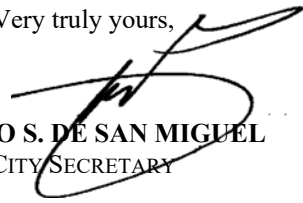

ORDINANCE NO. 13273-2017

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE BARANGAY TANOD DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE, PROVIDING ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS; PROVIDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BARANGAY TANODS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, the Barangay Police/Tanods are one of the major contributors and stakeholders in the implementation of the government's peace and order programs. They served the barangays on voluntary basis, risking their lives and limbs to preserve peace and order in their locality, for minimal or insignificant financial remuneration;

Whereas, the Barangay Police/Tanods are considered to be the agents of persons in authority who act as the front liners in the preparation and response to any type of atrocities, public disorders, emergencies and even disasters or man-made calamities that threaten peace and order and public safety. Their spirit of volunteerism and unwavering concern for the community deserves to be recognized and honored;

Whereas, it is imperative to create a committee that will coordinate all efforts and initiatives for the equal promotion and welfare of the Ronda Tanod;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) of the City of Cagayan de Oro in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. - TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the “**Barangay Tanod Development Committee Ordinance**” of Cagayan de Oro City.

SECTION 2. POLICY AND PRINCIPLES.-

- a) It is the duty of all citizens to promote peace and order in their respective communities;
- b) It is the duty of the local government and all concerned officials of Cagayan de Oro City to promote, enforce and maintain peace and order in their jurisdiction;
- c) Barangay authorities and concerned citizens play crucial roles in promoting, enforcing and maintaining peace and order in their respective communities;
- d) Laudable and commendable actions by barangay authorities for the promotion, enforcement and maintenance of peace and order in their areas deserve commendation and recognition so that they may motivate and inspire others to do the same.

SECTION 3. CREATION – There is hereby created the Barangay Tanod Development Committee as an Executive Committee to be composed of the following:

- (a) Chairperson - City Director, COCPO
- (b) Co-Chairperson - City DILG Director
- (c) Members:
 1. Chairperson, SP Committee on Police, Fire & Public Safety
 2. Chairperson, SP Committee on Finance, Budget & Appropriations
 3. President, Liga ng mga Barangay
 4. City Fire Marshall



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5. Department Head, Roads and Traffic Administration
6. City Legal Officer
7. Director, Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA)
8. 1 (one) NGO Representative selected from the City Peace and Order Council

The foregoing shall be appointed by the City Mayor for a term coterminous to his term of office.

SECTION 4. - DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE RONDA TANOD DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE:

- a) To coordinate closely with the barangay officials, Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCBP) and police/local authorities in the drive against all forms of crimes such as terrorism, smuggling, car napping, drug trafficking, drug pushing, illegal gambling, child abuse, crime against women, and all forms of vices and syndicated crimes;
- b) To coordinate and facilitate the various efforts, functions, and services of the different Ronda Tanod in the City in coordination with various agencies and organizations involved in the enforcement and implementation of all laws, ordinances, and programs against all forms of criminalities;
- c) To establish an insurance system for the legitimate members of Ronda Tanod in the City;
- d) To conceive and formulate a reward/award scheme for Ronda Tanod Unit/s and/or Ronda Tanod Member/s who have made a sterling performance of his duties and responsibilities.
- e) To train and teach the barangay tanods on community intelligence gathering and monitoring, and submit its report to the City Police Director for evaluation and verification;
- f) To enhance the ronda tanods skills on self-defense more particularly on arnis and karatedo and inculcate in them the doctrine of citizen's arrest;
- g) Others as maybe directed by the City Mayor and/or the City Council.

SECTION 5. HONORARIUM. – Each member of the Ronda Tanod Development Committee and its Secretary shall receive honorarium of ₱500.00 per meeting subject to limitations under budgeting and accounting guidelines.

SECTION 6. - FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO RONDA TANOD – There shall be granted financial assistance or honorarium to the members of the Ronda Tanod of the 80 barangays of Cagayan de Oro City at the rate of ₱500.00 each Ronda Tanod per month; *Provided, That* only 20 Ronda Tanods per barangay can avail of this financial assistance.

For this purpose, the barangay councils shall submit to the Ronda Tanod Development Committee through a barangay resolution their respective official list of the 20 Ronda Tanods recommended to avail of the financial assistance granted herein.

SECTION 7. BUDGETARY ALLOCATION. – There shall be a regular appropriation in the Annual Budget allocated for the operational expenses of the Ronda Tanod Development Committee and for the grant of financial assistance or honorarium to the Ronda Tanod pursuant to Section 5 hereof.

SECTION 10. - REPEALING CLAUSE. – All other ordinances, local issuances, rules and regulation, or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. - EFFECTIVITY. – This Ordinance shall take upon its approval.
