GREETINGS!

This is in response to your letter dated 25 July 2018 seeking for review and legal opinion on the herein attached Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) by and among Agricultural Training Institute (ATI), the City Agriculture Office, and Canitoan National High School for the implementation of "Glamourizing Farming through Urban Agriculture."

In this connection, kindly be informed that this Office has thoroughly reviewed the above-mentioned agreement and the following observations and recommendations are respectfully forwarded:

1. At the outset the office would like to emphasize that it should be the City Mayor, on behalf of the City or any of its departments, that should represent the City in any agreement or understanding whereby the City undertakes to perform certain obligations¹. In line with this, the section where the parties are enumerated should instead state the following:

"The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, through the City Agriculture Office headed by Hector R. San Juan, DVM, with official address at Kauswagan, Cagayan de Oro City, represented herein by City Mayor, **HON. OSCAR S. MORENO**, and hereinafter referred to as the **City Agriculture Office**;"

As such, it should also be the City Mayor's name, designation and signature, on behalf of the City Government of Cagayan de Oro which should appear under the signatories' portion of the said agreement.

¹ Paragraph (vi), (1), (b), Section 455, Local Government Code of 1991,

"(vi) Represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the sangguniang panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;"



2. In addition, the following provisions must be appended to Article V- General Provisions:

- a. A provision which should state that the said agreement does not create any employer-employee relationship between the parties stating, to wit:

“Section 3. This Agreement does not create an employer-employee relationship between the City Agriculture Office, its employees, agents or sub-contractors; ATI, its employees, staff and coordinators; and Canitoan National High School (CNHS), its teachers, participants and students.

- b. A provision which should state that the venue for any dispute or claim regarding this agreement shall be in Cagayan de Oro City stating, to wit:

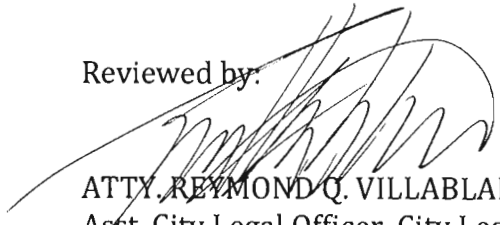

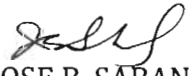

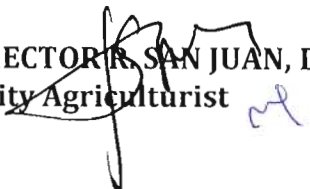

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and among:

The **AGRICULTURAL TRAINING INSTITUTE (ATI)**, the extension and training arm of the **Department of Agriculture**, through its **Regional Training Center-X** with official address at El Salvador City, Misamis Oriental represented by its OIC- Center Director, **MARIA LYDIA A. ECHAVEZ** and hereinafter referred to as **ATI**;

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, through the **City Agriculture Office** headed by Hector R. San Juan, DVM, with official address at Kauswagan, Cagayan De Oro City represented herein by City Mayor, **OSCAR S. MORENO** and hereinafter referred to as **City Agriculture Office**;

and

The **CANITOAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL**, with official address at Canitoan, Cagayan De Oro City represented by its Secondary School Head Teacher V, **LERIO A. DEL PUERTO** and hereinafter referred to as **CNHS**;

- WITNESSETH -

WHEREAS, **ATI** is the over-all extension and training arm of the Department of Agriculture and is mandated to train agricultural extension workers and their clientele including farmers and their families through appropriate training and extension activities;

WHEREAS, the **ATI** fully recognizes that the number of youth who manifest interest in agriculture and fisheries is dwindling, and that the youth has a very big important role in attaining food security and poverty alleviation in the country;

WHEREAS, the **City Agriculture Office**, is a department of the City Government of Cagayan de Oro, responsible for the provision of appropriate, time tested and technologically sound agricultural practices that promote resource conservation, and protection of the environment and the ecosystem;

WHEREAS, it is the role of the **City Agriculture Office** to encourage and assist the youth of Cagayan de Oro City to engage in agriculture and fishery activities not only on production but also on entrepreneurship;

WHEREAS, the **CNHS** is a public high school with the role of molding the young minds of the students and developing them into responsible citizens of the country;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, **ATI**, **City Agriculture Office**, and the **CNHS**, hereto decided to collaborate in disseminating and creating an environment that would bring back agriculture and urban gardening into the minds and hands of the youth.

ARTICLE I – THE PROJECT

ARTICLE I THE PROJECT

Section 1. Project Title. The Project shall be entitled “*Glamourizing Farming Through Urban Agriculture*”.

Section 2. Implementor. The Project shall be implemented by the ATI, the City Agriculture Office and the Canitoan National High School;

Section 3. Implementation. The Project shall be implemented within the months of August to December 2018;

Section 4. Modification. Modification of the agreements that is contained herein shall be allowed without the written consent of both **PARTIES** provided that it is jointly agreed.

ARTICLE II – OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT

This program envisions the urban youth to engage in urban agriculture by establishing urban gardens and instill 4-H thrusts by organizing 4-H Clubs in their own localities.

ARTICLE III – RESPONSIBILITIES OF EACH PARTY

SECTION 1. *Obligations of ATI*

- a. Provide orientation/seminar, training programs and extension needs of the target beneficiaries;
- b. Provide basic gardening tools, protective equipment, and supplies for gardening;
- c. Provide funds for the graduation ceremony/field day;
- d. Provide follow-up training programs needed by the beneficiaries/students;
- e. Provide PCIC insurance for the participating students;
- f. Conduct constant monitoring activities.

SECTION 2. *Obligations of the City Agriculture Office, Cagayan de Oro City*

- a. Initial coordination and identification of beneficiaries;
- b. Provide one Technical Staff to work on the whole program;
- c. Provide Resource Person/Lecturers on the needed subject matters
- d. Encourage participants/students to apply what they have learned in their respective homes or areas;
- e. Inform ATI of the other training needs of the participants/students;
- f. Conduct constant monitoring.

SECTION 3. *Obligation of the Canitoan National High School (CNHS), Canitoan, Cagayan de Oro City*

- a. Identify and allow the target students to participate in the program;
- b. Provide a space/area for demonstration projects of the students;
- c. Provide other needed materials for the construction of the demonstration garden, such as recyclable materials for gardening;
- d. Encourage the students to apply what they learned in their individual homes/areas;
- e. Conduct constant monitoring of the projects of the students;
- f. Assist the students in maintaining and sustaining the projects;
- g. Inform ATI of the training needs of the students to sustain the program.

ARTICLE IV – PERIOD OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless sooner terminated by mutual consent of all parties, provided a ten (10) working days written notice by any of the parties shall have been fully served to other Parties.

ARTICLE V

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Section 1.** This agreement and all rights and obligations hereunder, shall not be assigned by either of the parties hereto to another party unless otherwise permitted in the provision of this agreement or with the prior written consent thereto by the other parties.

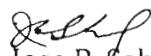

RATIONALE

The Processed Food is the secondary OTOP of Cagayan de Oro and the dominant Industry sector in the area, thus is given the priority for the development and assistance. One of the major concern identified by the sector is its competitive disadvantage in product quality and packaging. Our MSMEs in the package food sector are the interior and with its ASEAN counterpart when it comes to this and thus, the food sector will surely have difficulty competing when the ASEAN integration will be fully implemented.

At the bottom of this problem are the micro enterprises who lacks the capital in hurdling such a big challenge. Fortunately, MSMEs now has the ability to pack their products thru the food innovation, Packaging and Labeling Center. They can now use modern packaging equipment without buying an expensive one. Once sachet packing, nylon printing and custom fitted packaging seems too ambitious for simple MSME, but now it is already very doable.

This however is not the only challenge for MSMEs. Purchasing of packaging materials is also very expensive because suppliers require minimum order ranging from P 100, 000.00 – P 200, 000.00.

For this reason, this proposal is set forth to implement developmental programs for identified micro enterprises that will help them rise above the competition by addressing gaps in packaging, training or marketing.

OBJECTIVES

Generally the project aims to achieve the following:

- a. Generate P10 Million Sales thus increasing family income of impoverished families.
- b. Provide 200 jobs to unemployed
- c. Improve 145 MSMEs
- d. Assist 145 MSMEs

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** is entered into by and between:

The Regional Office of **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, REGIONAL OFFICE 10** with office address at Zone 1, Upper B, Cagayan de Oro City, represented by **DR. ARTURO B. BAYOCOT, CESO V, OIC - Regional Director**, hereinafter referred to as **DepEd**.

-and-

The **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY**, with office address at City Hall, Cagayan de Oro City, and represented Local Government Unit, created and operation under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, herein represented by its Mayor **Hon. OSCAR S. MORENO**, herein referred to as **Cagayan de Oro City**;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that, "the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them". Section 11 of the Article XIII thereof also provides that "the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health, and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost."

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) 7875, as amended by RA 10606, otherwise known as The National Health Insurance Act of 2013, UNDER Section 6 states that all citizens of the Philippines shall be covered by the National Health Insurance Program as implemented by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth);

WHEREAS, Section 3(c) of the same Act emphasizes the need to "prioritize and accelerate the provision of the health services to all Filipinos, especially that segment of the population who cannot afford such services;"

WHEREAS, pursuant to PhilHealth Board Resolution No. 1587 s. 2012 approving the Universal Health Care (UCH) Primary Care Benefit (PCB 1) Package as the new PhilHealth outpatient benefit package, the City of Cagayan de Oro fully supports PhilHealth as it endeavors to expand the PCB1 package to the employed sector.

WHEREAS, PhilHealth Circular No. 10, series 2013 provides for the expansion of its Primary Care Benefit (PCB1) [now called *Tamang Serbisyong Kalusugang Pampamilya (TSeKaP)*] to cover personnel of the DepEd on pilot testing basis;

WHEREAS, DepEd requires its teaching and non-teaching staff to undergo annual health check-up and PhilHealth recognizes this as an opportunity to support the health services of those who take care of our school children;

WHEREAS, the City of Cagayan de Oro operates and manages the J.R. Borja General Hospital (JRBGH), a government-owned hospital and operating under the mandate of the Department of Health. JRBGH is a primary-level hospital duly accredited by Philhealth to deliver its TSeKaP outpatient program.

WHEREAS, the City Health Office (CHO) delivers integrated public health and curative service to the people of Cagayan de Oro City, thereby promoting better health;

WHEREAS, DepEd has signified intent to engage Cagayan de Oro City's health care facilities as its TSeKaP provider as mandated by PhilHealth Circular No. 10, s, 2013 and Cagayan de Oro City through the CHO and JRBGH, is ready and willing to provide quality health care services to DepEd employees for this purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the **PARTIES** hereto agree as follows:

1. DepEd shall assign all their bonafide employees in the DepEd-Regional Office to its designated TSeKaP provider, which is the CHO/JRBGH;
2. DepEd, through its Administrative Division, shall endorse the list of personnel and its designated TSeKaP provider to PhilHealth;
3. DepEd personnel shall enlist themselves at the CHO/JRBGH based on a schedule formulated by DepEd, a copy of which will be provided to the City Health Insurance Office and to CHO/JRBGH;
4. CHO/JRBGH shall deliver TSeKaP program services (as mandated by PhilHealth Circular No. 10, s. 2013 and PhilHealth-DepEd Joint Circular No. 0001, s. 2014, both hereby made integral parts of this understanding) to all *bonafide* DepEd employees/beneficiaries as enumerated in the members' master-list provided by PhilHealth;
5. The CHO/JRBGH shall establish and maintain an individual health profile of DepEd employees and their dependents at least once a year;
6. The CHO/JRBGH shall render all the services and benefits in the PCB 1 program, which includes certain primary preventive services, obligated services, consultation, laboratory tests, drugs and medicines. A list of the services and benefits is herewith attached and is made integral part of this MOU.

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** shall take effect immediately upon the signing hereof by the parties.

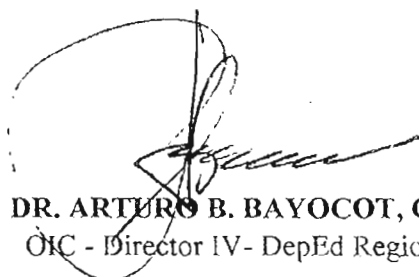

RESOLUTION NO. 004-18

BARANGAY RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR TO REQUEST JICA, DPWH AND RDC FOR THE IMMEDIATE COMPLETION OF THE MEGA DIKE PROJECT OF CAGAYAN DE IORO RIVER BY DECEMBER 2018 EVEN WITHOUT THE SIDE ROADWAY YET.

Whereas, the residents of low lying areas of Barangay Macasandig; Tibasak, Biasong, Tambo and Lower St. Ignatius suffered severe damages; loss of lives and properties during the occurrence of Sendong Flashflood last December 2011 and the 3 other flooding occurred between December 2017 and January 2018.

Whereas, sorrows/fears and traumas are now setting the minds of the said residents particularly if there are warnings of the coming LPAs and Typhoons announced.

Whereas, the demands of these residents through petition letters submitted to government concern agencies gained attention from the offices of DPWH, City Mayor and City Engineering and a dialogue and consultative meeting was called to discuss the status of Megadike Project held last March 3, 2018 at San Lorenzo Church, Biasong where the residents hysterically and emotionally expressed their experiences in fighting to escape the flood disaster and demanded for the immediate completion of the Megadike project.

Wherefore, on Motion made by Kagawad Amor G. Sanchez, duly seconded by all members of the Council be it:

Resolved, as the Barangay Council of Macasandig hereby resolved to: EARNESTLY REQUEST THE OFFICE OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR TO REQUEST JICA, DPWH AND RDC FOR THE IMMEDIATE COMPLETION OF THE MEGA DIKE PROJECT OF CAGAYAN DE IORO RIVER BY DECEMBER 2018 EVEN WITHOUT THE SIDE ROADWAY YET.

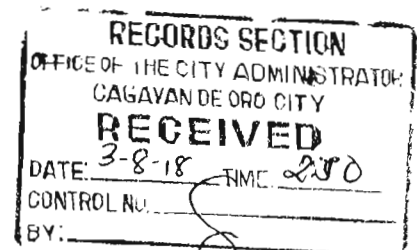

Greetings!

We, the residents of Tambo, Biasong, Lower St. Ignatius, SLR Homes, Tomas Saco 14, Lower de Lara St., Tibasak, Royal Palm Mansion, Sunshine Village, Golden Shower, Corona Drive, Sapphire Drive, Platinum Drive, Mediante Compound, Rainbow Drive, Agape Drive, Feroza Drive, St Cruz St., Immaculate Conception Village, Balangay Mouswag, and Palmera Drive of Barangay Macasandig, Cagayan de Oro City, whose signatures appear in the attachment, appeal to your good office to facilitate the implementation of measures, the construction of the dike and similar infrastructures that will mitigate the life threatening floods that now visit us regularly, be completed soonest. These floods also cause gradual deterioration of our momentarily undamaged properties which make them more vulnerable to similar events in the future.

The devastation brought about by typhoon Sendong in 2011, that was six years ago, has left a trauma in us that manifest as fear every time there is heavy rain, most especially during the supposedly merry months of December and January where typhoons normally come close or pass over Cagayan de Oro and Bukidnon. These fears are anchored on the fact that no concrete mitigating measures are in place yet. In fact, just few days ago, December 22, Typhoon Vinta created flood in our area with almost same intensity as Sendong. There were no casualties because we were lucky the flood happened in the morning, but still many of our properties got damaged. We were again lucky that Typhoon Agaton did not come near CDO on January 2, 2018, but we fear we might not be that lucky next time around.

Cagayan de Oro was formerly one of the best places to invest because of its abundance in clean water and being typhoon-free. Climate change has changed it all. A problem that man created that not our country nor the advance counties can solve nor reverse. As a reaction to the growing number and adverse impacts of global disasters, the International community adopted the Hyogo and later the Sendai risk reduction frameworks. And in choosing risk reduction measures, mitigation still strategically comes ahead of preparedness.

It is our prayer that you take our appeal with extreme urgency.
