Our estimated and realistic income for CY 2022 is higher compared to last year .Our desire is to make the barangay free from IRA dependence.

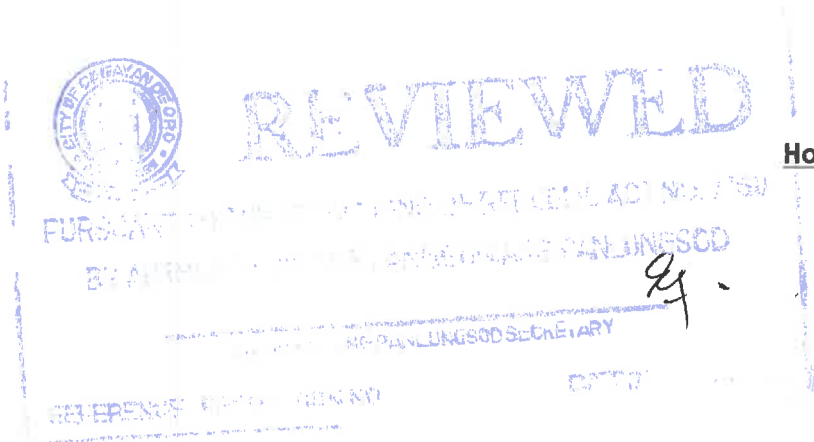

- 4. Strictly collect fees with the corresponding issuance of Officials Receipts.

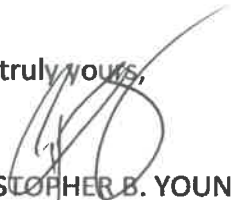
