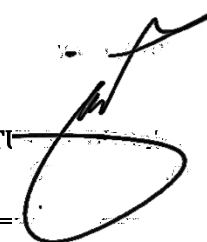

SECTION 1. The application of Sunberry Homes, Incorporated, represented by Jojie M. Tagalangit, for Preliminary Approval and Locational Clearance (PALC) of Sweetberries Community Subdivision Project, with an area of 49,377 square meters, containing 786 lots/units, located in Barangay Lumbia, this City, is hereby approved, subject to the following conditions:

- b) Non-compliance therewith shall be cause for cancellation or legal action and disapproval of Development Permit;
- c) This clearance does not exempt the project from pertinent requirements from line agencies;
- d) Any misrepresentation or materials falsehood on their part shall be a sufficient cause for the cancellation of this approval and or legal action;
- e) Pertinent provisions of BP220 and PD 1096 and their Implementing Rules and Regulations shall be complied with; and
- f) Remarks of the City Engineering Office shall be considered during the development stage, to wit:
 - i. Secure lot certification from this office, to determine whether the applied area is affected or not by any future development of the City;
 - ii. Consider the required volume capacity of detention pond based on a minimum of 2% of the applied area;
 - iii. Indicate on plan the cleared right of way and drainage structure of offsite drainage to connect any existing waterway and/or functional drainage system. It should be duly delineated with technical description and shall form part of the plans for development;

Pursuant to Section 29¹ of the Local Government Code of 1991 which states that highly urbanized cities and independent component cities be independent of the province and considering that the City is identified as a highly urbanized city, this Office recommends that the designation given to the City as the second party thereto remove the appellation to the province of Misamis Oriental and be changed from "*Local Government Unit of Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental*" to "**Local Government Unit of Cagayan de Oro City**" or the "**City Government of Cagayan de Oro**" and be simply therein referred to as the "**City**."

¹ Local Government Code of 1991, Section 29.

Provincial Relations with Component Cities and Municipalities. - The province, through the governor, shall ensure that every component city and municipality within its territorial jurisdiction acts within the scope of its prescribed powers and functions. **Highly urbanized cities and independent component cities shall be independent of the province.**

2. As this is agreement is for the training of students as a requirement of their course curriculum, this Office recommends that the following provisions be added to the roles and responsibilities of the BukSU/University:

4. Assure that the student intern/s it will assign to the City will perform the services and participate in the activities and programs of the City with reasonable care, skill and diligence;
5. Assure that its employees, staff and/or coordinators of the On-the-Job Training are readily available for a conference to discuss certain concerns or issues that may arise during the duration of the effectivity of the MOA;
6. Retain the responsibility of evaluating, supervising and other academic or school responsibilities towards the student intern/s participating in the On-the-Job Training assigned at the City;
7. Hold the City free from any and all liabilities, damages, loss, injury and/or death whether arising from contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise as a result of the services being rendered herein or should it be the proximate cause thereof;
8. Retain the substituted parental authority towards the student intern/s during the course of their participation in the On-the-Job Training at the City.

3. Likewise, this Office recommends that the following provisions be included in the roles and responsibilities of the City:

7. In its discretion, allow the student intern/s to participate in appropriate professional learning experiences such as training, seminars, workshops and programs conducted thereat;
8. Guide and assist the student intern/s in the course of the student intern's participation in the On-The-Job Training while at the City's premises;
9. Reject or refuse entry, participation, and/or involvement of the persons listed by BukSU as student interns if they are deemed unfit, uncooperative or otherwise do not follow or observe its rules and regulations;
10. Assume only solidary liability with BukSU in case of any damages, loss, injury and/or death whether arising from contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise as a result of the services being rendered herein or should it be the proximate cause thereof;

4. We also recommend that a new section be included thereon reflecting general provisions for both parties stipulating, to wit:

C. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. This Agreement does not create an employer-employee relationship between the City, its

employees, agents or sub-contractors and the employees, staff, coordinators, participants and student interns of BukSU.

2. Either party may rescind this Agreement, in case of material breach which is not so remedied within reasonable time after due written notice (within 30 days). The parties may also mutually agree to terminate this agreement
3. Except as herein provided, neither party shall assign or transfer all or any part of its rights under this agreement without the prior written consent of the party concerned.
4. The regular court or competent quasi-judicial bodies of Cagayan de Oro City shall have the exclusive jurisdiction over any disputes and/or claims arising thereto.

5. For purposes of clarity and guidance to all parties, a section on the effectivity and duration of the Memorandum of Understanding is also hereby recommended providing as such:

D. EFFECTIVITY and DURATION

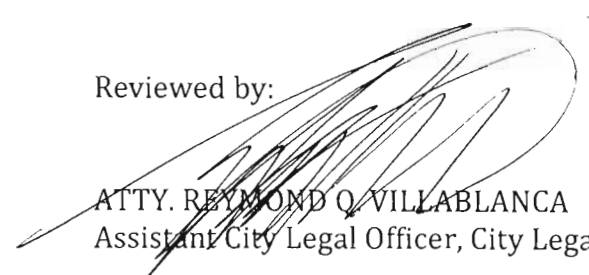

OSCAR B. CABAÑELEZ**, hereinafter referred to as **BukSU**;

The **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, MISAMIS ORIENTAL**, an organization duly-organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental represented by its City Mayor, **HON. OSCAR S. MORENO**, and herein referred to as **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, MISAMIS ORIENTAL**;

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, BukSU requires its graduating Sociology students to undergo an On-the-Job Training or OJT as part of the course curriculum;

WHEREAS, LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, MISAMIS ORIENTAL, is an organization whereby its functions and operations of which are appropriate for the graduating Sociology students;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, both parties agree to undertake this **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** under the following terms and conditions:

A. UNIVERSITY

1. That the university shall be responsible for briefing students on proper office decorum and basic work responsibilities.
2. That the university monitors the students through faculty supervisors or OJT Coordinator.
3. That the university shall voluntarily withdraw an On-Job Trainee who is found to misbehave and/or act in defiance to existing standards, rules, and regulations of **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, MISAMIS ORIENTAL**,

B. AGENCY

1. Assign work to students related to the student's course;
2. Sign the student's logbook and narrative report, the final requirement of the student;
3. Require the students to follow office rules/policies and standard operating procedures;
4. Evaluate the performance of the student by giving a grade ranging from 1.0 - 3.0, where 1.0 is the highest and 3.0 is the lowest;
5. Certify the total number of office hours that the students have rendered;
6. That the agency conducts its own orientation to the student-trainees on their duties and responsibilities.

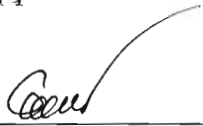

Subject : ADJUSTED FY 2019 INTERNAL REVENUE ALLOTMENT (IRA) SHARES OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (LGUs)

- 1.0 Section 89 of the General Provisions (GPs) of the FY 2018 General Appropriations Act (GAA), Republic Act (RA) No. 10964 provides, in part, that all valid adjustments, changes, modifications, or alterations in any of the factors affecting the computation of IRA that occurred or happened, including final and executory court decisions made effective, during the current fiscal year, shall only be considered and implemented by the DBM in the subsequent fiscal year from receipt by the DBM of the notice of said change.
- 2.0 Corollary thereto, the IRA shares of LGUs, which are automatically appropriated, shall be apportioned among LGUs, including provinces, cities, and municipalities created, approved, and ratified in 2018 in accordance with the allocation formula prescribed under Section 285 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA No. 7160).
- 3.0 Consistent with the foregoing, and by virtue of the enactment of the various laws, the barangays listed hereunder shall be included in the allocation of the FY 2019 IRA shares of LGUs:

- 6.0 The details by region and by level of LGU are provided in the attached Annex A. The LGUs shall be notified of their adjusted IRA shares by the DBM Regional Offices concerned.
- 7.0 Considering that the FY 2019 Annual Budgets of LGUs have been prepared/approved based on their computed IRA shares under LBM No. 77 dated May 15, 2018, all LGUs are hereby enjoined to adopt the appropriate measures resulting from the herein adjustments in their respective IRA shares, in accordance with the pertinent provisions of RA No. 7160 and other budgeting rules and regulations.
- 8.0 All other provisions of LBM No. 77, as supplemented by LBM No. 77-A dated July 24, 2018, which are not inconsistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 9.0 Please be guided accordingly.

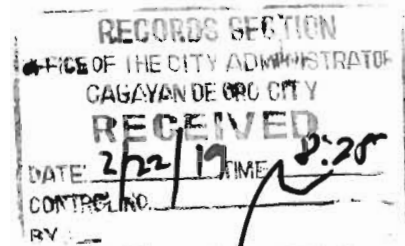

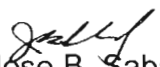

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This UNDERSTANDING made and executed by and between:

MASICAP MSME DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION, INC., a foundation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Philippines with principal office located at 1/F DBP Bldg., C.M. Recto Avenue, Davao City, represented herein by **MS. LEOSA NANETTE A. AGDEPPA**, in her capacity as President thereof, hereinafter referred to as the FOUNDATION,

- and -

LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, with office located at Capistrano Street, Cagayan de Oro City, represented herein by **HON. OSCAR S. MORENO**, in his capacity as City Mayor, herein referred to as **LGU – CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY**:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the FOUNDATION re-launched the Medium & Small Scale Industries Coordinated Action Program II (MASICAP II), following the same concept of the previously successful MASICAP program of the Department of Industry in 1974-1980 which harnesses the idealism, volunteerism and service orientation of graduating Business Administration, Commerce and Economics students trained to assist micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) in the preparation of feasibility studies and related documents for loan / grant applications with funding institutions;

WHEREAS, the FOUNDATION started MASICAP II pilot program in five provinces / cities in Southern Mindanao in August, 2002 with the approval of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), cooperation of selected participating schools, endorsements of local government officials and private business organizations, and funding mainly by the Chairman of the Foundation with limited contributions and volunteer work by MASICAP I alumni;

WHEREAS, results of MASICAP II pilot operations demonstrated its relevance and effectiveness in assisting small enterprises obtain loans / grants to start up / expand their business operations, resulting to the program's continuance / expansion in several provinces / cities in Mindanao for succeeding Fiscal Years.

WHEREAS, the LGU – CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY agrees to sign a Memorandum of Understanding to provide funds for the MASICAP program operations within the City for Fiscal Year August 1, 2018 – July 31, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, the FOUNDATION and LGU – CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, do hereby COVENANT and UNDERSTAND:

1. That the FOUNDATION shall provide one (1) team of three (3) technical personnel from among those trained by the FOUNDATION who will assist prospective proponent/s of MSMEs within the City of CAGAYAN DE ORO as its priority in the preparation of project feasibility studies and documents necessary for the availment of loans and/or assistance from banks and other funding agencies;
2. That the LGU shall contribute to the cost of fielding one (1) team assigned in its area of jurisdiction in the amount of THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND (Php380,000.00) PESOS, Philippines Currency, per year, which amount shall be remitted to the FOUNDATION, without need of demand, at the latter's office in Davao City, in the manner herein provided, to wit:

3. That the FOUNDATION shall identify the projects seeking assistance from the team(s) assigned in the herein LGU and shall submit from time to time a list of such projects to the LGU. The LGU will advise the Foundation of its ranking of socio-economic priorities and the Foundation will take such priorities into account in scheduling of assistance by the team(s) to the listed projects;
4. That the FOUNDATION is responsible for the supervision and control over the team(s) and the members thereof who are assigned in the herein LGU. Any complaints, suggestion and/or comments from the LGU on the work or project being undertaken by the teams and its members shall be promptly attended / implemented by the Foundation through corresponding directives / instructions to the team(s). Copies of such directives / instructions shall be immediately furnished to the LGU;
5. That the Foundation shall provide the herein LGU with a quarterly report on the accomplishment of the team(s) within the period herein stated and for the projects assisted by the FOUNDATION within the territorial jurisdiction of the herein LGU;
6. That this understanding shall be for a period of one year starting on August 1, 2018 and ending on July 31, 2019, renewable upon the mutual agreement of contracting parties, and that the City Mayor has the power to renew the contract;
7. That failure on the part of the herein LGU to comply with any of the terms and conditions herein stated, will produce, without need for notice and judicial order, the *ipso facto* recession and cancellation of this understanding, and the Foundation shall have the right, (within 30 days from written notice) to withdraw the team/s assigned in the herein LGU;
8. That the FOUNDATION shall hold the LGU free from any and all liabilities, damages, loss, injury and/or death whether arising from contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise as a result of the services being rendered herein by its

team / technical personnel or should it be the proximate cause thereof. Thus, the FOUNDATION shall be solidarity liable as provided herein;

9. That LGU may terminate or rescind this MOU, in this case of material breach which is not remedied within reasonable time after due written notice (within 30 days). The parties may also mutually agree to terminate this MOU;
10. This MOU does not create an employer – employee relationship between the FOUNDATION, its team, technical personnel, employees, agents or sub-contractors and the LGU, its officials, employees, agents or sub-contractors;
11. Except as herein provided, the FOUNDATION is prohibited from assigning or transferring all or any part of its rights under this MOU without the prior written consent of the LGU;
12. The regular court or competent quasi-judicial bodies of Cagayan de Oro City shall have the exclusive jurisdiction over any disputes and/or claims arising hereto.
