RESOLUTION NO. 02 - 2017

**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL TO
AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 5368-96, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE
CITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ORDINANCE, TO EXPAND THE COVERAGE OF
THE PROGRAM UNDER EXCEPTIONAL AND JUSTIFIABLE CASES**

WHEREAS, The Local Government recognizes the vitality of an educated, innovative, and competent workforce for the development of the city and of Northern Mindanao. To this end, it shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels, and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, The City Scholarship Program was created through Ordinance No. 5368-96, As Amended to realize the expressed policy of the Local Government Unit on access to quality education;

WHEREAS, The City Scholarship Committee is tasked to review and evaluate the implementation of the said program and recommend appropriate action for its improvement and expansion;

WHEREAS, After thorough evaluation, the said program only covers a narrow condition such as admission is only limited to fresh high school graduates thus failing to address situations that is born out of drastic but justifiable events that might disrupt their formal education in the middle of their college schooling;

WHEREAS, that the cause of these drastic events which disrupts student's formal education or imperil the continuation of their schooling is the implementation of city government projects;

WHEREAS, The City Scholarship Committee finds it necessary, in order to meet the demands of the time and further realize the declared education policy of the local government, to expand the coverage of the program guided by the principles of social justice and *parens patriae*;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE OF
CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN IT BY LAW,
IN SESSION ASSEMBLED,** to recommend the honorable City Council to amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 5368-96, as amended, otherwise known as the City Scholarship Program



Ordinance, to expand the coverage of the program under exceptional and justifiable cases created by the implementation of a city government project and other similar situations.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5368-96, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE CITY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM, AS AMENDED, SO AS TO EXPAND THE COVERAGE THEREOF TO COLLEGE STUDENTS OF FAMILIES BELONGING TO THE MARGINALIZED SECTOR WHO EXPERIENCED ECONOMIC DISLOCATION DUE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GOVERNMENT PROJECTS IN THE CITY

*Introduced by Councilor Suzette G. Magtajas-Daba, author
& Councilor Ian Mark Q. Nacaya, co-author*

Whereas, Ordinance No. 5368-96, otherwise known as the City Scholarship Program Ordinance, grants scholarship to deserving high school graduates who are in the top five of their respective class, among other qualifications;

Whereas, it is the intention of the said program to help poor fresh high school graduates finish college degree to emancipate them from the cycle of poverty;

Whereas, there are instances, however, that students already in the college level are unable to continue their studies due to drastic but justifiable events that disrupted their formal education in the middle of their tertiary schooling;

Whereas, it behooves upon the City Government to extend assistance to these students by expanding the coverage of the program under exceptional and justifiable cases;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council (Sangguniang Panlungsod) of Cagayan de Oro in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5368-96, otherwise known as the City College Scholarship Program, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding another Section therein to be denominated as Section 2-A, to read in full as follows:

“On motion jointly made and jointly seconded by the members present, it was

‘**RESOLVED**, as the City Council (Sangguniang Panlungsod) hereby resolves, to adopt the following:

‘ORDINANCE NO. 5368-96

‘AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR DESERVING STUDENTS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

‘**WHEREAS**, there is a need for the City of Cagayan de Oro to make college education available to poor but deserving students;

‘**WHEREAS**, the Barangay College Scholarship Program will help achieve and support the Education Program of the City;

‘**NOW, THEREFORE:**

‘**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council (Sangguniang Panlungsod) of Cagayan de Oro in regular session duly assembled that:

‘**SECTION 1. CREATION.-** There shall be created a "City College Scholarship Program" to be known as the Program under the supervision of the Community Improvement Office, and for this purpose a "Scholarship Committee" is

hereby created to effectively administer the same.

SECTION 2. QUALIFICATIONS - A high school graduate is qualified to avail of the program if he/she possesses the following qualifications:

- '(a) Filipino citizen;
- '(b) Single and a resident of one of the barangays of the City for at least five (5) years;
- '(c) Not more than 18 years of age. However, applicant who is more than 18 years old but not more than 25 years old maybe qualified on the condition that his/her high school education was delayed due to poverty; Provided, that he/she has not immediately enrolled in a College program after graduating from high school.
- '(d) The family income does not exceed Five Thousand Pesos (₱5,000.00) per month;
- '(e) Graduate of any public or private high school in the city and belonging to the top five percent (5%) of his/her class as certified by the school concerned and has not earned any college unit. If the applicant is a graduate from a school outside the City, his/her parents shall be bona fide residents of the City;
- '(f) Physically fit as certified by a duly licensed government physician;
- '(g) Has passed the entrance examination given by the college or university where he/she intends to enroll;
- '(h) Has no pending case before any disciplinary board of a school or conviction of a crime involving moral turpitude or penalty of not more than *arresto mayor* in any Courts of Law; and
- '(i) Has the favorable endorsement and commitment by the Barangay Council where he/she resides that it will shoulder the expenses for books and other materials as provided for in Section 3 hereof.

'SECTION 2-A. QUALIFICATION OF COLLEGE LEVEL SCHOLAR. –
Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 hereof, a college student already enrolled in any college or university in the City shall likewise be qualified to avail of the Program under the following circumstances and if he/she possesses the following qualifications:

- '(a) His/her family suffered economic dislocation due to the implementation of a Government-funded project in the City as certified to by the City Social Welfare and Development Office;
- '(b) Presently enrolled in a college or university in the City during the period his/her family was dislocated;
- '(c) Filipino citizen;
- '(d) Single and a resident of the City for at least six (6) months;
- '(f) The family income does not exceed Five Thousand Pesos (₱5,000.00) per month;
- '(g) Clean bill of health as certified by a duly licensed government physician;

'SECTION 3. PROGRAM ASSISTANCE. – The assistance extended by the Program shall only include Registration Fees and Tuition Fees and a monthly stipend or allowance at the following rates based on the Barangay residence of the scholar/beneficiary:

Monthly Stipend	Barangay Residence
a) ₱1,500.00	Lumbia, Dansolihon, Mambuaya, Tagpangi, Tignapoloan, Besigan, Pagalungan, Bayanga, FS Catanico, Indahag, Pagatpat, Pigsag-an, San Simon, Tuburan, Tumpagon, Baikingon, Balubal, Bugo, Puerto, Tablon, Agusan, Taglimao
b) ₱1,000.00	Barangays 1-40, Lapasan, Gusa, Cugnan, Nazareth, Macasandig, Puntod, Camaman-an, Carmen, Iponan, Bulua, Balulang, Canitoan, Bayabas, Bonbon, Kauswagan, Consolacion, Macabalan, Canitoan

'The cost of books and other materials shall be shouldered by the Barangay where the recipient resides, as its counterpart.

'SECTION 4. *CONDITIONS OF THE GRANT* - The scholarship grant under the Program shall be subject to the following conditions:

- '(a) Each barangay of the city shall be entitled to at least two or more scholars for any technical/vocational, four-year or five-year baccalaureate degree course preferably engineering courses except health-related courses such as nursing, physical therapy and medicines, among others.

'In order to accommodate applicants from all barangays in the City, the Program will accept an initial twenty (20) scholars for the first year and the same number every year thereafter until all the eighty (80) barangays in the City shall have been accommodated. The initial number of twenty (20) and the subsequent applicants shall be apportioned equally between the rural and urban barangays at the ratio of ten (10) scholars each. In the event of districting, the apportionment herein referred to shall be equal to each district;

- '(b) It shall only apply to any college or university located within the City of Cagayan de Oro; and

- '(c) The scholar must be able to maintain his/her grade in accordance to the school's standard for academic excellence in any four- or five-year baccalaureate degree excluding health-related courses;

'SECTION 5. - *SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE; CREATION, COMPOSITION AND PER DIEM* - A scholarship Committee is hereby created to administer the Program, which shall be composed of the following:

- '(a) The Chairman of the Committee on Education of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the Chairman;
- '(b) The Division Head of the Community Improvement Division, as vice-chairman;
- '(c) The DECS City Superintendent of Schools, as member;
- '(d) The City Treasurer, as member;
- '(e) The President of the Association of Barangay Councils (ABC), as member;
- '(f) The President of the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Federation, as member;
- '(g) The President of the High School Principals Association of Public Schools, as member;
- '(h) An owner, administrator, president or trustee of any private school, as member;
- '(i) The City Accountant, as member; and
- '(j) The City Budget Officer, as member.

'The members of this Committee shall be appointed by the City Mayor and shall hold office for a term of one (1) year and shall serve without any compensation except a per diem of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) for every meeting actually attended which shall not exceed two (2) meetings per month.

'SECTION 6. *COMMITTEE POWERS AND FUNCTIONS* - The Committee shall have the following powers and functions:

- '(a) Formulate guidelines, rules and regulations for the implementation of this program and designate a Secretariat to handle the administrative aspect thereof;
- '(b) Lay down policies and guidelines for the operation of a "Sponsorship Agreement" or "Adopt A Student" program by individuals or corporations who desire to participate in this undertaking;
- '(c) Recommend to the City Mayor, after screening, those qualified to avail of this program and those who may hereinafter be disqualified for failure to maintain

- academic excellence or for any valid grounds;
- (d) Solicit the participation, cooperation and assistance of owners or administrators of schools within the City of Cagayan de Oro and enter into any agreement beneficial pursuant to the purpose of the program;
- (e) Avail of professional and technical assistance from DECS or any qualified consultant to continually upgrade and enhance the Program's capabilities; and
- (f) Perform such other functions to ensure its continuous implementation.

SECTION 7. SCHOLAR EVALUATION - After each school semester, the Dean or School Registrar shall submit to the Committee the academic performance and/or records of the scholars and the Committee shall evaluate the same and recommend to the City Mayor for the continuation or for the cancellation of the grant, subject to the following conditions:

That the scholar/grantee shall:

- 1) be enrolled with the regular semestral load required by the course curriculum and should graduate within the prescribed period of the course;
- 2) maintain a general average per semester of at least 80% or its equivalent and not fail in more than one (1) subject;
- 3) not change course after the scholarship has been approved unless otherwise advised to shift by the dean and approved by the committee;
- 4) not make any misrepresentation of data related to obtaining the scholarship and/or terms and conditions of the scholarship;
- 5) not commit any misbehavior as a result of alcoholism, drug abuse or other unhealthful habits;
- 6) not violate any conditions set forth by the Program as well as policies, rules and regulations of the institution where the grantee/scholar is enrolled;
- 7) not avail or accept any other scholarship grant while pursuing studies under the CCSP;
- 8) report and submit a copy of academic records/status at the end of every semester duly certified by the school;
- 9) report and submit certification of completion (transcript of records, diploma, etc.) of the grant certified by the school or university concerned to the Scholarship Committee;
- 10) while still under the scholarship grant:
 - 10.a report to the Punong Barangay or his authorized representative weekly for monitoring purposes;
 - 10.b render one (1) hour service in the barangay every week or a total of 50-52 hours per year;
- 11) attend to all activities of the Scholar's Organization in which the grantee/scholar is a member abide with every rule, regulation and/or policy as provided for in its Constitution and By-laws;
- 12) not fail in any subject, maintain the average grade, not voluntarily drop any subject, or not stop from schooling without any valid reason.

SECTION 8. - SERVICE REQUIREMENT:

- (a) While still in the scholarship grant, the scholar shall report to the Barangay Chairman or his authorized representative weekly for monitoring purposes.
- (b) The scholar shall render one (1) hour service in the barangay every week or a total of 50-52 hours a year."

SECTION 9. APPROPRIATION.- To implement the Program, there is hereby appropriated an initial sum of One Million Pesos (P1,000,000.00) to be taken from the General Fund not otherwise appropriated and shall thereafter be included in the Annual Budget in such sum as may be necessary to ensure the Program's continued implementation.

local governance that are efficacious to both local government units, thus, leading to its growth and advancement and eventually self-sustainability:

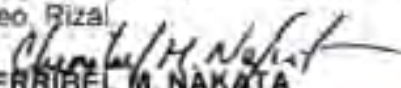

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (“MOA”) is entered into this ____ day of _____, 2017 in the City of Cagayan de Oro, Misamis Oriental, Republic of the Philippines, by and between:

TEACH FOR THE PHILIPPINES, INC. is a non-stock, non-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with address at Unit 201, Asia Tower Condominium Benavidez corner Paseo de Roxas Sts., Legaspi Village, Makati City represented herein by its Chief Executive Officer, Clarissa Isabelle L. Delgado, hereinafter referred to as “TFP”;

and

The DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, DIVISION OFFICE OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, Misamis Oriental of the Republic of the Philippines with address at Father Mastersons Avenue, Upper Balulang, Cagayan de Oro, Misamis Oriental, represented herein by its Schools Division Superintendent, Dr. Elena M. Borcillo, CESO VI, hereinafter referred to as “DepEd-CDO”;

and

The LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY of the Republic of the Philippines with address at City Hall, Capistrano Street, Cagayan de Oro, Misamis Oriental, represented herein by its Chairman and City Mayor, Honorable Oscar S. Moreno, hereinafter referred to as “LGU-CDO.”

Witnesseth, That:

WHEREAS, TFP is driven by the vision that all Filipino children should have access to an excellent and relevant education that realizes his possibilities and opportunities, as espoused by the national education agenda;

WHEREAS, TFP seeks to enhance the social well-being of the people by bridging the education gap in the Philippines and advocating functional literacy and progressive teacher and administrator training;

WHEREAS, the initiative is designed to recruit, select, train and provide on-going professional development to young individuals committed to closing the achievement gap by serving as Fellows who will teach students in under-resourced public elementary schools.

WHEREAS, DepEd-CDO and LGU-CDO recognize the nature of high-need public schools and welcome the implementation of the **Teach for the Philippines** Program (the “Program”) for the period June 2017 to May 2018 which will: (1) provide eight (8) Fellows in a Philippine public school in CDO; (2) launch extension classes in which education and noneducation majors are trained to become successful and transformational teachers; (3) contribute to the city’s education goals during the period June 2017 to May 2018; and (4) help in the research and development for future education policies based on scientific evidence.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual undertakings hereinafter set forth, the parties hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

Responsibilities of TEACH FOR THE PHILIPPINES, Inc.

A. Candidate Recruitment and Selection. - TFP shall recruit and select individuals from a wide range of academic majors, career fields and diverse backgrounds to participate in the Program, and who will serve as Fellows in the Partner Schools in CDO (Please refer to Appendix A for the list of schools). In the recruitment and selection of its Fellows, TFP shall not knowingly engage in any unlawful acts of discrimination.

For purposes of this MOA, a “Fellow” is a graduate from a top university, within the Philippines or abroad, who has passed the rigorous selection process conducted by TFP for participation in the Program and who shall not be covered by the provisions of Republic Act No. 4670, otherwise known as the “Magna Carta for Public School Teachers.” A Fellow shall be assigned to teach in a class or a grade level under the supervision of a teacher, such assignment shall be predetermined and agreed upon by TFP and the DepEd-CDO, and shall likewise be under the supervision and control of the school principal.

TFP shall employ reasonable efforts to provide the number of Fellows required by the LGU-CDO and/or the DepEd-CDO; Provided, that, the failure of TFP to provide all of the required number of Fellows for any school year shall not constitute a breach of this MOA.

B. Pre-Service Training or Summer Training Institute. - Before their two-year deployment, all Fellows shall undergo rigorous pre-service training to be provided by TFP in close coordination with the Department of Education Central Office (DepEd) prior to their assignment to a Partner School to ensure that each participant is highly qualified and equipped to serve as a Fellow.

Fellows are expected to attend continuing training sessions by TFP during the 2-month summer period after SY 2017 - 2018. They will also carry out their function as teachers in the school during this period, as prescribed by their respective school principals.

C. Allowance of Fellows. – All Fellows shall receive an allowance for the period June 2017 to May 2018, without prejudice to the extension of such placement upon the MOA of TFP and the LGU-CDO, or the DepEd-CDO and the individual Fellow.

D. In-service Professional Development. – In close coordination with DepEd Central Office and DepEd-CDO, TFP shall provide the Fellows with various in-service professional development services and activities, including classroom observation by regional program staff, videotaping of instruction with a review of teaching techniques, discussions to facilitate capacity for self-reflection and evaluation of instructional practice using student achievement data, and workshops facilitated by veteran teachers.

E. Access to Teacher Resources. – TFP shall provide all Fellows with access to an assortment of resources including sample lesson plans, assessments, grade tracking systems and instructional materials.

F. Provide Feedback on K to 12 Implementation. – TFP shall work closely with the DepEd and DepEd-CDO in the early period of implementation of the K to 12 curriculum.

G. Partnerships. – In an effort to engage the Partner School community, TFP will propose activities in coordination with partner individuals and institutions, subject to the endorsement of the school principal.

H. Liquidation Documents. – TFP shall be responsible for liquidating all public funds allocated by the LGU-CDO to TFP. At the end of each tranche period, TFP shall submit the following documentary requirements to the LGU-CDO:

- Certified true copy of the signed MOA;
- Liquidation Report and other supporting documents indicating that Fellows, master trainers, and representatives of involved training institutions have received the fund given their status as beneficiaries;
- Attendance Record of the Fellows showing their presence in their placement schools as acknowledged by the Principal or any competent staff member of the school;
- Bank Statement from the reputable financial institution that maintains the account of TFP. The Bank Report must indicate disbursement of the fund to the beneficiaries for that period;
- Pictures of Fellows teaching in their respective placement schools and master trainers conducting programs for the Fellows;

- Certificate of Rendered Service indicating that the Fellows have completed their teaching load for the given period as acknowledged by the Schools Division Superintendent of CDO;

Said documentary requirements for liquidation shall be submitted to the LGU-CDO within ninety (90) working days after the release of the funds to TFP.

I. Bank Records. – TFP shall maintain a separate bank records for the funds received from the LGU-CDO.

J. Return of Unutilized Fund. – TFP shall return to the LGU-CDO any unutilized amount from the funds donated for the Program within ninety (90) days from the end of the Program, including interest earned, if any.

ARTICLE II

Responsibilities of DepEd-CDO

A. Selection of Schools. – The DepEd-CDO, in collaboration with TFP, shall select and designate the public elementary schools in CDO, or the “Partner Schools,” where the participants recruited and selected by TFP will be placed as Fellows. A Partner has at least three (3) teaching positions in the grade level which, as determined by the parties, will necessitate the placement of at least three (3) Fellows in the same school year.

B. Commitment to Place Fellows. – The DepEd-CDO shall consider all Fellows presented, recruited, and selected by TFP for placement in the designated Partner Schools subject to the provisions of Article I.A of this MOA.

C. Notice of Placement. – TFP and the DepEd-CDO shall agree on the placement of the Fellows no later than one (1) month before the start of the Summer Training Institute.

D. Placement Period. – Each Fellow shall be placed in the designated Partner School for one (1) school year, without prejudice to the extension of such placement upon the MOA of TFP and the LGU-CDO, or the LGU-CDO and the individual Fellow, and shall teach for a maximum of six (6) hours a day under the supervision of the principal of the Partner School to which the Fellow is assigned.

The DepEd-CDO shall ensure that a Fellow assigned to a Partner School for the duration of the Program shall not be relieved of his or her position notwithstanding the removal or reassignment of the principal assigned in the Partner School.

During the placement period, the DepEd, DepEd-CDO, and/or LGU-CDO shall not burden the Fellows with duties and responsibilities that are not contemplated by this MOA, such as but not limited to duties relating to national and/or local elections and partisan events.

The principals of the Partner Schools shall have direct control and supervision over the Fellows assigned to his or her school. DepEd-CDO may allow “mentors and master trainers” from TFP to visit the Partner Schools at least once in six (6) months to monitor the Fellow inside his or her classroom and assess the support needed by the Fellow to enable said Fellow to create an interactive classroom where critical and analytical and thinking skills can be developed. Internet-based technological tools may be used in lieu of mentors and master trainers to monitor the Fellows’ performance.

F. Monitoring & Evaluation. The DepEd-CDO may allow the conduct of the following assessments: 1. 2017: Baseline Assessment 2. For the duration of the Program: School Visits, up to twice a month 3. 2018: End-term Assessment

In the event that the placement of a Fellow is extended upon agreement of TFP and the LGU-CDO, the conduct of the assessment for the following period shall follow the schedule provided in this paragraph.

ARTICLE III **Responsibilities of LGU-CDO**

A. Selection of Schools. – The LGU-CDO, in collaboration with the DepEd-CDO and TFP, shall select and designate the public elementary schools Partner Schools as defined in Article II.A of this MOA where the participants recruited and selected by TFP will be placed as Fellows.

B. Commitment to Place Fellows. – The LGU-CDO shall consider all Fellows presented, recruited, and selected by TFP for placement in the designated Partner Schools subject to the provisions of Article I.A of this MOA.

The LGU-CDO may allow TFP “mentors and master trainers” to visit the Partner Schools at least once in six (6) months as stated in Article II.E of this MOA.

C. Funding the Extension Classes. – The LGU-CDO shall fund the Program through allowance of the Fellows. The fund shall come from the Special Education Fund of the Local School Board to be given to TFP. The allowance shall be received by the Fellows during placement in the Partner School, including the period between one school year.

The LGU-CDO shall directly release to TFP in the form of a check payable to the latter as indicated in the schedule below. TFP shall liquidate the funds it receives in accordance with appropriate government accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations and in such formalities as may be required by law. (Please refer to Appendix B for the breakdown of the budget proposal.)

Under this MOA, the LGU-CDO shall release a total amount of **Two Million One Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Three Hundred Thirty One Pesos (Php2,164,331)** to be released throughout SY 2017 – 2018 and liquidated by TFP.

Considering that the foregoing allocation is an outright expense, the LGU-CDO hereby affirms that funds are available and are, or will be, duly appropriated to TFP.

E. Notice of Placement. – The LGU-CDO shall agree with the other parties on the placement of the Fellows not later than one (1) month before the start of the Summer Training Institute.

F. Placement Period. – Pursuant to Article II.E of this MOA, each Fellow shall be placed in the designated Partner School for one (1) school year, without prejudice to the extension of such placement upon the MOA of TFP and the LGU-CDO, or the LGU-CDO and the individual Fellow, and shall teach for a maximum of six (6) hours a day under the supervision of the principal of the Partner School to which the Fellow is assigned.

During the placement period, the DepEd Central Office, DepEd-CDO, and/or LGUCDO shall not burden the Fellows with duties and responsibilities that are not contemplated by this MOA, such as but not limited to duties relating to national and/or local elections and partisan events.

G. Additional Responsibilities of the LGU-CDO. – The LGU-CDO shall accomplish the following to facilitate the proper disbursement and utilization of funds, to wit:

1. Upon compliance with the process pursuant to law, provide an official document identifying the Program as a priority project, approving the monetary allocation granted to TFP, and authorizing TFP to receive funds therefor;
2. At the discretion of the LGU-CDO, conduct periodic evaluation and inspection in the training facility and Partner Schools during the following periods, to wit:
 - June 2017
 - November 2017
 - March 2018

H. Monitoring & Evaluation. – The LGU-CDO may allow the conduct of the following assessments:

1. 2017: Baseline Assessment
2. For the duration of the Program: School Visits, up to twice a month
3. 2018: End-term Assessment

ARTICLE IV

LEGAL ACTION

In the event of any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or relating to this MOA, or for any breach, termination, or invalidity thereof, the Parties are mandated to settle the same through mediation. If no settlement is arrived at after the earnest mediation participated by all Parties, the venue of judicial proceedings shall be in the proper courts of CDO to the exclusion of all other venues.

This Memorandum of Agreement shall be effective upon the signing of both parties and shall be valid from June 2017 - May 2018. Ninety (90) days before May 31, 2018, the parties will begin the discussion and negotiation for an extension of the terms of this Agreement to SY June 2018 - May 2019 through the execution of an addendum; provided, however, that either Party may terminate this Agreement anytime by giving a written notice to the other Party at least sixty (60) days prior to the intended date of termination.

ARTICLE V

DISSOLUTION OF THE NGO

In case of the dissolution of TFP, the LGU-CDO shall have a lien on TFP's assets to the extent of the unexpended or unutilized portion of the fund.

ARTICLE VI

GENERAL PROVISIONS

A. Fees-for-Service. – The LGU-CDO shall allocate the budget for a portion of the cost of the Program in the amount of Two Million One Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Three Hundred Thirty One Pesos (Php2,164,331) which covers the full period of the MOA.

B. Drop-outs. – In the event a Fellow fails to finish the placement period due to any reason (health or otherwise), TFP shall immediately inform thereof in writing the DepEd-CDO, through the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent.

C. Term. – The term of this MOA covers in full the batch of Fellows for the period June 2017 to May 2018, subject to provisions of Article II. E of this MOA.

ARTICLE VII

TERMINATION

This MOA may be terminated as follows:

- i. At any time by mutual written agreement of the parties;
- ii. By any party, upon thirty (30) days' prior written notice to the non-terminating parties; Provided, that the terminating party provides said notice thirty (30) days prior to the end of the current academic year; or
- iii. By any party upon written notice to the non-terminating parties in the event of a material breach of this MOA that is incapable of being cured or, if capable of being cured, is not cured within thirty (30) days following receipt by the breaching party of written notice of such breach from the non-breaching or parties.

ARTICLE VIII

ASSIGNMENT

This MOA may not be assigned by a party without the written consent of all the other parties.

ARTICLE IX

GOVERNING LAW

The validity, construction, and performance of this MOA shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

ARTICLE X

SEVERABILITY

If any provision of the MOA shall be held invalid or contrary to law, the validity of the other terms and conditions hereof shall not be affected thereby and shall continue to be in full force and effect. However, should the severance alter the basic nature of this MOA, or is contrary to public policy, the entire MOA will be rendered invalid.

ARTICLE XI

WAIVER

The failure of any party to insist on a strict performance of any of the terms and covenants hereof shall not be considered a relinquishment or waiver of any rights or remedies pertinent thereto,

nor shall the same be considered as a waiver or condonation of any subsequent breach or default of the terms and covenants hereof, all of which shall continue to be in full force and effect. No waiver, express or implied, by any of the parties of any of their respective rights or remedies hereunder shall be deemed to have been made, and no evidence thereof shall be admissible unless such waiver is expressed in a written instrument duly signed by the party waiving any such rights or remedies.

ARTICLE XII **ENTIRE AGREEMENT**

This MOA constitutes the entire understanding between the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof and cancels, supersedes or otherwise nullifies any prior oral or written agreements and understandings with respect hereto.

ARTICLE XIII **MODIFICATIONS**

Any and all amendments and modifications to this MOA shall be in writing and signed by all the parties hereto.

ARTICLE XIV **FORCE MAJEURE**

No party shall be liable to the other party for any loss, injury, delay, damages or other casualty suffered or incurred by the other party due to strikes, riots, storms, fires, explosions, acts of God, war, coup d'état, action of any government or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the party (each, a Force Majeure Event), and any failure or delay by any party in performing any of its obligations under this MOA due to a Force Majeure Event shall not be considered a breach of this MOA. The party suffering such Force Majeure Event shall notify the other party in writing promptly after the occurrence of such Force Majeure Event and shall, to the extent reasonable and lawful, use its best efforts to remove or remedy the Force Majeure Event.

ARTICLE XV **NO STRICT CONSTRUCTION**

The parties acknowledge that they have agreed amongst each other in good faith and at arms length with respect to the terms, conditions and provisions hereof, that each party has determined for himself or herself that this MOA is fair and reasonable, and that the words and phrases in this MOA express the true intentions of all the parties so that no rule of strict construction should be applied when interpreting and construing this MOA.
