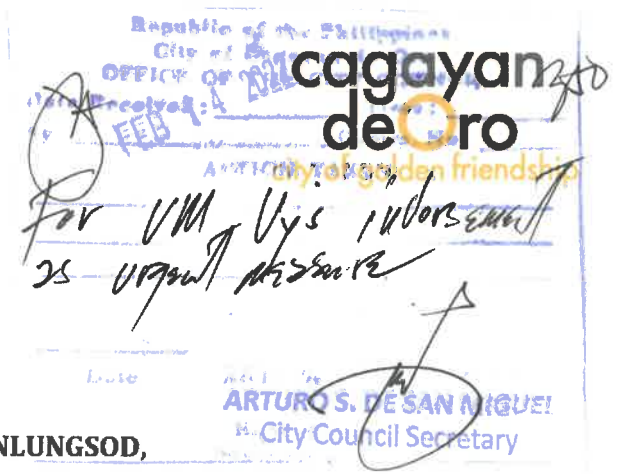

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

The undersigned respectfully requests the Honorable Body to grant him authority to represent the City Government of Cagayan de Oro, as the local chief executive, and to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") with the Municipal Government of Gitagum, Misamis Oriental, to be represented by the Honorable Municipal Mayor, Emmanuel S. Mugot, covering the Parties' partnership in the establishment of a hospital referral arrangement, whereby the City-owned JR Borja General Hospital ("JRBGH") will serve as referral hospital, and will receive the patients endorsed by the Gitagum Municipal Health Center, DOTS and Birthing Facility.

Under the arrangement, which promotes the "whole-of-government approach", the City will allow the patients of JMH requiring a higher level of hospital care be referred to JRBGH. The latter will provide the needed curative and maternal care services, which require medical and technical expertise not available at the above-mentioned municipal health center. This tie-up is subject to certain conditions intended to prevent the impairment of services which JRBGH provide to its own patients, thus, ensuring that the latter will receive priority attention in their medical needs over the endorsed patients of municipal health center, who will then be referred to the other hospitals in the City.

This collaboration by the two local government units ("LGUs") is consistent with the policy of the government, whereby a higher level public hospital like JRBGH provides the needed health and hospital assistance to a lower level public health facility like municipal health center.

In this regard, the undersigned respectfully requests the appropriate action of the August Body regarding this concern, which I hereby certify as an urgent legislative measure. A draft copy of the MOA is attached herewith for your easy reference.

JR BORJA GENERAL HOSPITAL, a LEVEL 1 government health institution with principal address at Serifa St., Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, headed by its Chief of Hospital, DR. RAMON MORENO , and represented herein by its CITY MAYOR HON. OSCAR S. MORENO, herein referred to as the **"SECOND PARTY"**

-Witnesseth that-

WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement are both health care providers, geared in preserving life and maintaining quality in rendering service to the clients;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is capable of providing primary health care and basic maternity care services through its health Center and Birthing Facility;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY, as a Level 1 hospital, is equipped with facilities, competent medical specialists, and other paramedical staff related to providing quality and effective secondary curative care and maternity care services;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 
1. The Second Party, being a referral hospital, hereby signifies its intention to accept at the foregoing facility and to provide the secondary curative care and maternity care services needed by the clients and/or patients of the First Party.
 2. Upon referral, the Second party shall perform secondary curative and maternity care services which require medical and technical expertise related hereto which the First Party is incapable of performing.
 3. The second Party shall perform the services with reasonable care and skill.
 4. The Second Party shall commence the provisions of the foregoing services with the First Party on January 1 2022 until December 31, 2022 or unless sooner terminated or rescinded by either party.

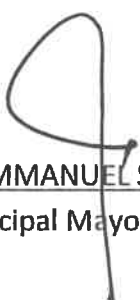
5. In case of extreme emergency, when the Operating Room of the Second Party is unavailable and/or when it is impossible for it to accommodate the referral of the First Party, the SECOND PARTY has the right to refuse and indorse the referral to another nearest hospital for immediate medical and/or surgical interventions.

8. This MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT does not create an employer – employee relationship between the FIRST PARTY, its employees, agents or sub – contractors, and the SECOND PARTY, its employees, agents or sub – contractors.
9. Except as herein provided, neither party shall assign or transfer all or any part of its rights under this agreement without the prior written consent of both parties.
10. The regular court or competent quasi – judicial bodies of Cagayan de Oro City shall have the exclusive jurisdiction over any disputes and/or claims arising hereto.

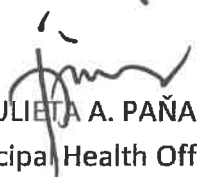

b. Nothing in this Clause will serve to limit or exclude either Party's liability for death or personal injury arising from its own negligence.

2.3 Termination – Either Party may terminate this Agreement upon notice in writing if;

a. The other is in breach of any material obligation contained in this Agreement, which is not remedied (if the same is capable of being remedied) within 30 days of written notice from the other party so to do; or

b. A voluntary arrangement is approved, bankruptcy or an administration order is made or a receiver or administration receiver is appointed over any of the other Party's assets or an undertaking or a resolution or petition to wind up the other party is passed or presented (other than for the purposes of amalgamation or reconstruction) or any analogous procedure in the country of incorporation of either party or if any circumstances arise which entitles a court of competent jurisdiction or a creditor to appoint a receiver, administrative receiver or administrator or to present a winding – up order in respect to the other Party.

Any termination of this Agreement (howsoever occasional) shall not affect any accrued rights or liabilities of either party nor shall it affect the coming into force or to continuance in force of any provision hereof which is express or by implication intended to come into or continue in force or on after such termination.

2. 4 Relationship of the Parties – the Parties acknowledge and agree that the Services performed by the Referral Facility, its employees, agents or subcontractors shall be as an independent contractor and that nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to constitute a partnership, joint a venture, agency relationship or otherwise between the parties.

2. 5 Confidentiality – Neither party will use, copy, adapt, alter, or part with possession of any information of the other which is disclosed or otherwise comes into possession under or in relation to this Agreement and which is of a confidential nature. This obligation will not apply in information which the recipient can prove was in its possession at the date it was received or obtained or which the recipient obtains from some other person with good legal title to it or which is in or comes into the public domain or otherwise than through the default or negligence of the recipient or which is independently developed by or for the recipient.

2.6 Notices – Any notice which may be given by a Party under this Agreement shall be deemed to have been duly delivered if delivered by hand, registered mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail to the address of the other Party as a specified in this Agreement or any other address notified in writing to the other Party.

2. 7 Miscellaneous –

a. The failure of either party to enforce its right under this Agreement at any time for any period shall not be constructed as a waiver of such rights.

b. If any part, term or provision on this Agreement is held to be illegal or unenforceable, neither the validity or enforce ability of this Agreement without the consent of the other party.

c. Neither Party shall assign or transfer all or any its rights under this Agreement without the consent of the other party.

d. This Agreement may not be amended for any other reason without the prior written agreement of both parties.

e. This Agreement constitute the entire understanding between the parties relating to the subject matter hereof unless any representation or warranty made about this Agreement was made fraudulently and, save as may be expressly referred to or referred herein, supersedes all prior representation, writings, negotiations or understanding with respect hereto.

f. Neither Party shall be liable for failure to perform or delay in performing any obligation under this Agreement if the failure or delay is caused by any circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, war, civil commotions or industrial dispute. If such delay or failure continues in at least 7 days, the party not affected by such delay or failure shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement by notice in writing to the other.

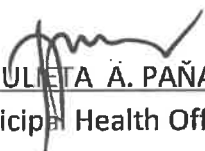

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES (BFAR) REGIONAL FISHERIES OFFICE NO. 10 AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BALIK SIGLA SA ILOG AT LAWA (BASIL) PROGRAM.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **Memorandum of Agreement** entered into by and between:

The **BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES-10**, a government agency organized and existing under Philippine laws, with office at Macabalan, Cagayan de Oro City (Misamis Oriental), represented herein by **TEODORO A. BACOLOD, JR.**, Regional Director hereinafter referred to as "**BFAR**"

-and-

The **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, MISAMIS ORIENTAL** a government agency created and existing under Philippine laws, with principal office at City Hall, general Capistrano Street, Cagayan de Oro City represented herein by **HON. OSCAR S. MORENO**, City Mayor, hereinafter referred to as the "**LGU**".

-WITNESSETH -

WHEREAS, the 1987 Philippine Constitution directs the State to protect the rights of subsistence fishermen, especially of local communities, to the preferential use of communal marine and fishing resources, both inland and offshore and to provide support thereto through appropriate technology and research, adequate financial, production, and marketing assistance, and other services;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8550, otherwise known as the "*Philippine Fisheries Code of 1998*", as amended by RA 10654 mandated BFAR to provide fishery livelihood projects assistance with the aim of providing support to marginal fisherfolk in the exercise of their preferential rights to benefit from the country's fisheries resources, especially in municipal waters;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "*Local Government Code of 1991*", mandates the LGU to provide its constituents extension facilities related to agriculture and fishery activities which include water and soil resource utilization and conservation projects and enforcement of fishery laws in municipal waters;

WHEREAS, the BFAR-10 as mandated by law to improve fisheries productivity and empower stakeholders toward food security, global competitiveness and climate change adaptation;

WHEREAS, the provision of BASIL Components such as Capacity Building, Habitat Restoration, Establishment of Habitat Structures, Stock Assessment and Fisheries Enhancement (dispersal of tilapia/carp fry/fingerlings and other

indigenous freshwater fish fry/fingerlings) as part of the on-going collaboration between the BFAR and the LGU (hereinafter collectively dubbed as the “PARTIES”) in the implementation of BalikSigla sa Ilog at Lawa (BASIL) Program of BFAR in a one (1) year period;

WHEREAS, the **PARTIES** identified Danao Lake located at Barangay Pagalungan, Cagayan de Oro City as BASIL Management Area to rehabilitate and restore;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and to ensure the efficient implementation of BASIL Program, the PARTIES do hereby mutually stipulate to agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. ROLES OF THE BFAR-10:

- a. Provide free dispersal of tilapia/carp fry/fingerlings and other indigenous freshwater fish fry/fingerlings to the LGU-Cagayan de Oro City for them to disperse to the identified BASIL Management area
- b. Provide technical assistance to the LGU and identified fisherfolk association regarding the implementation of the components of BASIL Program mentioned above;
- c. Provide capability enhancement to the project recipients;
- d. Allocate budget for the implementation of BASIL Program in a one (1) year period;
- e. Supervise dispersal of tilapia/prawn fry/fingerlings and other indigenous freshwater fish fry/fingerlings) through the PFOs; and
- f. Conduct monitoring and evaluation of the project.

2. ROLES OF THE LGU:

- a. Identify and submit a list of qualified DOLE registered fisherfolk beneficiaries using the criteria set by BFAR;
- b. Facilitate the documentary requirements of all activities necessary for the implementation of the BASIL Program;
- c. Assist BFAR on the creation of Fisherfolk Association if there's none existing;
- d. Assist BFAR during the conduct of monitoring and evaluation of the program;
- e. Collect regular production catch data from the fisherfolk-beneficiaries residing at the vicinity/near the area and submit to BFAR thru the PFO; and
- f. Continue the BASIL Program even after the one (1) year allocated implementation budget set by BFAR, with its components for management and conservation of the rehabilitated area for long term sustainable fish production.

ARTICLE III
SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

In the event of force majeure or any unforeseen calamity, which is not covered by the provisions of this MOA and as a consequence thereof the implementation of the project is affected and, hence, there is a need to discuss and resolve the implications thereof, the parties shall immediately agree to amend this MOA to resolve the issues concerning the unforeseen circumstances and shall endeavor to make appropriate actions to expedite the continuation of the project.

Should there be any conflict or controversy such as failure to submit production report to BFAR that may subsequently arise between parties as a result of breach by either parties in any of the terms and conditions of this MOA, the parties shall first resort to a dialogue to amicably settle any controversies arising from the contract prior to any judicial action.

The provisions of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise known as the "Administrative Code of 1987", particularly on the procedure of settlement of intra-government disputes shall be suppletorily adopted in this MOA.

ARTICLE IV
MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

A. Amendment

Any modification or amendment to this MOA shall be mutually agreed upon by the parties and reduced in writing.

B. Other Relevant Guidelines

Consent of both parties must be properly secured on any change, modification, and reversion in the physical implementation of the above project.

Fisheries Office Order (FOO) No. 338 s. 2019: Guidelines on the Dispersal/Distribution of Fish Fingerlings and Broodstock, and **FOO No. 199 s. 2019:** Guidelines on the Implementation of BalikSigla sa Ilog at Lawa (BASIL) Program, and other relevant guidelines shall form part of this MOA and shall be binding for all parties.

C. Separability Clause

If any provision of this MOA or the application thereof to any circumstance is later declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

D. Effectivity Clause

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** shall take effect on the date of the signing by the parties and shall continue to be effective until the herein project is fully implemented or unless sooner revoked upon the mutual consent of the parties.
