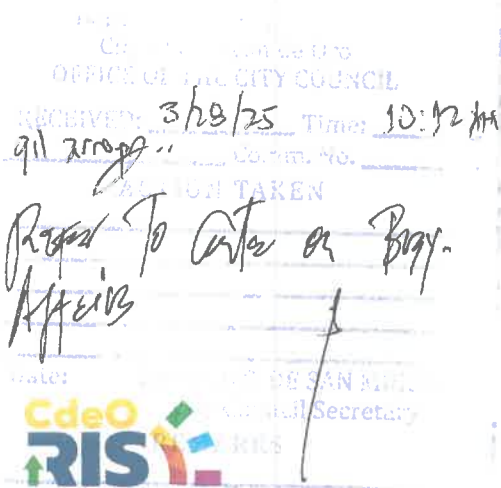

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW FOR CHILDREN BELOW 18 YEARS OLD IN BARANGAY INDAHAG, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

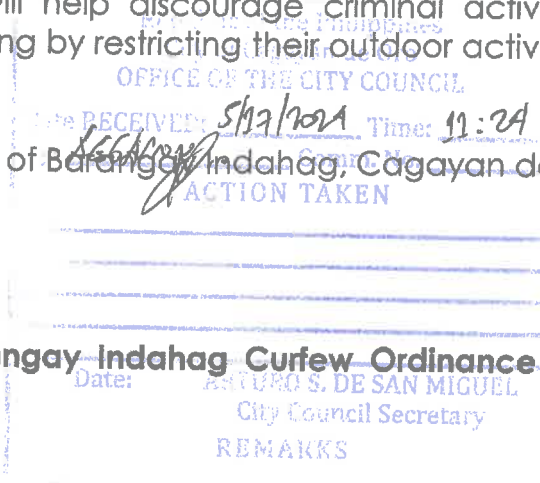

WHEREAS, Barangay Indahag recognizes the importance of maintaining peace, order, and the safety of its residents, particularly the youth population;

WHEREAS, there is a need to implement measures to prevent juvenile delinquency, ensure the welfare of minors, and promote responsible parenting within the barangay;

WHEREAS, imposing a curfew for minors will help discourage criminal activities involving youths and safeguard their well-being by restricting their outdoor activities during late hours;

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City, that:



SECTION 1: Title.

This ordinance shall be known as the "**Barangay Indahag Curfew Ordinance for Children.**"

SECTION 2: Definition of Terms

1. Children – a young human being below the age of puberty or below the legal age of majority.
2. Child - For the purposes of this ordinance, a child means every human being below the age of 18 years.
3. Curfew – a regulation enjoining the withdrawal of usually specified persons (such as juveniles) from the streets.

SECTION 3: Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to ensure the safety and well-being of children below 18 years old by imposing a curfew to prevent them from engaging in activities that may endanger their welfare or involve them in unlawful acts.

SECTION 4: Coverage.

This ordinance shall apply to all children below 18 years old residing in or visiting Barangay Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City.

SECTION 5: Curfew Hours.

The curfew hours for children below 18 years old shall be from 11:00 o'clock to 5:00 o'clock in the morning every day of the week.

SECTION 6: Prohibited Acts.

During the curfew hours specified in Section 5, children below 18 years old are prohibited from loitering, roaming, or engaging in any public or outdoor activities within the barangay premises, unless accompanied by a parent, guardian, or authorized adult.

SECTION 7: Exceptions.

The following shall be exempted from the curfew provisions of this ordinance:

- A. Children below 18 years old who are accompanied by a parent, guardian, or authorized adult;
- B. Children below 18 years old who are traveling to or from work, school-related activities, religious services, or other authorized events with the consent of their parent or guardian;
- C. Children below 18 years old who are involved in emergency situations requiring immediate assistance;
- D. Children below 18 years old who are engaged in lawful employment or authorized community service activities; and
- E. Children below 18 years old who are participating in or attending organized events or activities supervised by responsible adults.

SECTION 8: Responsibilities of Parents/Guardians.

Parents, guardians, or persons having custody or control of children below 18 years old shall ensure compliance with the curfew provisions of this ordinance. They shall exercise reasonable supervision and control over the activities and whereabouts of their children during curfew hours.

SECTION 9: Penalties.

Any violation of this ordinance shall be subject to the following penalties:

- A. First Offense: Written warning to the child and parent/guardian, with documentation by barangay authorities.
- B. Second Offense: Barangay community service for the child and parent/guardian, as determined by the Barangay Council.

C. Subsequent Offenses: Fines and/or community service as determined by the Barangay Council, with progressive penalties for repeat violations.

SECTION 10: Implementation.

The Barangay Council, through the Barangay Peace and Order Committee, shall be responsible for the implementation, monitoring, and enforcement of this ordinance. Barangay Tanods, barangay police, and other authorized personnel shall assist in ensuring compliance with the curfew provisions.

SECTION 11: Repealing Clause.

All ordinances, rules, regulations, or parts thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

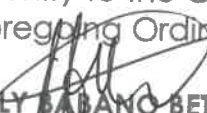

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ALL KINDS OF ANIMALS TO STRAY IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE STREETS, PLAZAS, PARKS, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF IN BARANGAY INDAHAG, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY

WHEREAS, ensuring public safety and welfare is a primary concern of the Barangay Council of Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City;

WHEREAS, stray animals in public and private spaces pose risks to pedestrians, motorists, and the community at large, including incidents of accidents, property damage, and public health concerns;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enact measures to regulate the presence of animals in public and private areas to maintain order, cleanliness, and safety within the barangay;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Barangay of Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City, in session assembled:

SECTION 1: TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as the **"Indahag Animal Stray Prohibition Ordinance."**

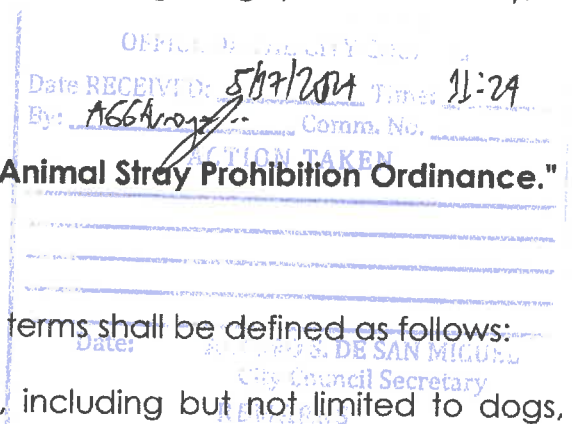
SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as follows:

1. **Animal**: Any non-human living creature, including but not limited to dogs, cats, poultry, livestock, and other domestic or wild animals.
2. **Stray**: Any animal found wandering, loitering, or roaming freely in public or private streets, plazas, parks, and other similar areas without the direct control or supervision of its owner or custodian.

SECTION 3: PROHIBITION

It shall be unlawful for any animal to stray or be allowed to stray in public and private streets, plazas, parks, and other similar areas within Barangay Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City.

SECTION 3: IMPOUNDMENT AND PENALTIES

- A. Any stray animal found in violation of Section 3 shall be subject to immediate apprehension and impoundment by authorized personnel designated by the Barangay Chairman.
- B. An impounding fee of ₱500.00/ per animal shall be collected from the owner(s) claiming the pet payable at the Indahag Barangay Hall.
- C. Unclaimed stay animal shall be confined within three (3) days in the impounding area and can be adopted by any person provided that he will pay for the impounding fee of the animal and provided further that he can provide appropriate care and management to the animal.
- D. Impounded stray animal(s) which are not claimed within five (5) days are considered abandoned by its owners and are subsequently be transfer to the impounding site of the City of Cagayan de Oro.

SECTION 4: IMPLEMENTATION

The Barangay Peace and Order Council (BPOC), in coordination with the Registered Mamatong or Animal Control Officer in the Barangay shall be responsible for the implementation and enforcement of this ordinance.

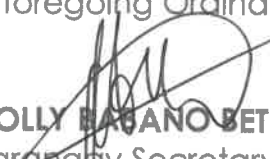

WHEREAS, ensuring the safety and well-being of mothers and infants during childbirth is of paramount importance;

WHEREAS, homebirths conducted without proper medical supervision and facilities may pose risks to the health and lives of mothers and infants, including complications that require immediate medical intervention;

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Barangay Council to promote public health and welfare within its jurisdiction;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Barangay of Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City, in session assembled:

SECTION 1: TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as the **"No Homebirth Policy Ordinance"** in Barangay Indahag.

SECTION 2: POLICY

It shall be the policy of Barangay Indahag to prohibit homebirths within its jurisdiction to ensure the safety and well-being of mothers and infants.

SECTION 3: REQUIREMENT FOR CHILDBIRTH

All expectant mothers residing in Barangay Indahag shall be required to give birth in accredited medical facilities or hospitals equipped with the necessary medical personnel and facilities to handle childbirth complications.

SECTION 4: PENALTIES

Any person found violating this ordinance by conducting or facilitating a homebirth shall be subject to the following penalties:

1. First Warning: Written warning and reprimand.
2. Second Warning: Written warning + 2 weeks Community Service.

3. Last Warning: Referral to the appropriate authorities for further legal action and a fine of ₱1, 000.00 payable to the Barangay Treasurer.

The Barangay Peace and Order Committee (BPOC), Barangay Kagawad Melitona B. Patriana – Chairwoman Committee on Health, City Health Office Personnel, in coordination with relevant health authorities, shall be responsible for the implementation and enforcement of this ordinance.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVITY

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the approval of the Barangay Council subject for review of the City Council of Cagayan de Oro.

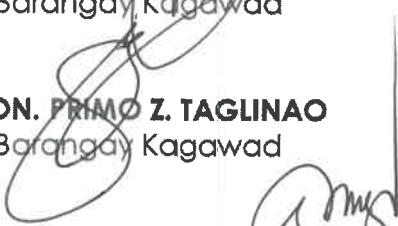

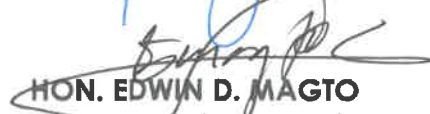

Whereas, Barangay Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City, recognizes the need to formalize the status of Bato as an integral part of our community;

Whereas, Bato has been inhabited by residents who have contributed significantly to the cultural, social, and economic development of Barangay Indahag;

Whereas, the formal recognition of Bato as the 10th Sitio of Barangay Indahag will facilitate better governance, provision of services, and allocation of resources to the area;

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City, assembled in session:

Section 1: Establishment

Barangay Indahag is composed of 9 Sitios namely: (1.) Poblacion, (2.) Lomboy, (3.) Talisay, (4.) Kamakawan, (5.) Sto. Niño, (6.) Sumpung, (7.) Calacapan, (8.) Moloypoloy and (9.) Taguanao.

Bato will be composed of the following homeowners association and subdivision: Mergeville Home Owners Association, Holy Cross Heights, Ecoverde Sierra Homes Subdivision, Phase 1 Bato HOA and Phase 2 Bato HOA with more or less 3, 500 population and 960 households.

Section 2: Boundaries

The boundaries of Bato shall be defined as follows:

- To the North: Sitio Kamakawan, Indahag
- To the South: Caritas Village Poblacion, Indahag
- To the East: Centro, Indahag
- To the West: Bigaan River

Section 3: Rights and Responsibilities

Residents of Bato shall enjoy all the rights and privileges accorded to other sitios within Barangay Indahag, including access to basic services, infrastructure development, and participation in barangay affairs.

The residents of Bato shall also be subject to the laws, ordinances, and regulations of Barangay Indahag and shall actively participate in community activities and initiatives for the betterment of the barangay.

A Sitio Leader for Bato shall be elected within the residents. The Sitio Leader shall represent the interests of Bato in barangay affairs and shall serve as a liaison between the residents and the Barangay Council.

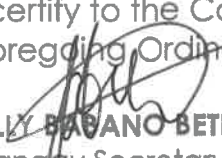

SECTION 5: Funding

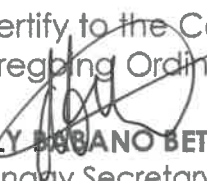

ORDINANCE NO. 004-2020



AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE FISH AND VEGETABLE PEDDLERS WHO ARE NON-RESIDENTS OF THE BARANGAY TO SELL FISH PRODUCTS AND VEGETABLES ONLY ON MONDAYS AND WEDNESDAYS OF EVERY WEEK.

Whereas; there are quite a number of local residents who are fish and vegetable vendors in the barangay's designated selling area who paid local fees to the barangay.

Whereas; the fish and vegetable peddlers who are non-residents of the barangay who sells much cheaper goods and move around the residential areas became disadvantageous to the local fish and vegetable vendors of the barangay.

Whereas; the peace and order committee seek in the monitoring of these non-resident fish vendors roaming around the barangay selling their commodities, the constituents in the barangay does not have any idea of who these people are, all they know is that they are just fish vendors selling seafood products from unknown areas.

Whereas; the Barangay Council of Indahag prioritizes livelihood opportunities to the residents to boost local commerce in our barangay by regulating these fish and vegetable peddlers who are non-residents of the barangay.

Now therefore; be it ordained by the barangay council this city in session assembled that;

Section 1 - Title - this ordinance shall be known as The Regulation of Fish and Vegetable Peddlers Ordinance of Barangay Indahag.

Section 2 - Definition of Terms - For the purpose of this ordinance, fish and vegetable peddler refers to mobile sellers of fish and vegetable products who are non-resident of the barangay. Regulating refers to scheduling the entry and selling of fish and vegetable products.

Section 3 - Who are involved - All fish and vegetable peddlers who are non-residents of the barangay.

Section 4 - Implementing Personnel - The Barangay Tanod shall act as implementing personnel.

Section 5 - Penalties - violators of this ordinance shall be penalized with the following:

1st Offense: Reprimand from the barangay.

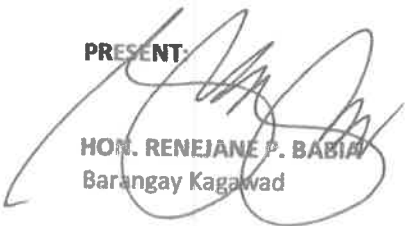

Section 5 - Penalties - violators of this ordinance shall be penalized with the following:

1st Offense: Reprimand from the barangay.

2nd Offense: A fine of Php 1,000.00

3^{rs} Offense: A fine of Php 1,000.00 and a written recommendation from the barangay to the city government for the revocation of the business permit.

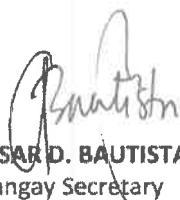

BARANGAY ORDINANCE NO: 001 SERIES OF 2023

"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT OF BARANGAY LUMBIA, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY."

- WHEREAS,** Barangay Lumbia is committed to the protection, preservation and conservation of the ecosystem;
- WHEREAS,** it is the responsibility of the barangay to effectively and efficiently implement the Solid Waste Management System under City Ordinance 13378 - 2018 in its territorial jurisdictions;
- WHEREAS,** Chapter 3 Section 389 of the Local Government Code (RA 7160) provides that the Barangay Council headed by the Barangay Captain is recognized having the important role of delivering an efficient, effective and economical governance, the purpose of which, as related to the implantation of laws and regulations related to control of pollution and protection of the environment, particularly to solid waste management, is a matter of general welfare of the Barangay and its inhabitants;
- WHEREAS,** the practice of waste segregation to facilitate reuse and recycling does not only reduce the cost of collection and disposal of garbage but conserves the natural resources of materials and avoid wasteful consumption of goods;

NOW THEREFORE, recommendation of Punong Barangay, **HON. ALEXANDER V. TORRALBA**, duly seconded by **KAGAWAD QUIRINO B. SALUNA**, **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY ON ITS REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED ON TUESDAY, 18 JULY 2023:**

ARTICLE I – GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance on the Ecological Solid Waste Management of Barangay Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City"

ARTICLE II – COVERAGE

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall apply to all residential houses; commercial establishments such as restaurants, eateries, department stores, groceries, sari-sari stores, auto-repair shops; institutions like hospitals, schools, churches, public and private offices; industrial establishments of any kind; and agricultural areas situated within the territorial jurisdictions of Barangay Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City"

ARTICLE III – LEGAL BASIS, PURPOSE, GOAL AND OBJECTIVES

SECTION 3. LEGAL BASIS. This Ordinance is enacted to implement the provisions of Republic Act No. 9003 which mandates the proper segregation and collection of household wastes.

SECTION 4. PURPOSE. This Ordinance is enacted for the following purposes:

- 4.1 To promote and protect the health, safety, peace and convenience of the general welfare of the inhabitants of the Barangay;
- 4.2 To guide, control and regulate the generation of solid wastes within the Barangay and promote an orderly and sanitary system for the same;
- 4.3 To enhance the total environment of the locality through the necessary control and mitigation of negative environmental impacts of solid waste;

4.4 To strengthen education and advocacy activities in collaboration with various stakeholders to promote environmental awareness and action among inhabitants;

4.5 To minimize the generation of solid waste and maximize possible resource/recovery/recycling and utilization by:

- a. Maximizing the use of goods and consumption of foods;
- b. Encouraging the salvaging of possible “recoverable” from solid wastes for re-use and/or recycling back to production process; and
- c. Encouraging the recycling and resource recovery of wastes in own backyards through composting.

SECTION 5. GOAL. The primary goal of this Ordinance is to enhance ecological balance of the community through sustainable and integrated waste management.

SECTION 6. OBJECTIVES. The objectives of this Ordinance are the following:

- 6.1 To ensure round-the-clock cleanliness through the orderly waste management;
- 6.2 To eradicate unsightly, uncovered and overflowing waste containers in streets, public places and open spaces;
- 6.3 To maximize and optimize sanitary resource recovery for feeds, materials and others; and
- 6.4 To minimize pollution arising from harmful gases, smoke particulates produced by needless burning/dumping, polluted runoffs into water sources/supply, and hazardous substances.

ARTICLE IV – DEFINITION OF TERMS

SECTION 7. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this Ordinance, the following term has its meaning as follows:

- 7.1 Collection – refers to the act of removing solid waste from the source or from a communal storage point.
- 7.2 Biodegradable – shall refer to any material that can be reduced into finer particles, degraded or decomposed by microbiological or enzymes. This is synonymous with compostable.
- 7.3 Biodegradable Wastes – is a type of waste, typically originating from plant or animal sources, which may be degraded by other living organisms.
- 7.4 Compost – decayed organic material for use as soil conditioner or fertilizer.
- 7.5 Composting – biological degradation under controlled conditions; the process of making biodegradables such as food waste, garden waste and selective animal waste into compost by mixing them with soil, water, biological additives/activators (optional) and air.
- 7.6 Recyclable Wastes – dry papers & newspapers, dry cardboards & cartons, plastic materials like plastic containers, plastic water and soda bottles, plastic bottle caps, PVC & PE pipes, computer casing, tin cans & covers, aluminum cans, iron steel, copper wires, broken transparent glasses, glass bottles, toner cartridges, computer ink cartridges.
- 7.7 Residual Wastes – refers to waste that presents no other use or purpose and cannot be classified as compostable, recyclable, non-reusable such as sando bags, packing wrappers, styropors / Styrofoam, cigarette butts, worn out plastic sacks, dirt from sweepings, worn out rags, sanitary napkins, disposable diapers, plastic straws, parlor & barbershop waste, household medicine bottles, poultry feathers.
- 7.8 Material Recovery Facility – refers to the designated establishment or structure designed to temporarily receive or store sorted, separated and recovered waste before transfer, transported and disposed to the identified sanitary landfill site.

ARTICLE V – SEGREGATION OF WASTES

SECTION 8. MANDATORY SEGREGATION OF SOLID WASTES. The segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources:

SECTION 9. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SEGREGATION AND STORAGE OF SOLID WASTE PENDING COLLECTION. The following shall be the minimum standards and requirements for segregation and storage of solid waste pending collection:

9.1 There shall be a suitable container such as a plastic bag or the like for the ecological solid waste before these are brought out along the streets or being brought out at the assigned dumping areas.

9.2 There shall be a separate container for each type of waste from all sources.

9.3 The solid waste container depending on its use shall be properly marked or identified for on-site collection as follows:

a. Biodegradables/Compostables or “Malata”;

b. Recyclables or “Mapuslan pa”; and

c. Residuals or “Di Malata ug ‘di na mapuslan.”

ARTICLE VI – COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

SECTION 10. COLLECTION/DROP-OFF POINTS. All zones must have a designated strategic collection/drop-off points to facilitate the hauling of segregated solid waste materials of the barangay. Only segregated solid waste materials must be brought to the collection points at the time and date of collection.

SECTION 11. SANITARY CREWS/SANITARY AIDES. The barangay must assign sanitary crews/sanitary aides to gather biodegradables and recyclables and handle the transfer to the Barangay MRF.

SECTION 12. COLLECTION OF SEGREGATED WASTE MATERIALS AT THE BARANGAY. The City Garbage Collector through the City Ecological Solid Waste Management Task Force shall be the responsible agent in the collection of residual waste materials. On the other hand, the Barangay will be the one liable for the collection of the biodegradable and recyclable waste.

SECTION 13. SCHEDULE OF SEGREGATED SOLID WASTE MATERIALS COLLECTION AT THE BARANGAY. The schedule of collection for the accumulated segregated solid waste materials at the barangay will be determined in coordination with the barangay concern and be properly disseminated by the CLENRO.

SECTION 14. RESIDENTIAL AREAS. The garbage shall be collected through the present system of collection within the barangay. Independent collection systems of the composite barangays shall be followed.

SECTION 15. SCHOOLS, CHURCHES, AND BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS. All garbage in these locations shall also be collected in the same manner as in Section 14.

SECTION 16. AGRICULTURAL AREAS. Agricultural areas shall convert organic wastes into compost in their respective areas.

SECTION 17. TIME OF DUMPING. Time of dumping of ecological solid wastes for collection at the collection point/sites shall be:

17.1 For zones that are along the Barangay main road at 6:00 AM subject to change from the City Collection Schedule.

ARTICLE VII – PLASTIC BAG REGULATION

SECTION 18. THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS SHALL APPLY IN THE USE OF PLASTIC BAGS IN ALL COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE BARANGAY:

- a. Business establishments, food vendors or food outlets, pharmacies, market vendors, food kiosk, sari-sari store, ambulant vendors and customers and the like shall not provide plastic bags or sando bags.
- b. Wet goods that are already in plastic wraps, pouches, bags and the likes as part of the product packaging are allowed.
- c. The use recyclable and reusable bags as alternative packaging materials shall be promoted such as natural fiber bags, woven bags (bayong), cloth bags, rattan baskets, shopping bags made from recyclable waste materials.
- d. All commercial establishments shall adopt the "Bring Your Own Bag (BYOB) Program" to mainstream the use of reusable bags.

ARTICLE VIII - PROHIBITED ACTS

SECTION 19. PROHIBITED ACTS. The following acts are prohibited and its corresponding Fines and Penalties:

19.1 Bringing out, and dumping of garbage outside of collection day and proper time of dumping for collection, indiscriminately dumping garbage, littering, throwing, dumping of solid waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canals, drainage systems, curbs and gutters, esteros or parks, creeks, rivers, tributaries, rivulets and other natural waterways, and establishment, or causing or permitting the same;

19.2 The open and indiscriminate burning of residual and special wastes;

19.3 Causing or permitting the collection of non-segregated or unsorted waste/non-segregation of wastes into biodegradable, recyclable, and residual/special; and

19.4 Unauthorized removal of recyclable materials intended for collection by authorized persons.

19.5 Transportation and dumping in bulk of collected domestic, industrial, commercial and institutional wastes in areas other than the Sanitary Landfill.

SECTION 20. FINES AND PENALTIES. The following fines and penalties shall be imposed to any person who violates specific provisions of this ordinance. He/she shall be issued with a BARANGAY ORDINANCE VIOLATION RECIEPT (BOVR) by an enforcer duly assigned/designated by the Punong Barangay.

20.1 For paragraphs (19.1) to (19.4):

First Offense – Php 300.00 and promissory note and one (1) day community service

Second Offense – Php 500 or three (3) days community service

Third Offense – Php700 or five (5) days community service

Subsequent – Php1, 000.00 with ten (10) days community service

20.2 For paragraph 19.5:

First Offense – Php 700.00

Second Offense – Php 1, 000.00 and must join 5 barangays clean up during the Barangay Clean up

Third Offense – refer to CLENRO for issuance of penalty worth P5, 000.00

20.3 Households and establishments that do not provide receptacles/containers for their solid waste;

First Offense – promissory note and 1day community service

Second Offense – Php 300.00

Third Offense – Php 500.00

Subsequent – Php 700. 00

20.4 Not keeping the surrounding areas and immediate premises clean by establishments, institutions, households and other concerned occupants. Streets shall be kept clean by occupants or owners of properties lining the street from the line of the property to the middle of the street and from one property to the other.

First Offense – promissory note and one (1) day community service

Second Offense – Php 500.00 or three (3) days community service

Third Offense – Php700.00 or five (5) days community service

Subsequent – Php1, 000.00 with ten (10) days community service

20.5 Any violation of Article VII of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be penalized with a fine of Php 100 per plastic bag issuance

20.6 If the offense is committed by a corporation, partnership, or other juridical entity duly organized in accordance with law, the chief executive officer, president, general manager, managing partner or such other officer-in-charge shall be liable for the commission of the offense penalized under this Ordinance.

20.7 If corporation, partnership, or other juridical entity duly organized in accordance with law ignores the notice of violation, the Barangay Council will refer the case to City Government by submitting “**BLACK LISTED ESTABLISHMENTS**” to refrain them from getting Business Permits.

20.8 Violators shall not be given barangay clearances and certifications until he/she has paid and/or served his/her fines/penalties. Their names also shall be posted at conspicuous places in the barangay.

20.9 Violations shall be accounted per household and the head of the family shall be responsible in the implementation of the Ordinance in their respective household. In effect, any violation committed by the household shall be carried by all members of the said household except household helps, transient visitors, and other temporary or visiting individuals.

ARTICLE IX. ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT MECHANISM

SECTION 21. ENFORCEMENT – An enforcement of this Ordinance shall entail the following procedure:

- a) Apprehension
- b) Issuance of Barangay Ordinance Violation Receipt (BOVR)
- c) Payment of fine depending on prescribed penalty

SECTION 22. DEPUTIZATION – The Punong Barangay shall deputize persons, individuals or entities to be solid waste management enforcers; giving them the authority to affect the apprehension of violators in accordance with this Ordinance, provided that no person shall be deputized until he/she has completed the necessary training and capacity building for the effective implementation of the Ordinance.

SECTION 23. OVR ISSUANCE – The deputized agents shall issue Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR) to the violators; Payment of fines imposed for violation(s) of this ordinance shall be made at the Barangay Hall, specifically, to be received by the Barangay Treasurer.

SECTION 24. UTILIZATION OF COLLECTED FINES. The fines collected shall accrue in favor of the following:

- A. Thirty percent (30%) to be given as an incentive to the informant and/or enforcer implementing this ordinance
- B. Seventy percent (70%) which shall be called as Brgy. Ecological Solid Waste Management (ESWM) Fund, shall be used for the following within the fiscal year of which the fines were collected:

- 24.1 Honoraria for the Barangay Kaagapay Advocates of Eco-aides;
- 24.2 Procurement of Materials, Equipment, Protective Gears and other items necessary for the proper implementation of the Ecological Solid Waste Management of the Barangay;
- 24.3 Information, education, communication and monitoring activities of the Ecological Solid Waste Management of Barangay;
- 24.4 Acquisition of products, facilities, technologies and processes necessary to enhance proper ecological solid waste management;
- 24.5 Transportation/Hauling of ecological solid wastes;
- 24.6 Awards and incentives;
- 24.7 Research programs;
- 24.8 Technical assistance;
- 24.9 Capability-building activities; and
- 24.10 Maintenance and other related activities, programs, etc. for the Materials Recovery Facility of Cluster.

ARTICLE IX – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

SECTION 25. CITIZEN SUITS. For purposes of enforcing the provisions of this Ordinance, any citizen may file an appropriate civil or criminal action in the barangay against any person who violates or fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance. The Barangay concerned shall exempt such action from payment of filing fees.

SECTION 26. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstances is declared unconstitutional, the remainder of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.

SECTION 27. REPEALING CLAUSE. All existing ordinances and resolutions of this barangay found to be inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 28. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.

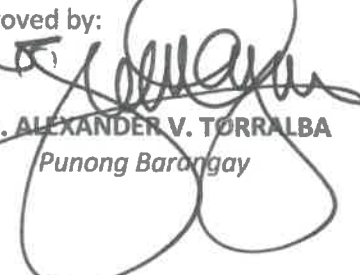

WHEREAS, the creation of a stand-alone Senior High School will support the city's educational objectives by ensuring students have access to a more specialized curriculum, along with improved resources for both academic and vocational tracks;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Clarissa Guidaben, Chairman of the Committee on Education, duly seconded by Hon. SK Chair Mary Grace Llido, the Sangguniang Barangay of Nazareth, in a session duly assembled, **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

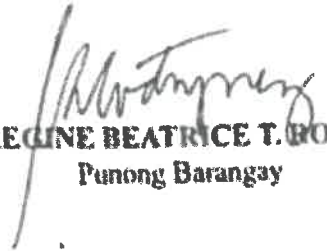
1. To express full support for the establishment of Cagayan de Oro National High School - Senior High School (CDONHS-SHS) as a stand-alone institution;

3. To forward a copy of this resolution to the City Council of Cagayan de Oro for their consideration and approval.

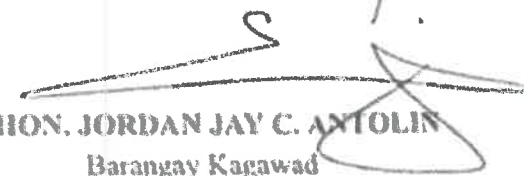

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement executed by and between:

The **COMMISSION ON POPULATION AND DEVELOPMENT (CPD) - REGION X**, an agency of the National Government with office address at Jesus V. Serina St., Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, represented by its Regional Director, **NEIL ALDRIN G. OMEGA**, herein referred to as "**CPD-X**";

-and-

The **CITY OF CAGAYAN DE ORO**, a Local Government Unit (LGU) with office address at 89 Capistrano-Hayes St., Cagayan de Oro City, represented herein by its City Mayor, **HON. ROLANDO A. UY**, herein referred to as "**LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY**"

WITNESSETH: That,

WHEREAS, the **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY** envisions a strategic and prime development hub of the south, a city managed through good governance, with an empowered citizenry that thrives in a highly competitive economy, and a sustainable environment that nurtures its diversity and multi-cultural heritage towards a resilient, progressive, and inclusive future.

WHEREAS, the **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY** recognizes that at the core of the locality's vision and thrust are the people who are the drivers and subject of local development, hence, the importance of enabling each individual and institution to have increased share and opportunity for socioeconomic progress;

WHEREAS, the **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY** recognizes the importance of optimizing the current's demographic opportunity and addressing critical population issues within the locality to support and accelerate socioeconomic development;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates the local government units to provide family planning and population development services, as part of the basic welfare services;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Population and Development Plan of Action (PPD-POA) 2023-2028, which was approved by the Office of the President through Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 40, provides a framework for inter-agency collaboration to optimize demographic opportunities and address remaining population challenges in order to accelerate the attainment of the socioeconomic development agenda under the PDP 2023-2028;

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular No. 40 series of 2023 mandated the **CPD** to take the lead in the coordination of the implementation of the PPD-POA 2023-2028;

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular No. 40, series of 2023, mandated the whole of government including LGUs to support the implementation of the PPD-POA 2023-2028.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

Section 1: OBJECTIVES

This MOA between **CPD-X** and **LGU OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY** aims to establish a collaborative mechanism and arrangements between the parties for developing and pursuing population and development strategies to optimize demographic opportunities and address prevailing population issues to accelerate local socio-economic development.

It specifically aims to achieve the following strategic objectives:

1. To strengthen local structure and coordinative and collaborative mechanism to plan, coordinate, implement monitor and evaluate population and development (POPDEV) strategies based on a local POPDEV strategic plan;
2. To strengthen the competencies and capacities of local workers and staff and relevant institutions in pursuing POPDEV strategies;
3. To establish or strengthen implementing mechanisms to ensure efficiency in the planning and delivery of POPDEV services;
4. To improve enabling policy environment for optimizing demographic opportunities and addressing prevailing population issues within the locality;
5. To strengthen leadership in pursuing local POPDEV strategies; and,
6. To establish a reliable POPDEV database that supports development, implementation, and assessment of local POPDEV strategies.

Section 2: ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

1. The CPD-X:

To support the LGU of Cagayan de Oro City, the CPD-X shall:

- 1.1 Provide technical assistance to the LGU OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY in the attainment of the mutual objectives of this MOA (as spelled out in SECTION 1);
- 1.2 Collaborate with the LGU in assessing and capacity building interventions in improving the competencies of staff and leaders involved in the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of local POPDEV strategies; and,
- 1.3 Provide timely coaching and mentoring to concerned local leaders and managers in pursuing POPDEV strategies.

2. The LGU OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY shall:

- 2.1 Strive to pursue the mutual objectives of this MOA (as provided in Section 2) through mobilization and active engagement of relevant local structures and offices and allocation of needed resources;
- 2.2 Pursue sustainability of POPDEV strategies and interventions through, but not limited to, integration of such strategies in the local development plans and investment program;

- 2.3 Establish a reliable POPDEV database/s that supports the development, implementation, and assessment of local POPDEV strategies such as Registry of Barangay Inhabitants and Migrants (RBIM), Family Planning Information System (FPIS), etc.
 - 2.4 Monitor and evaluate the results of POPDEV strategies for enhancement; and,
 - 2.5. Create or facilitate participation of civil society organizations, people organizations, development partners and other relevant institutions to foster participatory program implementation.
3. All information, data, documents and papers exchanged between LGU-CDO and CPD X in relation to the preparation and execution of this MOA shall be treated by the parties with utmost confidentiality and shall not be divulged or shared with any third party, without the prior written consent of either of the party.
- The parties shall further acknowledge and agree that for the purposes of this Agreement, each party is responsible for compliance with all obligations and duties applicable under the Data Privacy Act of 2012 with respect of any Personal Data which the parties may process in delivery of the services.
4. There shall be no employer-employee relationship between the LGU-CDO and CPD X. CPD X shall have exclusive control and supervision of its employees in the performance of the obligations herein agreed upon. CPD X shall be solely responsible for all acts and/or omissions of its employees allowed by it to have access to the data in line with the program subject to the present MOA. Any accident, injury or sickness of any kind, or death that may occur to any employee of CPD X during the implementation or any of the activities conducted in line with the MOA shall likewise be sole responsibility of CPD X. CPD X further binds itself to hold LGU-CDO free and harmless from any claim on account of the aforementioned injury or damage in line with the implementation of the program.
5. In case of litigation arising from or in connection with the MOA, the parties agree that the venue of this action shall be at the proper court in the City of Cagayan de Oro only.

Section 3: SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

In the event that one or more provisions contained herein shall be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect and for any reason, the remaining provisions shall remain valid, legal and enforceable.

Section 4: DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THIS AGREEMENT

All appendices hereto attached are hereby expressly made an integral part of this agreement by reference, excluding inconsistencies with any/all part, terms, and conditions contained in this Memorandum of Agreement.

Section 5: EFFECTIVITY OF THE AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall take effect upon signing of both parties and shall be in effect for a period of one year.
