A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE PROPOSED INTEGRATED ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Whereas, Section 10 of the Republic Act 9003 otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 stipulates that the LGU shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this Act within their respective jurisdictions;

Whereas, Section 1 of the Rule IX of the Implementing Rules and Regulation of RA 9003 that the volume reduction at source shall be the first priority of the ESWM system. All LGUs shall actively promote among its constituencies that reduction and minimization of wastes generated at source;

Whereas, Section 20 of RA 9003 that each LGU plan shall include an implementation schedule which shows that within five (5) years after the effectivity of the this Act; the LGU shall divert at least 25% of all solid wastes from waste disposal facilities through re-use, recycling and composting activities and other resources recovery activities: Provided, That the waste diversion goals shall be increased every three (3) years thereafter;

Whereas, Section 458 of the RA 7160 that the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city as provided for under Section 22 of this Code;

Whereas, the proposed Integrated Ecological Solid Waste Management Ordinance of Cagayan de Oro shall be endorse to the Sangguniang Panlungsod;

Wherefore, with the motion of Engr. Isidro G. Borja of the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) and duly seconded by Atty. Ernesto B. Neri of Oro Youth Development Council and unanimously approved by all members present;

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PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2017-_____

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE INTEGRATED ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Introduced by Councilors Zaldy O. Ocon & Edna M. Dahino

BE IT ORDAINED by the 18th City Council (*Sangguniang Panlungsod*) of Cagayan de Oro in session duly assembled that:

Article I
Title, Mandates and Definition of Terms

SECTION 1. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known as the “INTEGRATED ECOLOGICAL SOLIDWASTE MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY”

SECTION 2. MANDATE:

- (a) Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2003, provides for an ecological solid waste management program, creates the necessary institutional mechanisms and incentives, declares certain acts prohibited and provides penalties for violations;
- (b) Section 10 of Republic Act No. 9003 provides that, “Pursuant to the relevant provisions of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the LGUs shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this Act within their respective jurisdictions.”
- (c) Section 16 of Republic Act No. 9003 provides that, “The province, city or municipality, through its local solid waste management boards, shall prepare its respective 10-year solid waste management plans consistent with the National Solid Waste Management Framework: *Provided*, That the waste management plan shall be for the re-use, recycling and composting of wastes generated in their respective jurisdictions: *Provided further*, That the solid waste management plan of the LGU shall ensure the efficient management of solid waste generated within its jurisdiction.”;
- (d) Section 47 of Republic Act No. 9003 provides that, “The local government unit shall impose fees in amounts sufficient to pay the costs of preparing, adopting, and implementing a solid waste management plan prepared pursuant to this Act.”;
- (e) Chapter 3, Section 389 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Barangay Council headed by the Barangay Captain is recognized having the important role of delivering an efficient, effective and economical governance, the purpose of which, as related to the implementation of laws and regulations related to control of pollution and protection of the environment, particularly to solid waste management, is a matter of general welfare of the Barangay and its inhabitants;

- (f) Section 4, Rule XIX of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9003 provides that local government units shall be required to legislate appropriate ordinances to aid in the implementation of Republic Act No. 9003 and in the enforcement of its provisions; provided, such ordinances shall be formulated pursuant to relevant provisions of R.A. No. 7160;

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

- a) *Collection* – refers to the act of removing solid waste from the source or from a communal storage point;
- b) *Compostable* – refers to biodegradable or compostable materials free from contamination such as pathogens and hazardous substances, and considered safe for agriculture use.
- c) *Composting*- refers to the controlled decomposition of organic matter by micro-organisms, mainly bacteria and fungi, into a humus-like product.
- d) *Junkshop* – refers to any building, including its premises, in which junk is stored. It can be dealing with a particular kind of junk or with all kinds of junk, and it may thus assume a different business name.
- e) *Market Vendors* - refers to the permanent and /or ambulant vendors mainly engaged in the business activities at the City Public Market and within its vicinity.
- f) *Material Recovery Facility* - refers to the designated and or established building or structure designed to receive, temporarily store, sort, separate and recover wastes before the transfer, transport and final disposal of remaining non-reusable waste into the identified sanitary landfill site.
- g) *Receptacles* – refers to the properly marked individual waste containers used for separation or segregation of recyclable materials.
- h) *Recyclable materials* – refers to any waste material retrieved from waste stream that can still be converted or utilized into other purposes.
- i) *Recycling*- shall refer to the process of treating used or waste materials making them suitable for beneficial use and for other purposes, including any process by which waste materials are transformed into new products.
- j) *Residual Waste*- refers to waste that present no other use or purpose, and cannot be classified as compostable, recyclable, non-reusable.
- k) *Resource Recovery* - shall refer to the collection, extraction and recovery of and re-usable materials from the waste stream for the purpose of recycling, generating energy or producing a product suitable for other beneficial use.
- l) *Re-use* – refers to the process of recovering the waste materials intended for the same or different purpose without alteration of the physical characteristics of the recovered materials.
- m) *Sanitary Landfill* – refers to a waste disposal site designed, constructed, operated and maintained in a manner that exerts engineering control over potential environmental impacts arising from the development and operation of the facility;

- n) *Segregation at Source*- refers to the waste management practice of sorting, categorizing and separating the different waste at the point of origin or source of generation in order to promote recycling and re-use of resources to reduce the volume of accumulated waste prior to final disposal.
- o) *Solid waste* – any form or type of refuse material from household, commercial, institutional, agricultural and industrial which are non-hazardous and non-infectious, free from liquid mixture, generated in the city through natural or man-made processes or activities.
- p) *Special Waste* – refers to household hazardous wastes such as paints, thinners, household batteries, fluorescent lamps, lead-acid batteries, spray canisters and the like. These include waste from residential and commercial sources that comprise bulky wastes including construction and demolition debris, consumer electronics, white goods, yard wastes that are collected separately, oil and used tires. These wastes are usually handled separately from other residential and commercial waste;
- q) *Storage* – shall refer to the interim containment of solid waste generation for the purposes of segregation and resource recovery prior to disposal.

ARTICLE II 10-YEAR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

SECTION 4. THE 10-YEAR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN – The 10-Year Solid Waste Management Plan of Cagayan de Oro City shall be implemented in accordance with the implementation schedule, strategies and guidelines contained in the said plan as adopted and approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod under Ordinance No. 13130–2016. The Plan shall be updated in every 3 years.

ARTICLE III CREATION OF THE CITY ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD

SECTION 5. CITY ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD – The City Government shall create an Ecological Solid Waste Management Board (ESWMB) that shall formulate plans and policies and oversee the implementation of sanitary management of solid waste generated in areas under its geographic and political coverage.

ARTICLE IV MANDATORY SEGREGATION OF SOLID WASTE

SECTION 6. SEGREGATION OF WASTE AT SOURCE – That segregation of waste shall be primarily conducted at the source or point of origin, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial/business establishments, public markets, health care centers and agricultural sources.

SECTION 7. ROLE OF THE BARANGAY LGU – The segregation of waste shall be primarily managed at the barangay level specifically for the compostable, recyclable and reusable waste.

SECTION 8. MARKED AND COLOR-CODED RECEPTACLES – There shall be a properly identified and marked wastes container and receptacle for each type of waste and corresponding color code according to the classification of the segregated waste. Provided

that waste receptacles from residences, institutions, commercial and industrial establishments, and other sources must be stored in properly sealed and/or tied in spill-proof containers; and should only brought outside during collection time only.

SECTION 9. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SEGREGATION AND STORAGE AND SET OUT OF SOLID WASTE:

- (a) There shall be a separate container for each type of waste from all sources. In the case of bulky special waste, shall be placed in a designated area.
- (b) Two (2) or more residential units, the owner shall provide the occupants a designated area with properly marked containers. The accumulated source separated recyclable and biodegradable waste shall be collected by the barangay. Residual and special waste shall be collected by the city.
- (c) The owners, operators, or proprietors of the commercial establishment or business entity shall be responsible to provide storage for their source separated waste for collection and be placed in a designated area within their premises. Segregated wastes shall only be set out in time for collection and following a collection schedule.
- (d) The owners of residential buildings, heads of institutions and industries and proprietors of the business and commercial establishment shall notify all workers, employees and entities working in the premises of the requirements and procedures of segregation as prescribed in this ordinance.
- (e) All public utility vehicles, such as jeepneys, buses, motorelas and tricycles operating in the city are required to have garbage container for biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes inside their vehicle.

**ARTICLE V
ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITY**

SECTION 10. MRF ESTABLISHMENT - There shall be a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) in every barangay or cluster of barangays. The MRFs shall be established in a suitable location, in considerations of volume of waste generation, availability of site for the MRFs and accessibility of garbage collection and transport provision which shall be determined by the Barangay and/or cluster of barangays.

SECTION 11. The MRFs shall receive the segregated waste according to the prescribed waste classification for the final sorting. The resulting residual non-recyclable and non-reusable waste shall be transported to the designated Sanitary Landfill for the final disposal.

SECTION 12. MRF IN SCHOOLS - Schools and other educational institution, and offices of national government agencies and private corporations shall come up with an Ecological Waste Management Program, including the segregation at source and provision of Materials Recovery Facility.

SECTION 13. DUTY OF BARANGAY COUNCILS - It shall be the duty of the respective Barangay Councils to primarily enforce and supervise the solid waste management, collection, segregation, and resource recovery of the waste generated by the households, buildings, their premises, and the premises or place of business within their respective political boundaries.

SECTION 14. STORAGE DURATION OF WASTES - The appropriate duration for the storage of waste in the Materials Recovery Facility Station shall be determined by the Barangays Council in coordination with the solid waste management office.

SECTION 15. MRFs IN CONDOMINIUMS/SUBDIVISIONS - All subdivision and condominium owners and/or developers in Cagayan de Oro City shall provide sufficient space for the establishment of MRFs to store recyclables and process compostable materials of the homeowners or in coordinate with the barangay shall schedule the collection and processing of recyclable and compostable materials.

SECTION 16. MRF IN SUBDIVISION LAYOUT PLANS - For subdivision and condominium developers who are planning to put up a subdivision or any land development projects in Cagayan de Oro City, they shall incorporate the establishment of an MRF in their subdivision lay-out plan.

ARTICLE VI COLLECTIONS AND TRANSPORT OF SOLID WASTES

SECTION 17. NON-COLLECTION OF UNSEGREGATED SOLID WASTE - Only segregated wastes and only the types of waste that are scheduled for collection on a particular day and time shall be collected, provided that specific day and time shall be provide for by the IRR. Unsegregated waste shall not be collected. Repetitive disposal of unsegregated solid waste shall constitute a violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 18. TRANSPORT - The collected biodegradable and recyclable wastes shall be dropped off at the barangay MRF. Only the residual and special waste shall be brought to the disposal site.

SECTION 19. COLLECTION VEHICLES - Only collection vehicles covered with nets, tarpaulins and other similar materials shall be allowed to transport solid waste from the collection area to the disposal facility. For the purpose of identification, vehicles shall bear the body number, the name, and telephone number of the contractor/agency collecting solid waste.

SECTION 20. REQUIRED PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT - All collectors and other personnel directly dealing with collection of solid waste shall be equipped with personal protective equipment and cleaning implements such as, but not limited to gloves, masks and safety boots, to protect them from the hazards of handling solid wastes.

SECTION 21. GARBAGE COLLECTORS TRAINING - The City Health Officer/Solid Waste Management Officer shall provide necessary training to the collectors and personnel to ensure that the solid wastes are handled properly in accordance with pertinent guidelines pursuant to the Act.

SECTION 22. AUTHORITY TO COLLECT GARBAGE COLLECTION FEE - The city may impose fees in amounts sufficient to pay the costs of operation and maintenance based on the type and volume of waste. The amount and procedure of fees shall be defined and provided for by the Implementing Rules and Regulations. However, payments shall be consistent with the accounting system of government.

SECTION 23. ACCREDITATION OF PRIVATE HAULERS/COLLECTORS - All private individuals and companies engage in garbage collection and hauling in the city shall be accredited by the city, provided that accreditation guidelines shall be provided for by the

Implementing Rules and Regulations.

ARTICLE VII
ESTABLISHMENT OF SANITARY LANDFILL

SECTION 24. SANITARY LANDFILL ESTABLISHMENT - The City Government shall establish a Sanitary Landfill which shall be provided with all the required support facilities/equipment in accordance with the schedule and guidelines prescribed in the 10-Year Solid Waste Management Plan and shall conform to the guidelines provided in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9003.

SECTION 25. SANITARY LANDFILL RESOURCE RECOVERY - The Sanitary Landfill shall be provided with capability for resource recovery at the discretion of the city government and may mechanize operations to ensure it can cope with the required rate of processing of disposed solid waste.

SECTION 26. FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT - The support facilities and equipment that maybe provided to deliver effective and cost-efficient operations shall be determined by the city government, and may include Transfer Stations, Block Compactors, Pay Loaders, Dozers, Sheds, Lifters, Mechanized Segregators, Loading and Unloading Augers/Conveyors, Receptacles/Bins, Leachate Treatment and Processing facility, and related operation and maintenance equipment and facilities.

SECTION 27. TIPPING FEES - The city shall impose tipping fees for all private haulers, companies and individuals to dispose solid waste in the sanitary landfill to sufficiently support the cost of operation and maintenance of the facility. The amount and procedure of fees shall be defined and provided for by the Implementing Rules and Regulations. However, payments shall be consistent with the accounting system of government.

ARTICLE VIII
MAINTENANCE OF CLEAN AND SANITARY SURROUNDINGS

SECTION 28. DUTIES OF THE CITY & BARANGAY –

- a) Public thoroughfares, open spaces and grounds, unattended private and public lands shall be kept clean jointly by the city and barangay.
- b) Trees, shrubs and other vegetation within the vicinity of residences shall be regularly be cared for and maintained to minimize generated waste/yard waste and unpleasant site by the barangay.

SECTION 29. DUTIES OF BUILDING OWNERS -

- a) Residential buildings and its surroundings shall be kept clean and tidy by the owner or lessee of the building at all times.
- b) The lobby and/or sidewalks, immediate grounds fronting the business and commercial establishment, stalls, open spaces of markets shall be maintained clean and sanitary by the owner/operator or lessee/renters of the establishment.

ARTICLE IX
PLASTIC BAG REGULATION

SECTION 30. PLASTIC BAG REGULATION – The following regulations shall apply in the use of plastic bags in all commercial establishments in the city:

- a) Business establishments, fast-food outlets, pharmacies, market vendors, food kiosks, sari-sari stores, ambulant vendors, and the like shall not provide plastic bags and/or sando bags as packaging materials for dry goods and cooked foods to customers.
- b) Plastic bags with no handles, holes or strings shall be allowed for wrapping of unpacked meat and poultry products, marine products, fresh fruits and vegetables at supermarkets and markets separately to ensure food safety.
- c) Wet goods that are already in plastic wraps, pouches, bags and the like as part of the product packaging shall not be contained further in any plastic bags.
- d) The use of recyclable and reusable bags as alternative packaging materials shall be promoted, such as natural fiber bags, woven bags (bayong), cloth bags, rattan baskets, shopping bags made from recycled waste materials.
- e) All stores and markets shall adopt the “Bring Your Own Bag (BYOB) Program” to mainstream the use of reusable bags.
- f) All stores shall formulate appropriate incentives to consumers such as point system and/or special counters to be called as “green lane” to encourage customers to use reusable bags.
- g) Plastic bags as final packaging of goods in stores shall not be allowed in all commercial establishments every Wednesday and Friday.

ARTICLE X JUNKSHOP OPERATION

SECTION 31. PROHIBITED LOCATIONS OF JUNKSHOP - No junkshop shall be established along waterbodies, such as rivers and creeks, coastal areas and inside subdivisions.

SECTION 32. PERMITS - It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation to operate or maintain a junk shop or junkyard, or to do business in junk at any place within Cagayan de Oro City, in any manner contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance and without first having obtained a Business Permit for such purpose. The documents required for the application of business permit shall be followed.

SECTION 33. REQUIREMENTS - Any space, piece or parcel of land, licensed and used as junkshop whether existing now or hereinafter created, shall have gated entrances and exits and shall be properly and enclosed or separated from adjoining lots by walls or fences, such that all junk materials shall be stocked inside the junkshop premises and not be visible to the public. Orderliness and sanitation within the premises shall always be maintained by the junk owner/operator.

SECTION 34. SIDEWALKS - Sidewalks shall be free from stockpile of any junk materials.

SECTION 35. TRANSACTION BOOK/REGISTER - The city shall have access to every junk shop owner/operator Transaction Books or Registers to record acquisitions or

purchases, disposals or sales of junk materials for monitoring and regulation purposes.

SECTION 36. INSPECTION - The junkshop owner/operator shall permit law enforcers to conduct inspection of junkshop premises and transaction books or registers, and to present proof of purchases when requested.

ARTICLE XI PUBLIC EDUCATION AND INFORMATION DRIVE

SECTION 37. EDUCATION CAMPAIGN - The City government shall conduct continuing education and information campaign on solid waste management to develop public awareness and behavioral change on solid waste management.

SECTION 38. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMUNICATION PLAN - The City government shall formulate a Solid Waste Management Communication Plan and implement the said plan down to the barangay in partnership with the barangay.

SECTION 39. NGO/PO PARTICIPATION - The City government shall encourage non-government organizations, people's organizations to promote solid waste management and to endorse and patronize environmentally acceptable packaging of products and materials.

SECTION 40. DEPED/CHED PARTICIPATION - The City government shall develop partnership with City Division of Department of Education and the Commission on Higher Education to integrate ecological solid waste management in particular and environment education in general in the school curricula at all levels.

SECTION 41. DEPUTIZED AGENTS - The City government shall encourage and coordinate with the barangay to convene/organize volunteer groups who shall serve as Solid Waste Management deputized agents who shall assist in the Information, Education and Communication campaign and enforcement of this ordinance.

SECTION 42. IEC MATERIALS - Solid waste management stickers and other kinds of Information, Education and Communication collaterals shall be placed in conspicuous public places and in public transportation vehicles shall be required to display solid waste management IEC materials.

ARTICLE XII INCENTIVE MECHANISM

SECTION 43. INCENTIVES - The City shall develop and provide incentives to encourage barangays, institutions, commercial establishments, industries and Civil Society Organizations to develop or undertake socially acceptable, effective and efficient solid waste management practices, and/or to actively participate in any program for the promotion thereof, as provided for in RA 9003 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

SECTION 44. AWARDS - The city government shall grant incentives to barangays with outstanding solid waste management practices, subject to specific guidelines set forth in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance, following the budgeting, accounting and auditing procedures of government.

SECTION 45. INCENTIVES TO BARANGAYS FOR USE OF TRUCKS - An incentive scheme shall be devised by the City Solid Waste Management Board for barangays utilizing barangay-owned garbage truck for collection service of residual wastes in their respective

jurisdictions, subject to specific guidelines set forth in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance, following the budgeting, accounting and auditing procedures of Government.

SECTION 46. INCENTIVES FOR BEST PRACTICES - An incentive scheme shall be devised by the City Solid Waste Management Board for commercial establishments, institutions and industries with outstanding solid waste management practices, subject to specific guidelines set forth in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance, following the budgeting, accounting and auditing procedures of Government.

ARTICLE XIII
JURISDICTION OF CITY PUBLIC AGENCIES

SECTION 47. IMPLEMENTING OFFICE - The City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office (CLENRO) shall ensure the proper implementation of this Ordinance in coordination with other departments in the city government.

SECTION 48. CEED - That the City Economic Enterprise Department (CEED) shall be responsible for the supervision in the proper segregation and disposal of solid waste in the public markets and terminals, including the city public cemeteries in coordination with the City Public Services Office (CPSO).

SECTION 49. APO - The Agricultural Productivity Office (APO) shall provide technical assistance such as training and promotion of acceptable technology on composting and livelihood development on processing of biodegradable/compostable wastes.

SECTION 50. CITY ENGINEERING OFFICE - That the City Engineering Office (CEO) in coordination with Barangay shall be responsible over the cleanliness rivers, streams, canals, esteros, storm drainage or in any natural and man-made waterways. Likewise, coordinate with CLENRO on the operation and management of the sanitary landfill.

SECTION 51. CITY HEALTH OFFICE - The City Health Office (CHO) shall ensure that all food related businesses in the city shall be clean and sanitary.

SECTION 52. CITY VETERINARY OFFICE - The City Veterinary Office shall ensure the enforcement of the Ordinance on stray animals which may scatter garbage in streets, highways, and such enforcement shall be coordinated with Barangays.

SECTION 53. CITY SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE - The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) in coordination with Barangays shall provide alternative livelihood opportunities for waste pickers in the city.

SECTION 54. CITY INFORMATION OFFICE - The City Information Office (CIO) in coordination with CLENRO shall develop education and advocacy campaign program for ecological solid waste management.

SECTION 55. CITY TREASURER'S OFFICE - The City Treasurer's Office and/or its deputized agents shall collect and/or receive payments of fines.

ARTICLE XIV
PENAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 56. PROHIBITED ACTS – The following acts shall be prohibited:

- (a) Littering, throwing, dumping of waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canals, esteros or parks, and establishment, or causing or permitting the same;
- (b) Removal, relocation, scattering and spilling of any wastes after it has been placed in the properly marked and color-coded receptacle or in any manner interfere in the duty of garbage collection;
- (c) Removal or taking away any coded garbage receptacles from duly designated locations other than the persons authorized by the city and/or barangay;
- (d) Re-mixing of source-separated recyclable material with other solid waste in any vehicle, box, container or receptacle used in solid waste collection or disposal;
- (e) Open burning of solid waste;
- (f) Burying of biodegradable or non-biodegradable materials in flood-prone areas;
- (g) Causing or permitting the collection of non-segregated or unsorted waste;
- (h) Squatting in sanitary landfills;
- (i) Importation of toxic wastes misrepresented as “recyclable” or “with recyclable content”;
- (j) Transport and dumping in bulk of collected domestic, industrial, commercial and institutional wastes in areas other than the Sanitary Landfill;
- (k) Construction of any establishment within two hundred (200) meters from the sanitary landfill;

SECTION 57. PENALTIES:

- (a) Any violation of Article XIV, Sections 56(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g); Article VI, Section 17 and Article VIII of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be penalized with a fine of not less than five hundred pesos (P500.00) or community service for one (1) day but not exceeding to two thousand pesos (P2,000.00) or community service for five (5) days.
- (b) Any violation of Article IX, Section 30(c), (e) and (g) of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be penalized with a fine of not less than five hundred pesos (P500.00) but not exceeding to three thousand pesos (P3,000.00).
- (c) Any violation of Article XIV, Sections 56(h), (i), (j) and (k) of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction be penalized with a fine of not less than Five Thousand pesos (P 5,000.00) or imprisonment of not less thirty (30) days but not more than six (6) months, or both.
- (d) City and barangay government officials who fail to comply with this Ordinance and its Implementing Rules and Regulations shall be charged administratively in accordance with RA 7160 and other existing laws, rules and regulations.
- (e) National and Local government officials who fail to comply with this Ordinance and its Implementing Rules and Regulations shall be charged in accordance with this Ordinance.

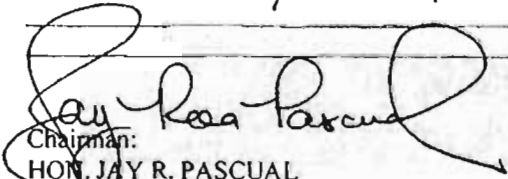

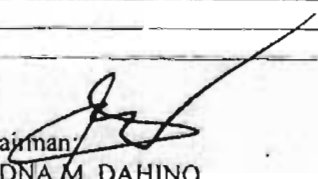

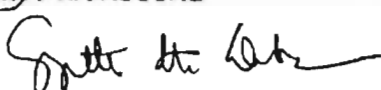

The city's name and tag should always appear together in the logo.

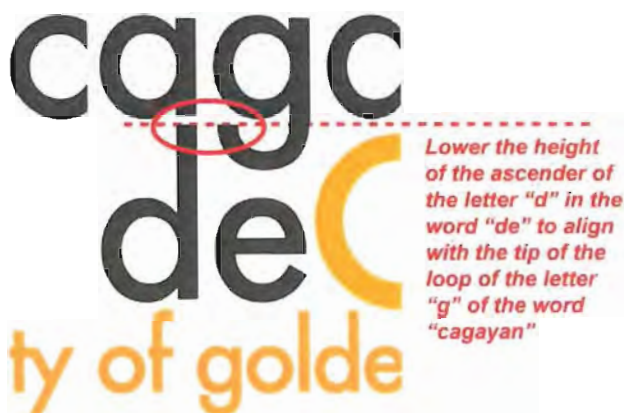

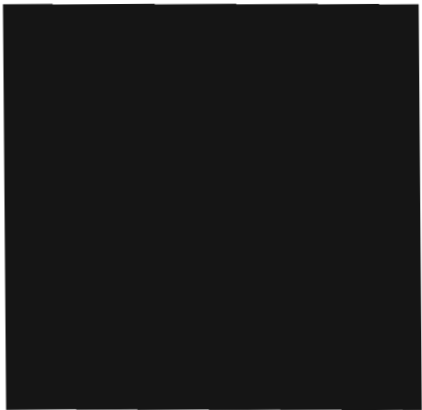

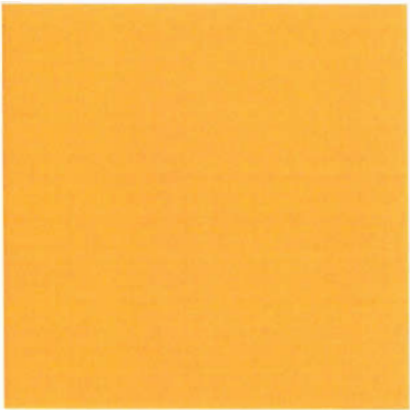

If the logo has to be placed on dark backgrounds that compete with its black text, the logo variant with white text may be used (course requests through investcdo@cagayandeoro.gov.ph).

When using the logo against photographic or patterned backgrounds, make sure the logo is clear and legible.





Using our Seal and Logo together

When used with the city seal:

1. The logo should always be to the right of the seal.
2. The topmost part of the logo should align with the topmost part of the inner circle in the seal.
3. The bottom part of the log should align with the bottom curve of outer circle of the seal.
4. Always allow the width of the gold letter "c" between the rightmost end of the yellow ribbon in the seal and the leftmost edge of the gold letter "c" in the logo.
