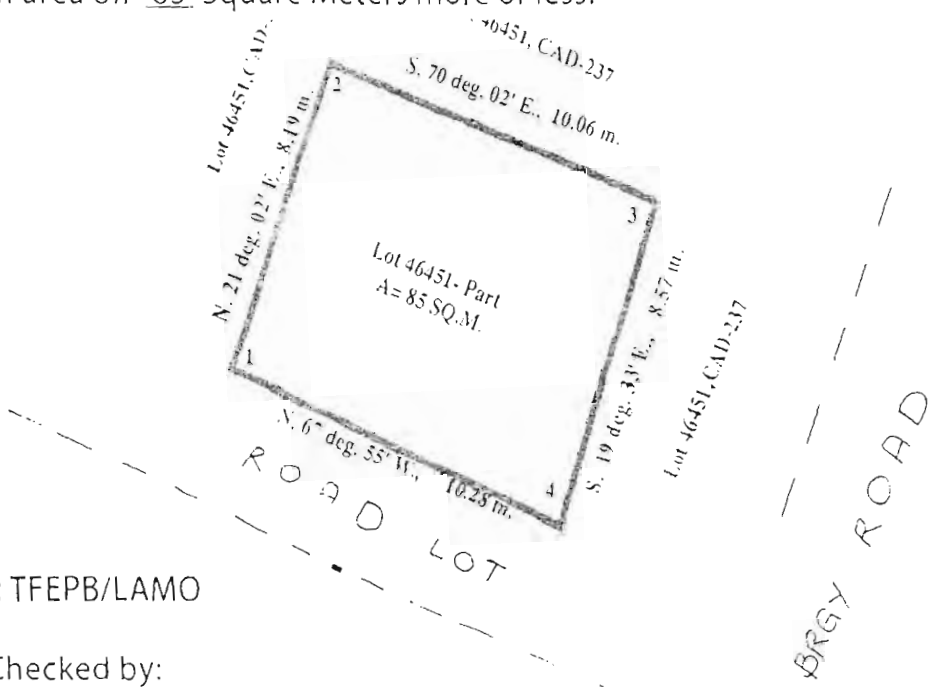

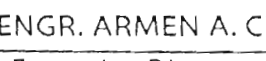

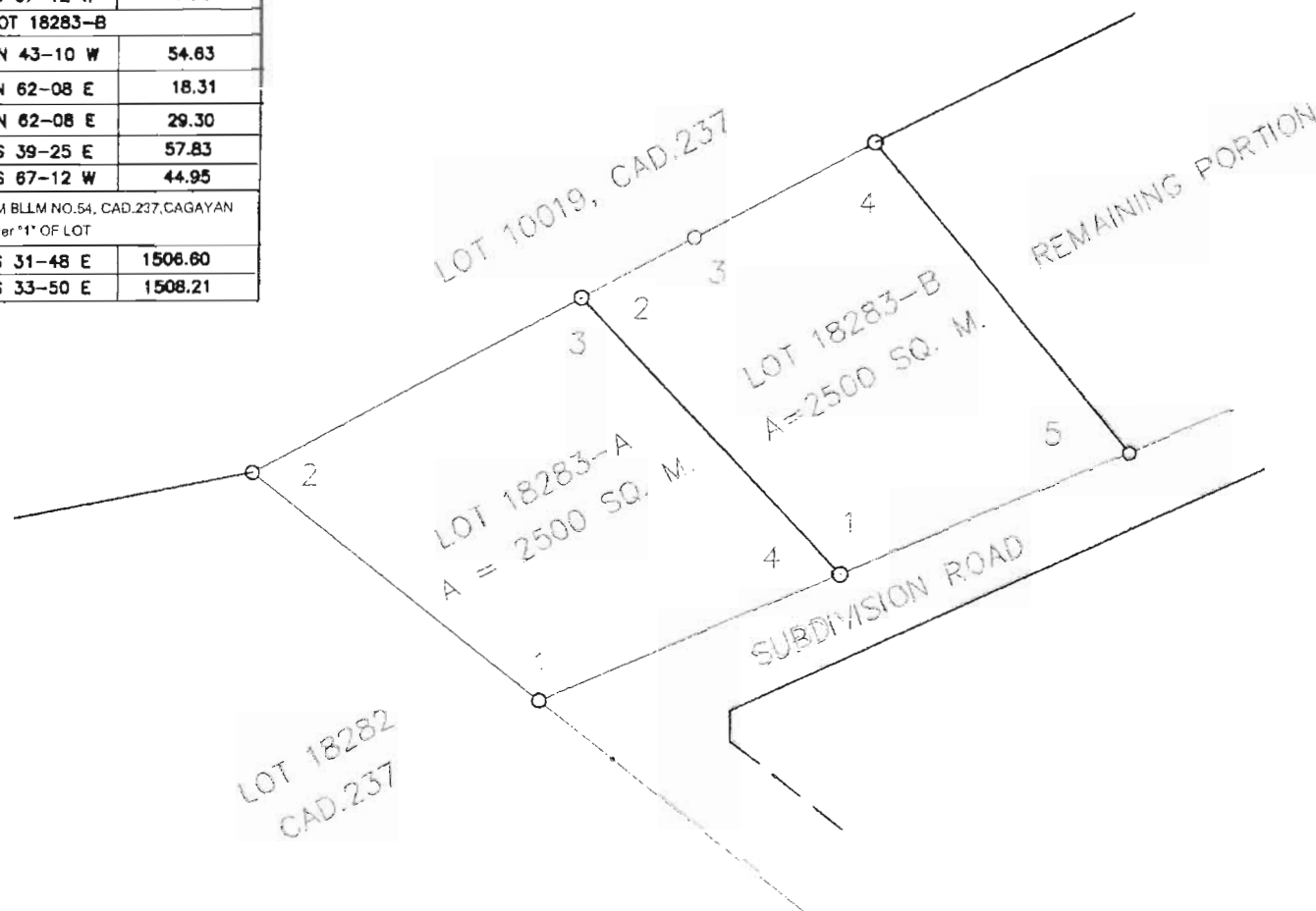

SKETCH PLAN

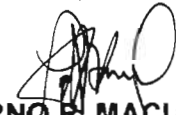

After a careful review of the draft of the proposed ordinance, I find its provisions to be in order and not contrary to the Constitution, existing laws, public moral, good customs, public order, or public policy.

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**AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE CAGAYAN DE ORO
TECHNICAL VOCATIONAL INSTITUTE (CDO-TVI); APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

*Introduced by Councilor Suzette G. Magtajas-Daba and co-introduced by Councilors
George S. Goking, Jay R. Pascual and John Michael L. Seno*

~~Whereas~~, "Education has been considered as a great equalizer" and a proven effective program in breaking the cycle of poverty;

~~Whereas~~, the city government has been nationally recognized for its successful Education program which resulted in its being awarded with the Seal of Good Education Governance;

~~Whereas~~, there is a need to sustain the gains achieved by the local government unit through the expansion of its Education program by providing technical skills and vocational training to its constituents to enable them to answer the need for such market demands locally and internationally;

~~Whereas~~, the City Government, in collaboration with the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and other concerned government agencies, as well as the stakeholders, will undertake the lead role in developing technical and vocational work force in the local government unit (LGU) by establishing a Training School for such purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the 18th City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) of Cagayan de Oro in its session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the Cagayan de Oro Technical Vocational Institute Charter, or CDO-TVI Charter for brevity.

SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT. – The Cagayan de Oro Technical Vocational Institute is hereby created and established as a technical vocation school, owned and operated by the City Government of Cagayan de Oro.

SECTION 3. GENERAL MANDATE. – (a) The Cagayan de Oro Technical Vocational Institute (CDO-TVI) shall undertake center-based and community-based skills and livelihood, and other related trainings through technical-vocational and skills development programs for students from low-income families, out-of-school youths and the marginalized sector. CDO-TVI will play a crucial role in helping the said students and other trainees become productive, self-reliant and transformed into middle-level skilled labor force and meet the demands of both local and international labor markets, resulting in the enhancement of the social and economic development in the local government unit and the neighboring areas.

(b) The CDO-TVI shall also offer school-based, Mobile Training Program (MTP), enterprise-based, community-based, entrepreneurial, technical, vocational education skills development curricula adopting the Unified TVET Programs Registration and Accreditation Systems (UTPRAS) of the Technical Education & Skills Development

50 Authority (TESDA) and the Senior High School Curriculum of the Department of
51 Education and the Commission of Higher Education (CHED) for its ladderized degree
52 courses. In addition, it shall serve as Assessment Center and Training Methodology (TMI)
53 Center for acquired competencies in technical-vocational skills to qualify and certify
54 middle level manpower for employment.

55
56 **SECTION 4. CURRICULAR OFFERINGS.** – The Cagayan de Oro Technical
57 Vocational Institute (CDO-TVI) shall offer short-term courses in preferred market-driven
58 and relevant technical-vocational courses within its areas of specialization in consultation
59 with Technical Education Skills and Development Authority (TESDA), the Department of
60 Labor and Employment (DOLE), Cagayan de Oro Technical Education and Skills
61 Development Committee (CTESDEC), and such other relevant agencies, both local and
62 international.

63
64 **SECTION 5. SCHOOL SITE.** – The Cagayan de Oro Technical Vocational Institute
65 (CDO-TVI) shall be established at the old site of the Agusan National High School at Zone
66 2, Brgy. Agusan, this City, and such other sites as the Board of Trustees may decide.

67
68 **SECTION 6. GOVERNING BOARD** - The governing body of the CDO-TVI shall be
69 its Board of Trustees (BOT). It shall promulgate policies in accordance with the declared
70 state policies on technical vocational education, as well as the policies, standards, and
71 thrusts of TESDA, and other pertinent provisions of existing laws and city ordinances.

72
73 **SECTION 7. COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES** - The Board of Trustees
74 shall be composed of the City Mayor as Chairperson; the Executive Director of the CDO-
75 TVI as Vice Chairman and the Deputy Executive Director as Co-Vice Chairman,
76 respectively; and ten (10) members composed of the following:

- 77
78 a) Chairman of the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* Committee on Education;
79 b) Chairman of the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* Committee on Youth;
80 c) Chairman of the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* Committee on Trade and
81 Commerce;
82 d) Representative from the Department of Education (DepEd);
83 e) President of the Alumni Association;
84 f) Representative from the Technical Education Skills Development Authority
85 (TESDA);
86 g) Chairperson of the City Technical Education Skills Development and
87 Employment Committee (CTESDEC);
88 h) President, AMORTVET, Inc.;
89 i) Representative from the Oro Chamber of Commerce;
90 j) Representative Filipino-Chinese Chamber of Commerce in Cagayan de Oro
91 City.

92
93 The TESDA, Oro Chamber of Commerce and the Filipino-Chinese Chamber of
94 Commerce representatives shall serve for a specific term as prescribed by the Board, while
95 the representatives from the alumni association shall be co-terminus with their respective
96 terms of office.

97
98 In case of vacancy in the Board of Trustees by reason of resignation, death, or other
99 incapacity of one or more of its members, such vacancy shall be filled-up by appointment

100 by the City Mayor in his capacity as Chairperson of the Board, with the concurrence of the
101 Board. The appointee shall hold office for the unexpired portion of the term.

102
103 The members shall serve without compensation but will be entitled to reasonable
104 allowances or honoraria for attendance at meetings of the Board or on other official
105 business, provided that the same are authorized by resolution of the Board, subject to
106 availability of funds.

107
108 The Secretary of the Board shall be designated by the Board. He/She shall keep all
109 records of proceedings of the Board and such other official records as may be directed by
110 the Board.

111
112 **SECTION 8. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES** - Subject to
113 existing laws and subject to the review by and approval of the *Sangguniang Panlungsod*, the
114 Board of Trustees herein created shall have the following powers and duties in addition to
115 its general powers of administration:

- 116
117 a) To enact rules and regulations not contrary to law as may be necessary to carry
118 out the purposes and functions of the CDO-TVI;
- 119 b) To formulate such policies, guidelines, rules and regulations consistent with the
120 purposes of CDO-TVI towards ensuring proper and judicious administration and
121 operation of thereof;
- 122 c) To receive and appropriate to the ends specified by this ordinance such sums as
123 may be provided hereof for the support of the CDO-TVI;
- 124 d) To establish academic and technical-vocational courses most needed in the
125 community and in the local or international market, as may be determined in
126 consultation with the stakeholders in the community;
- 127 e) To confirm all appointments made by the City Mayor for the position of trainers,
128 as endorsed by the Selection Committee created herein;
- 129 f) To fix and adjust wages of trainers and administrative officials and employees
130 including honoraria and other emoluments of lecturers/trainers subject however
131 to the provisions governing those hired without employer-employee relationship;
- 132 g) To set policies and guidelines for CDO-TVI faculty, students, and non-teaching
133 personnel;
- 134 h) To fix the tuition fees and other school charges, such as but not limited to
135 matriculation fees, graduation fees and laboratory fees, as the Board may deem
136 proper to impose after due consultations with the involved sectors; Provided, that
137 these fees will not be prohibitive or unreasonable as to deviate from the purpose
138 for which the CDO-TVI is created.

139 Such fees and charges, including government subsidies and other income
140 generated by the CDO-TVI, shall constitute a special trust funds and shall be
141 deposited in any authorized government depository bank, and all interests that
142 shall accrue therefrom shall form part of the same fund for the use of the CDO-
143 TVI.

144 Any provision or existing laws, rules and regulations to the contrary
145 notwithstanding, any income generated by the CDO-TVI from tuition fees and
146 other charges, as well as from the operation of auxiliary services and land grants,
147 shall be retained by the CDO-TVI, and may be disbursed by the Board for
148 instruction, research, extension services, or other programs/projects of the CDO-

149 TVI: Provided, that all fiduciary fees shall be disbursed for the specific purpose
150 for which they are collected.

151
152 If, for reason of control, CDO-TVI shall be able to pursue any project for
153 which funds have been appropriated and allocated under its approved program of
154 expenditures, the Board may authorize the use of said funds for any reasonable
155 purpose which, in each discretion, may be necessary and urgent for the
156 attainment of objectives and goals of the CDO-TVI;

- 157
158 i) To adapt and implement a socialized scheme of tuition and school fees for greater
159 access to poor but deserving students;
- 160 j) To authorize the construction or repair of its building, machineries, equipment,
161 and other facilities, as well as the purchase and acquisition of real personal
162 properties, including necessary supplies, materials, and equipment;
- 163 k) To approve the curricula, and institutional programs of the institution: Provided,
164 that it conforms to the TESDA guidelines.
- 165 l) To approve rules of discipline for the administrative and academic staff of CDO-
166 TVI to ensure orderly and effective governance thereof;
- 167 m) To set policies on admission and graduation of students;
- 168 n) To establish research and extension centers of the CDO-TVI where such will
169 promote the development of the latter;
- 170 o) To enter into joint ventures/agreements with business and industry for the
171 profitable development and management of the economic assets of the CDO-
172 TVI, the proceeds from which to be used for the development and strengthening
173 of the CDO-TVI;
- 174 p) To develop consortia and other forms of linkages with the local government units,
175 institutions and agencies, both public and private, local and foreign, in
176 furtherance of the purposes and objectives of the institutions;
- 177 q) To develop academic arrangements for institution capability building with
178 appropriate institutions and agencies, public or private, local or foreign, and to
179 appoint experts/specialists as consultants, or visiting or exchange professors,
180 scholars, researchers, as the case may be;
- 181 r) To set up the adoption of modern and innovative modes of transmitting
182 knowledge such as the use of information technology, the dual training system,
183 open learning, community laboratory, etc., for the promotion of greater access to
184 education within the institution; and
- 185 s) To establish policy guidelines and procedures for participative decision making
186 and transparency within the institution.

187
188 **SECTION 9. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD** - The Board of Trustees shall hold
189 quarterly meetings, the date of which to be set by the Board, and special meetings as may be
190 called by the Chairperson.

191
192 **SECTION 10. COMPENSATION** - Subject to subsequent compliance with TESDA
193 requirements and when CDO-TVI financial resources permit as certified by the City
194 Accountant, the Board of Trustees shall, in the interim, appoint the CDO-TVI Executive
195 Director/Deputy Executive Director. He/She may be entitled to receive monthly

196 honorarium as determined by the Board subject to Commission on Audit (COA) Rules and
197 Regulations.

198
199 **SECTION 11. ADMINISTRATION OF THE CDO-TVI.** – (a) The administration and
200 operations of the Cagayan de Oro Technical Vocational Institute (CDO-TVI) shall be
201 handled by the Executive Director and supported by the Deputy Executive Director. Both
202 shall be appointed by the City Mayor in accordance with the standard set qualification
203 requirements by the governing board and pertinent laws. Administrative support will be
204 provided by the office personnel.

205
206 b) The Executive Director /Deputy Executive Director of the CDO-TVI shall have a term
207 of five (5) years and shall be eligible for reappointment for another term. Both shall
208 hold an appropriate earned masteral degree and should have at least five (5) years of
209 relevant administrative experience, without prejudice to the provisions of additional
210 qualifications to be set by the governing of the board of the CDO-TVI.

211
212 c) In case of vacancy in the Office of the Executive Director/Deputy Executive Director by
213 reason of death, compulsory retirement, resignation, removal for cause or incapacity to
214 perform the functions of his/her office, the City Mayor shall have the authority to
215 designate an Officer-In-Charge of the CDO-TVI pending the appointment of a new
216 Executive Director.

217
218 d) The powers and duties of the Executive Director/Deputy Executive Director, in
219 addition to those specially provided in this Ordinance, shall be those usually pertaining
220 to the Office of the President of other colleges, and those delegated by the Board. The
221 salary of the Executive Director/Deputy Executive Director of CDO-TVI shall be set by
222 the Board, taking into consideration the applicable civil service rules and regulations
223 and ensuring that the same be comparable to that being received by the presidents of
224 similar educational institutions.

225
226 e) For the effective operation of the CDO-TVI, the trainers, non-teaching personnel and
227 such other officials and employees shall be recommended by the Executive Director as
228 confirmed by the Board, taking into consideration the recommendation of the Selection
229 Committee. The appointments of these CDO-TVI officials and employees shall be in
230 conformity to existing civil service laws, rules and regulations.

231
232 **SECTION 12. SELECTION COMMITTEE** - The selection committee referred to in
233 Section 8(e) is hereby created and shall be composed of the following:

- 234
235 a) Executive Director;
236 b) Deputy Executive Director;
237 c) Chairman of the *Sanggunian* Committee on Education;
238 d) Board Secretary, and
239 e) Focal Person for Education, Office of the City Mayor

240
241 They shall elect from among themselves the Committee Chairperson.

242
243 **SECTION 13. APPROPRIATIONS.** – The City Mayor shall include in the City
244 Government's program the implementation of this Ordinance, the funding of which shall
245 be included in the annual Budget of the City Government.

247 **SECTION 14. ACADEMIC FREEDOM AND INSTITUTIONAL AUTONOMY.** - The
248 CDO-TVI shall enjoy academic freedom and institutional autonomy, pursuant to
249 Paragraph 2, Section 5 of Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the
250 Philippines.

251
252 **SECTION 15. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS.** – After the effectivity
253 of this Ordinance, the Local Chief Executive (LCE), in coordination with the TESDA and
254 DepEd, CTESDEC, and such other relevant government agencies, and stakeholders, shall
255 formulate and issue the necessary rules and regulations for the implementation of this
256 Ordinance.

257
258 **SECTION 16. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** – If, for any reason, any section or provision
259 of this Ordinance shall be deemed unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or
260 provisions hereof shall not be affected and shall thereby remain in force and effect.

261
262 **SECTION 17. REPEALING CLAUSE.** – All existing ordinances and orders contrary
263 to or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified
264 accordingly.

265
266 **SECTION 18. EFFECTIVITY.** – This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
