

ORDINANCE NO. 15281-2026

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PROGRAM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A SUSTAINABLE ELEVATED WALKWAY SYSTEM ALONG MAJOR THOROUGHFARES IN KEY COMMERCIAL AND PUBLIC DISTRICTS OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY; PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP, COMMERCIAL UTILIZATION, AND INFRASTRUCTURE STANDARDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, elevated walkways, aka skywalk or skybridges, are an effective response to overcrowding and urban chaos by connecting multiple buildings, thereby providing a safer and more convenient experience to pedestrians. These raised pathways encourage commuters to walk instead of taking motorized transportation by connecting or linking important parts of the central business district or commercial centers;

Whereas, they provide a safe crossing for pedestrians over busy streets and intersections, reducing the risk of accidents with vehicles, helping to reduce travel time for pedestrians and improving connectivity, mitigate traffic congestion by separating foot traffic, thus improve the flow of vehicles on the street level, shield pedestrians from adverse weather conditions such as rain or intense heat, and provide an accessible route especially for those physically challenged to building entrances on sloping ground, making navigation easier for all users;

Whereas, as can be observed in major cities abroad and in Metro Manila, the importance of elevated walkways in Cagayan de Oro City became especially apparent particularly in commercial and institutional areas where urban flooding commonly occurs;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the 21st Sangguniang Panlungsod (City Council) in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title - This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Sustainable Elevated Walkway System Program Ordinance of Cagayan de Oro City**".

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy - It is the policy of the City Government of Cagayan de Oro to promote sustainable, inclusive, and modern urban infrastructure by improving pedestrian access, reducing road congestion, enhancing public safety and supporting tourism and economic activity.

SECTION 3. Objectives - This Ordinance seeks to:

- a) establish elevated, roofed pedestrian walkways in identified zones;
- b) Encourage private sector participation in funding, development, and management;
- c) Create revenue-generating mechanisms for the city through commercial utilization of walkway spaces;
- d) Provide safe, all-weather access for pedestrians;
- e) Promote local tourism and cultural heritage through thematic design and exhibits.

SECTION 4. Definition of Terms:

- a) **Elevated walkway** – A pedestrian corridor raised above ground level, usually connecting two or more buildings or locations, with roofing or weather protection.
- b) **PPP (Public-Private Partnership)** – A contractual agreement between the City Government and private entities for joint participation in infrastructure development.



c) **Commercial Use Zones** – designated sections of the walkway where advertisements, ATMs, vendor stalls, or cultural exhibits may be installed.

SECTION 5. Scope and Coverage - There shall be designated elevated walkways in the following major public thoroughfares and high-density urban areas, consisting of enclosed or covered footbridges serving as exclusive access-ways for pedestrians, under the parameters set forth in this Ordinance, to wit:

- a) CM Recto Avenue;
- b) Limketkai Center and Agora Area;
- c) Cogon and Divisoria Commercial Districts; and
- d) Other areas identified by the City Planning and Development Office.

Elevated walkways which utilize air rights above the road rights-of-way (RROWS), being part of the public domain, shall be considered public spaces. Motor and non-motor vehicles are prohibited from being driven or parked on all such walkways.

SECTION 6. Design Standards and Safety - All elevated walkways shall comply with the National Building Code, Accessibility Law (BP 344), and safety requirements set by the Office of the City Engineer and/or Office of the Building Official. Materials used shall be durable, weather resistant, and visually aligned with the city's urban branding.

The design and specifications of elevated walkways to be established under this Ordinance shall be governed by the following design considerations and issues:

- a) *High Density and Accessibility* - Elevated walkways should be sited and designed to prioritize high-density zones, relieving overcrowded streets by serving the largest share of pedestrians at any given time, shifting ground-level foot traffic onto multiple levels and improving circulation in city centers; they must also be highly accessible and permeable to ensure the project serves a broad segment of the walking public;
- b) *Continuous Flow* - Elevated walkways should provide uninterrupted pedestrian movement day and night, free from vehicle congestion and delays at traffic signals and intersections, with integrated wayfinding and directional signage to guide pedestrians;
- c) *Temperature Control and Comfortability* - Elevated pedestrian routes must provide continuous, climatically controlled spaces that offer comfort and relief from extreme heat, humidity, and wet conditions, separate pedestrians from vehicular pollution and contact, prioritize shaded, cool open-air zones, and employ passive cooling strategies alongside artificial ventilation in a sustainable manner;
- d) *Connectivity* - Elevated walkways must be interlinked in a manner that connects pedestrian movement to retail, residential, commercial, and business activities and locations, as well as adopt essential access points that facilitate pedestrian entry to and exit from ground (grade) level walkways;
- e) *Safety and Transparency* - Elevated walkways must directly address issues of pedestrian safety and transparency, including the separation of pedestrians from vehicular traffic, exposure to natural hazards, and compliance with disaster resilience and mitigation standards;
- f) *Environmental Sustainability* - Program must maintain adequate spatial separation between the existing environment and all urban interventions, address potential ground-floor decay and abandoned spaces, provide safeguards and protection for walkway users exposed to air and noise pollution and install public address systems to warn users upon entry and use, while prioritizing energy and water conservation and solid waste management as key sustainability features of the system;
- g) *Social Inclusivity* - Elevated walkway networks must be socially inclusive, mitigate potential social separation caused by aerial walkways in income-diverse areas, and accommodate persons with disabilities by installing structural features and vertical access facilities that reasonably enhance mobility in accordance with existing disability laws, such as B.P. Blg. 344 (Accessibility Law) and R.A. No. 7277, as amended (Magna Carta for Disabled Persons);
- h) *Right-of-Way Interfacing* - Elevated walkways must account for affected portions of the road



right-of-way and other public-domain areas, including interfaces with grade-level sidewalks reserved for pedestrians (for supports, foundations, and vertical access), the air rights above sidewalks, space for connectors using air rights over carriageways, links of air rights above sidewalks on opposite sides of the road, and legal easements and their air rights along waterways so these easements can host elevated walkways in accordance with P.O. No. 1067 (s. 1976) (the Water Code) and R.A. No. 10752 (The Right-of-Way Act).

- i) *Vertical Access System* - As elevated walkways may have finished floor elevations above sidewalk surfaces, vertical access systems shall be established to connect the walkways to ground level pedestrians, (e.g., elevators, stairs, and escalators that shall be gender-sensitive, socially-inclusive, elongated and appropriately sloped, and constructed in a manner that will not unduly constrict connecting sidewalks);
- j) *Support Facilities* - Elevated walkway systems shall include the construction and regular maintenance of bicycle parking lots, adequate lighting, crime prevention facilities and well-lit patrolling space for law enforcement personnel, closed-circuit television (CCTV) camera systems, access to restrooms, etc.
- k) *Active Policing* - Elevated walkway networks established under this Ordinance must provide for the administration of active policing and law enforcement coordination to prevent obstructions and nuisances;
- l) *Adaptability to Future Technology* - Elevated walkway structures shall be designed to be adaptable to future technologies and capacities, including the provision to accommodate later installation of walkalators to increase pedestrian capacity; and
- m) *Integration with urban landscape*: Elevated walkways must complement the urban environment rather than detracting from it, considering their impact on building facades and views. Portions of the walkway may be curated by the City Tourism Office to:
 - i) showcase Cagayan de Oro's cultural heritage
 - ii) promote upcoming festivals or tourism campaigns
 - iii) feature rotating exhibits by local artists

SECTION 7. Prohibited Acts. - The use of elevated walkways and vertical access systems for commercial and personal purposes shall be prohibited. Such prohibited acts include but are not limited to the following:

- a) Driving or parking motor and non-motor vehicles on all such walkways, including its vertical access points and drop-off areas;
- b) Alms or donation-seeking activities;
- c) Doing house chores such as washing clothes, hanging clothes, and bathing;
- d) Repair of vehicles of all types;
- e) Dumping garbage;
- f) Sports, games, and amusements;
- g) Use of walkway to install pens of animals or keep animals in chains or tether;
- h) Holding picnics/gatherings or storage of foodstuffs and beverages for such gatherings;
- i) Drinking liquor;
- j) Storing of junks and recyclable materials;
- k) Storage of construction materials for sale (pipes, tubings, lumber, cement, and the like);
- l) House extension or stall/store extension including installation of roofs or awnings;
- m) Installation of temporary or permanent fences;
- n) Use of walkways for plants, trees and plant boxes;
- o) Signs or signboards above sidewalks and detached from the business establishment;
- p) Any other purpose which violates the standards enumerated in Section 6.

SECTION 8. Obstructions as nuisance per se. - Without prejudice to the prosecution of prohibited acts defined under the immediately preceding section, all obstructions along elevated walkways are hereby presumed or declared nuisances per se and, as such, are subject to summary abatement without need of judicial proceedings.

Obstructions include any structure, permanent or otherwise, movable or immovable, erected along, standing on, abutting or in any manner impeding safe and convenient passage through any elevated walkway; *Provided*, That property of the government including structures erected or installed for the purpose of regulating the flow of traffic shall not be deemed obstructions.

SECTION 9. Implementing Agency - The Office of the City Planning and Development Coordinator (CPDO), in coordination with the Office of the City Engineer, shall serve as the lead implementing agency. A Walkway Project Technical Working Group (TWG) shall be created through an Executive Order by the City Mayor, which shall be composed as follows:

- a) Chairperson : City Engineer
- b) Vice Chairperson : City Planning and Development Coordinator
- c) Members :
 - i) City Administrator
 - ii) City Legal Officer
 - iii) Roads & Traffic Administration Officer
 - iv) Chairperson, Local Finance Committee
 - v) Regional Director, Department of Public Works & Highways – Region 10
 - vi) District Engineer, DPWH, 2nd District Office, Cagayan de Oro City

The City Mayor may expand the membership thereof by including the representatives of other government agencies, business establishments/shopping malls and institutions.

SECTION 10. Public-Private Partnership Mechanism - The City Government shall enter into PPP agreements with interested mall owners, real estate developers, banks, and private corporations, subject to:

- a) Standard bidding and procurement procedures under the PPP Code of CDO (if applicable)
- b) Shared maintenance responsibilities;
- c) Defined commercial rights and cost-recovery provisions.

SECTION 11. Revenue-Generating Components - To support sustainability, the following may be allowed subject to approval by the Sangguniang Panlungsod:

- a) Advertisement panels and digital billboards
- b) ATM installations by commercial banks
- c) Designated Local Vendor Booths or MSME Kiosks
- d) Naming Rights or sponsorship Sections

Rental income from these shall be deposited to a Special Infrastructure Fund for walkway maintenance and expansion.

SECTION 12. Funding - To carry out the provisions of this Ordinance, such amount as may be necessary is hereby authorized to be appropriated from the General Fund of the City Government of Cagayan de Oro. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continuous operation of the Program shall be included in the annual appropriation of the City Planning and Development Office under its Special Program fund.

SECTION 13. Penalty - Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to summary abatement, dismantling, forfeiture, and disposal of the obstruction to the walkway.

In addition, any person, corporation, trust, firm, partnership, association or entity found violating this Ordinance shall be penalized by a fine not less than Three Thousand pesos (₱3,000.00), or imprisonment of not more than 30 days, or both, at the discretion of the court. When the offender is a juridical entity, the officers or agents responsible for the violation shall be meted with said penalties.

Any officer of the duly designated enforcement agency who neglects or fails to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance shall be held administratively liable.





A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE FULL SUPPORT OF THE 21ST CITY COUNCIL OF CAGAYAN DE ORO FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE MEASLES-RUBELLA SUPPLEMENTAL IMMUNIZATION ACTIVITY (MR-SIA) AND VITAMIN A SUPPLEMENTATION FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026, PURSUANT TO THE ADVISORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH – CENTER FOR HEALTH DEVELOPMENT NORTHERN MINDANAO AND THE MEMORANDUM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) DATED 12 JANUARY 2026.

WHEREAS, the Department of Health – Center for Health Development Northern Mindanao, in its Advisory dated January 8, 2026, informed the City Government of Cagayan de Oro of the increasing number of measles-rubella cases in Region X, the persistently low routine immunization coverage, and the resulting large pool of susceptible children;

WHEREAS, from January 1 to December 7, 2025, a total of four hundred five (405) measles-rubella cases were reported in Region X, with Cagayan de Oro City recording twenty-three (23) cases, placing the city among the affected localities:

WHEREAS, as of November 29, 2025, Region X ranked second nationwide in reported measles-rubella cases, indicating a heightened risk of an outbreak that may overwhelm the health system;

WHEREAS, the Regional Verification Committee (RVC) for Measles and Rubella Elimination has determined that endemic measles and rubella transmission remains ongoing nationwide and has recommended the conduct of a high-quality, nationwide, non-selective Measles-Rubella Supplemental Immunization Activity (MR-SIA) for Calendar Year 2026 as an urgent public health intervention;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health has scheduled Phase 1 of the MR-SIA for Mindanao and the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) from January 19 to February 13, 2026, targeting children aged six (6) months to fifty-nine (59) months, together with Vitamin A supplementation, with the objective of achieving at least ninety-five percent (95%) coverage to interrupt measles transmission;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), in its Memorandum dated January 12, 2026, directed all Local Government Units to actively support the implementation of the MR-SIA CY 2026, in accordance with DOH Department Memorandum No. 2025-0573, and specified the roles and responsibilities of LGUs in ensuring its successful conduct;

WHEREAS, under the said DILG Memorandum, Local Government Units are enjoined to:

(a) designate personnel to serve as a local task force to oversee MR-SIA implementation;

(b) issue local ordinances or resolutions supporting the MR-SIA campaign;

(c) mobilize resources necessary for implementation;

(d) deploy human resources to support vaccination teams and community engagement;

and

(e) submit accomplishment reports on time in accordance with DOH guidelines;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, that the 21st City Council of Cagayan de Oro expresses its full support for the conduct of the Measles-Rubella Supplemental Immunization Activity (MR-SIA) and Vitamin A supplementation for Calendar Year 2026 in the City of Cagayan de Oro:

SUBJECT: URGENT REQUEST FOR AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE FILING OF APPLICATION FOR BUSINESS PERMIT RENEWAL FROM JANUARY 20, 2026 TO, MARCH 31, 2026, WITHOUT SURCHARGES OR PENALTIES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 56, ARTICLE 0 OF THE CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY REVENUE CODE OF 2015.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

This refers to the request of the undersigned for the enactment of an Ordinance extending the deadline of the filing of application for business permit renewal from January 20, 2026 to March 31, 2026, without surcharges or penalties.

Pursuant to Sec. 56, Article 0 of the *Cagayan de Oro City Revenue Code of 2015*, the period of time for payment of business taxes may be extended without surcharges or penalties, *viz*:

"Section 56. Time of Payment. The tax shall be paid once within the first twenty (20) days of January or in quarterly installments within the first twenty (20) days of January, April, July, and October of each year. **The Sangguniang Panlungsod may, for a justifiable reason or cause, extend the time for payment of such taxes without surcharges or penalties, but only for a period not exceeding six (6) months.**

In addition, the Cagayan de Oro Chamber of Commerce & Industry Foundation, Inc. (Oro Chamber), Cagayan de Oro Filipino-Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry, Inc. (CDO-FILCCCII), and the Misamis Oriental Filipino-Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry, Inc. (MOFCCCII), on behalf of its respective member companies and the broader business community, collectively requested for the extension of the business permit renewal deadline, citing several concerns and challenges affecting business owners¹.

Hence, the undersigned finds that it is for the best interest of the City Government to support local businesses and promote a business-friendly environment to significantly benefit economic growth and stability, through this initiative.

For this reason, I am respectfully requesting the appropriate action of the Honorable Body, *signified as urgent*, for the enactment of an Ordinance extending the deadline of the filing of application for business permit renewal from January 20, 2026 to March 31, 2026, without surcharges or penalties.


