This Memorandum of Undertaking is entered into and executed by and between:

Section 1. COVERAGE

Section1.1 This Memorandum of Undertaking covers the implementation of the Farm-to-Market Road projects validated and prioritized by DA for implementation by the DPWH.

Section1.2 Policy Guidelines. All proposed Farm-to-Market Roads must meet the criteria stated in the Implementing Guidelines on the implementation of Farm-to-Market Road Development Program of the Department of Agriculture.

Section 2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY – 1st DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE (DPWH)

Section2.1 The DPWH shall cause the preparation of Programs of Work (POWs) and Detailed Engineering Design (DED), noted by the DA in accordance with existing guidelines and applicable rules and regulations on the matter.

Section2.2 The DPWH shall consider the 10% counterpart fund of CLGU amounting to Two Million Pesos (Php 2,000,000.00) for the implementation of the Farm-to-Market Road Projects, with breakdown as follows:

The counterpart fund shall be in the form of cash and shall be downloaded by CLGU-Cagayan de Oro City to the DPWH thru a funding check. This shall fund the corresponding lengthening of projects as herein mentioned. However, should the CLGU fail to download the counterpart funds, the CLGU shall implement the works for the lengthening of these projects with the use of its counterpart funds.

Section2.3 The DPWH shall issue official receipt to the CLGU of Cagayan de Oro upon receipt of the 10% counterpart for the implementation of the Farm-to-Market Road Projects.

Section2.4 The DPWH shall secure Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) or Certificate of Non-Coverage (CNC) if applicable and adhere to its provisions and the other social safeguard measures.

Section2.5 The DPWH shall undertake the bidding and award of contract for the project's civil works in accordance with R.A. 9184- Government Procurement Reform Act. The DPWH may pursue the procurement process upon the approval of the POW & DED and Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAF).

Section2.6 The DPWH may conduct procurement of the Project upon receipt of SAA and consider the 10% CLGU counterpart fund for lengthening of the project.

Section2.7 The DPWH shall be responsible for the 100% completion of the project in case the contractors defaults in the implementation of the said project.

Section 2.8 The DPWH shall complete the FMR project within the duration indicated in the PERT/CPM.

Section 2.9 The DPWH shall be fully responsible for the accounting and disbursement of funds in accordance with existing COA, DBM and other existing government procedures, rules and regulations.

Section 2.10 The DPWH shall designate a Project Engineer who shall supervise all the project activities throughout its duration.

Section 2.11 The DPWH shall facilitate the turnover of completed Farm-to Market Road to the concerned LGU-beneficiaries in accordance with the provisions of the Memorandum of Undertaking.

Section 3. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CITY LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO

Section 3.1 The CLGU shall issue Certificate of Availability of Funds to the DPWH for the CLGU Counterpart Fund amounting to TWO MILLION PESOS (Php 2,000,000.00) signed by the City Local Finance Committee.

Section 3.2 The CLGU Counterpart Fund amounting to same as above shall be downloaded by the CLGU to the DPWH-CDOC 1st District Engineering Office, upon approval of the MOU, through a funding check.

Section 3.3 The CLGU shall monitor the project implementation of the said FMR projects enumerated and identified under this MOU.

Section 3.4 The CLGU shall maintain the good road condition of the FMR projects after completion and turn-over of the DPWH.

Section 4. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 4.1 DPWH-CDOC 1st DEO shall transfer the assets at cost to the CLGU after final acceptance of the project and all required liquidation reports are submitted. Accordingly, such assets shall be taken up in the books of the CLGU.

Section 4.2 In the event of any breach of disagreement, DPWH-CDOC 1st DEO has the option to terminate this agreement given ten (10)-day written notice besides other rights and remedies it may avail of.

Section 4.3 Implementation of Standards and Procedures. The parties hereto guarantee to carry out the projects using generally accepted professional and technical standards of the DPWH, and in accordance with the attached schedules and appropriate Procurement Procedures of R.A.9184 Government Procurement Reform Act.

Section 4.4 Authorized Representatives. Any action required or permitted to be taken, and any document required or permitted to be executed under this Undertaking on behalf of the DPWH/CLGU may be taken or executed by the DPWH/CLGU or such other persons as maybe designated in writing provided that such designation has been authorized by DPWH/CLGU.

In this connection, kindly be informed that this Office has thoroughly reviewed the above-mentioned Barangay Ordinance and poses no legal objection as it is within the mandate of Barangays under Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, the pertinent provisions are quoted as follows, to wit:

Section 10. Role of LGUs in Solid Waste Management - Pursuant to the relevant provisions of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local government code, the LGUs shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this Act within their respective jurisdictions.

Segregation and collection of solid waste shall be conducted at the barangay level specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable wastes: *Provided, That the collection of non-recyclable materials and special wastes shall be the responsibility of the municipality or city.*

Section 32. Establishment of LGU Materials Recovery Facility. - **There shall be established a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) in every barangay or cluster of barangays.** The facility shall be established in a barangay-owned or -leased land or any suitable open space to be determined by the barangay through its Sanggunian. For this purpose, the barangay or cluster of barangays shall allocate a certain parcel of land for the MRF. The MRF shall receive mixed waste for final sorting, segregation, composting, and recycling. The resulting residual wastes shall be transferred to a long term storage or disposal facility or sanitary landfill.

However, this Office strongly suggest that the said Barangay Ordinance be duly indorsed to the concerned agencies and/or departments (i.e. City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office, City Solid Waste Management Board, and City Finance Department) for proper consultation, review, comment, and recommendation. In addition, it is recommended that the Barangay comply with the requirements under Section 511¹ of the RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

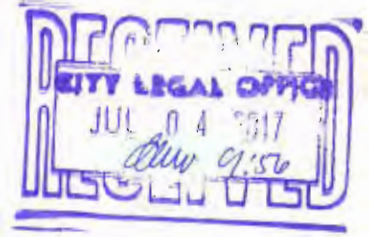

¹ **Section 511. Posting and Publication of Ordinances with Penal Sanctions.**

(a) Ordinances with penal sanctions shall be posted at prominent places in the provincial capitol, city, municipal or barangay hall, as the case may be, for a minimum period of three (3) consecutive weeks. BE IT ORDAINED by the Barangay Nine Council of Cagayan de Oro City in session assembled that:

SECTION 1.-This Ordinance shall be known as the “Barangay Waste Segregation Ordinance No. 2017-001”

SECTION 2. – DEFINITION OF TERMS

1. Garbage - Solid Waste refers to a discarded households waste, commercial waste, non – Hazardous institution, industrial waste, street sweeping,
2. Residuals / Hazardous Garbage
 - (1) Waste identified or listed as hazardous waste either solid, liquid, gaseous or semi- solid which may cause or contribute to death, of a person and other organisms.
 - (2) Infectious waste from hospitals such as:
 - (a) equipments, instruments, utensils, and disposable fomites (things that may carry infectious organisms, such as gauze, surgical gloves, syringes) from patients suspected to have or been diagnosed as having contagious diseases.
 - (b) Laboratory wastes such as pathological specimens from (all tissues, specimen of blood, excerta and secretions obtained patients or laboratory animals) and disposable fomites that may harbor or transmit pathogenic organism
 - (c) surgical operating room pathologic specimens and attendant disposable f omites and
 - (d) similar disposable materials from outpatient areas and emergency rooms.
 - (e) waste resulting from mining activities including contaminated soil and debris.
3. Biodegradable – all materials that can be reduced into finer composition or refuse resources that are basically decomposable.
4. Non-biodegradable – all wastes that are mainly non-biodegradable or donot readilydecay.
5. Composting – biological degradation under controlled conditions; the process of making Them with soil, water, biological additives and air.

6. Recyclable/reusable – all non-decomposable but can still be used or such as processed tin cans, metals, bottles, glasses, plastics, etc.
7. Solid Waste – this include anything thrown away, such as garbage, rubbish, trash, litter, junk, and refuse from sources such as houses, businessmen, farms or institutions.
8. Institutions – refers to the establishments like hospitals, schools, churches, public and private offices and other similar structures.
9. Recycling – the reuse, retrieval, re-commission of element matters for anyand all purpose necessary to healthful and productive structure
10. Solid Waste Management – systematic control of the generation, storage collection, transport separation, processing, recycling, recovery and final disposal of solid waste.
11. Sorting at source – the segregation of waste at the point of generation or at the very place Where they are produced into bio-degradable, recyclable. Toxic and hazardous wastes And residuals.

SECTION 3. – AUTHORITY / COMPOSITION

ORDINANCE NO.001-2017

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL RESIDENTS, OPERATORS/ MANAGERS/ LEASE OCCUPANTS OF ANY BUSINESS, SIDEWALK VENDORS, PEDDLERS, COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL, PRIVATE OR PUBLIC ESTABLISHMENTS OF BARANGAY NINE TO IMPLEMENT WASTE SEGREGATION AT SOURCE AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Barangay Nine Council of Cagayan de Oro City in session assembled that:

SECTION 1.-This Ordinance shall be known as the “Barangay Waste Segregation Ordinance No. 2017-001”

SECTION 2. – DEFINITION OF TERMS

1. Garbage - Solid Waste refers to a discarded households waste, commercial waste, non – Hazardous institution, industrial waste, street sweeping,
2. Residuals / Hazardous Garbage
 - (1) Waste identified or listed as hazardous waste either solid, liquid, gaseous or semi- solid which may cause or contribute to death, of a person and other organisms.
 - (2) Infectious waste from hospitals such as:
 - (a) equipments, instruments, utensils, and disposable fomites (things that may carry infectious organisms, such as gauze, surgical gloves, syringes) from patients suspected to have or been diagnosed as having contagious diseases.
 - (b) Laboratory wastes such as pathological specimens from (all tissues, specimen of blood, excerta and secretions obtained patients or laboratory animals) and disposable fomites that may harbor or transmit pathogenic organism.
 - (c) surgical operating room pathologic specimens and attendant disposable f omites and
 - (d) similar disposable materials from outpatient areas and emergency rooms.
 - (e) waste resulting from mining activities including contaminated soil and debris.
3. Biodegradable – all materials that can be reduced into finer composition or refuse resources that are basically decomposable.
4. Non-biodegradable – all wastes that are mainly non-biodegradable or donot readilydecay.
5. Composting – biological degradation under controlled conditions, the process of making Them with soil, water, biological additives and air.

6. Recyclable/reusable – all non-decomposable but can still be used or such as processed tin cans, metals, bottles, glasses, plastics, etc.
7. Solid Waste – this include anything thrown away, such as garbage, rubbish, trash, litter, junk, and refuse from sources such as houses, businessmen, farms or institutions.
8. Institutions – refers to the establishments like hospitals, schools, churches, public and private offices and other similar structures.
9. Recycling – the reuse, retrieval, re-commission of element matters for anyand all purpose necessary to healthful and productive structure
10. Solid Waste Management – systematic control of the generation, storage collection, transport separation, processing, recycling, recovery and final disposal of solid waste.
11. Sorting at source – the segregation of waste at the point of generation or at the very place Where they are produced into bio-degradable, recyclable. Toxic and hazardous wastes And residuals.

SECTION 3. – AUTHORITY / COMPOSITION

AUTHORITY - This Barangay Ordinance - SWM program is enacted to implement the provision Of Republic Act 9003, which mandates the proper solid wastes segregation and reduction at source.

COMPOSITION - The BESWMC and BSWM Task Force of barangay 09, Cagayan de Oro City are created to look after and enforce the implementation of SWM practice:

Duties and Functions :

1. To coordinate and facilitate any activity refer for the implementation BESWMP.
2. To help the information and educational campaign of R.A 9003, within barangay 09, vicinity.
3. Vigilant to all violators and recommend fines and penalties.
4. To monitor and evaluate the state of health and sanitation of the barangay.
5. Convenes monthly meeting and submit annual report to CLENRO / DILG.

(b) BSWM Task Force: the Monitoring and enforcer of SWMP. Which is composed of Barangay Volunteers. With its Duties and Functions as follows:

1. Enforce BESWMC activities and implementation of SWMP.
2. Field Enforcer for SWMP violators.
3. Convene monthly meeting and submit monthly list of SWMP violators.
4. Supervise and concern of the sanitation/cleanliness of brgy. 09 AOR.
5. The Monitoring team of SWMP

SECTION 4. – Mandatory Segregation of Waste at Source

1. That segregation of waste shall be primarily conducted at source or point of origin, to include household, institutional, commercial/business establishments, sidewalk vendors, peddlers and other similar sources.
2. That all Non- Government Organizations (NGO), People's Organizations (PO) and similar agencies involved in solid waste management activities hereby encouraged to promote and participate in the implementation of this ordinance.
3. That waste containers or receptacles shall be properly marked or identified with description according to the classification of segregated waste as follows:

4. That it shall be the duty of the respective operator, owner, manager, lease occupants of any business, sidewalk vendors, peddlers, commercial, private or public establishments, and residential houses to provide their own properly marked segregated garbage receptacles and/or containers at their respective places.

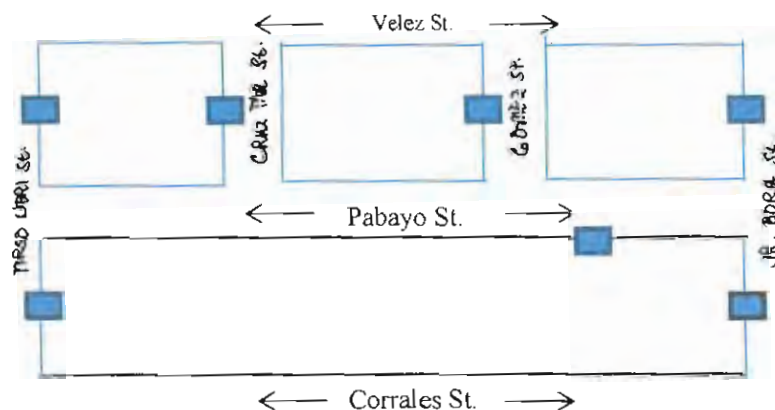
SECTION 5, – GARBAGE DISPOSAL AND COLLECTION

- a) That the prescribed schedule of garbage disposal to the collection point will be one hour before the time scheduled for the collection by garbage trucks provided by the City Public Services Office. Schedule of dumping and City garbage collector pick up time are as follows:

1. SCHEDULE

2. DUMPING AND PICK UP POINTS.



Legend: Blue Boxes indicate the dumping and pick up points.

- b) That no garbage disposal shall be allowed outside of the scheduled time to avoid infiltration and unnecessary spillage of garbage by stray dogs and to ensure efficient and effective collection operation.
- c) That littering, throwing or dumping of garbage or waste materials in public places such as roads, sidewalks, canals, esteros, open spaces and parks, or any act causing or permitting the same is prohibited.
- d) That all house owners and tenants of residential building and owners, managers, operators, occupants and lessees of any commercial/business establishments, *government institutions* shall be required to clean the area in front of and around their vicinity and shall be required to provide their own waste receptacles for efficient waste segregation.
- e) That it shall be the duty of the house owner, lessee, occupants, operator/manager of any business/commercial establishment or government institutions to dispose outside our barangay within Seventy Two (72) hours any and all kinds of construction debris or waste materials scrap such as cement, sand, gravel, lumber, steel and scrap materials coming from construction or renovation of their house or establishment.

SECTION 6, – ESTABLISHMENT OF MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITY (MRF)

- a. That there shall be a Material Recovery Facility (MRF) to be established in suitable site within the barangay to accommodate segregated “Recyclable or suitable” waste materials by brought in household owners and/or business operators or owners.
- b. That Recyclable or Re-usable Waste materials may be disposed of or sold to junk buyers by the individual household owners or business operators/owners at their own discretion.

SECTION 7, –PROHIBITED ACTS,FINES, AND PENALTIES

1. PROHIBITED ACTS

- (a) No scavenging activity is allowed within Barangay 09 jurisdiction.
- (b) Littering, throwing, dumping of waste matters in public places such as roads, sidewalks, canals, or parks are strictly prohibited.
- (c) No open Burning of solid waste.
- (d) No open dumping, burying of biodegradable materials in food prone areas.
- (e) To collect or allow to collect unsegregated wastes
- (d) Dumping without segregation.
- (e) Non-compliance of solid waste segregation practice.
- (f) Dumping in no time scheduled.
- (g) Throwing/dumping in non- designated area.

2. FINES AND PENALTIES

Any act done in violation of this Brgy 09, Ordinance No. 001-2017. Shall subject to all offender the following fines and penalties.

1st offense	Php 200.00
2nd offense	Php 400.00
3rd offense	Php 600.00

Or render community service not less than one day to not more than five (5) days to Barangay 09, Cagayan de Oro City, where such prohibited acts are committed and cannot pay the fines.

SECTION 8.– PENALTY CLAUSE.

1. Any person and establishments who violated disobeyed, refused, omitted or neglected to comply with the Section 7 (a), (b), (c), (d) (e), (f), (g) and of this Ordinance shall upon be conviction punished with a fine of not less than Two Hundred Pesos (200.00) but not exceeding Six Hundred Pesos (P600) or render community service of not less than (1) day but not more than five (5) days or both depending upon the discretion of the court.
2. Any peddlers, sidewalk vendors around Barangay 09, area of responsibility found violated this Barangay 09, Ordinance No. 001-2017, will be ejected permanently.
3. Any person found violating Section 8.1 provision of this Ordinance No. 001 – 2017 shall be charge to non - issuance of any Barangay Clearances.

SECTION 9. – LEGAL BASIS

The basis of this ordinance is to ensure proper segregation, collection and disposal of Solid Waste, embodied in the City Codified Ordinance No. 8975 series of 2003 and as provided in Republic Act 9003 commonly known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000.

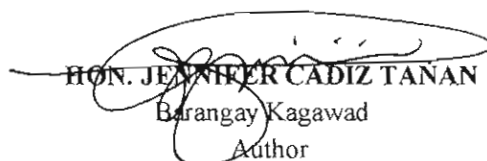
SECTION 9. – RELATION TO PRIOR CITY ORDINANCE

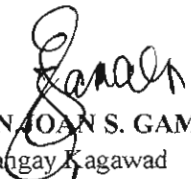
Any provision of this ordinance which may be substantially the same with any existing city ordinance shall be construed as restatement and not as new enactment

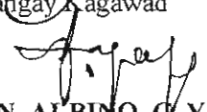
SECTION 10. – EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE

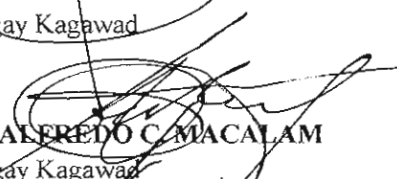

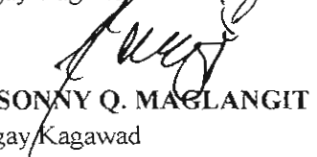

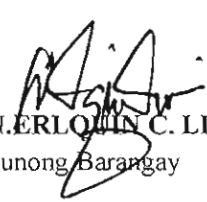

BARANGAY ORDINANCE
ON ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of San Simon is committed to the protection, preservation and conservation of the ecosystem;

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the barangay to effectively and efficiently implement the Solid Waste Management System under Republic Act No. 9003 in its territorial jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code (RA 7160) also provides:

“ SEC. 16 General Welfare – Every Local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things... promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.”
(underscoring supplied.)

WHEREAS, the unsystematic waste disposal by households and commercial/industry establishments cause unsightly surroundings and spread of communicable diseases;

WHEREAS, the practice of waste segregation to facilitate reuse and recycling does not only reduce the cost of collection and disposal of garbage but conserves the natural resources of materials and avoid wasteful consumption of goods;

NOW THEREFORE, upon recommendation of Punong Barangay Rodolfo S. Nacario, duly seconded by Kagawad Fernando C. Edrolin, Chairman on Environment and Natural Resources ,

ARTICLE I
Title of the Ordinance

This ordinance shall be known as the “ Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Ordinance of Barangay San Simon.”

ARTICLE II
COVERAGE

This ordinance shall apply to all residential houses; commercial establishments such as restaurants, eateries, department stores, groceries, sari-sari stores, auto repair shop; intitutions likes hospitals, schools, churches, public and private offices; industrial establishments of any kind; and agricultural areas situated within the territorial jurisdictions of Barangay San Simon of the Municipality/City of Cagayan de Oro.

ARTICLE III
Authority and Purpose/Goals

SECTION 1. **Authority.** This ordinance is enacted to implement the provisions of Republic Act No. 9003 which mandates the proper segregation and collection of household wastes.

SECTION 2. **Purpose.** This ordinance is enacted for the following purposes:

- a.) To guide, control and regulate the generation of solid wastes within the Barangay and promote an orderly and sanitary system for the same;
- b.) To enhance the total environment of the locality through the necessary control and mitigation of negative environmental impacts of solid waste;
- c.) To promote and protect the health, safety, peace and convenience of the general welfare of the inhabitants of the Barangay;
- d.) To minimize the generation of solid waste and maximize possible resource/recovery/recycling and utilization by:
 - Maximizing the use of goods and consumption of foods
 - . Encouraging the salvaging of possible “recoverables” from solid wastes for re-use and/ or recycling back to production process; and
 - . Encouraging the recycling and resource recovery of wastes in own backyards through composting.

SECTION 3. **Goal.** The primary goal of this Ordinance is to enhance ecological balance of the community through sustainable and integrated waste management.

SECTION 4. **Objectives.** The objectives of this Ordinance are the following:

- a.) To ensure round-the-clock cleanliness through the orderly management of waste;
- b.) To eradicate unsightly, uncovered and overflowing waste containers in streets, public places and open spaces;
- c.) To maximize and optimize sanitary resource recovery for feeds, materials and others: and
- d.) To minimize pollution arising from harmful gases, smoke particulates produced by needles burning/dumping, polluted runoffs into water sources/supply, and hazardous substances.

ARTICLE IV Definition of Terms

SECTION 5. **Technical Terms.** The technical terms used in this Ordinance shall be defined as follows:

- a.) **Biodegradable** – any material that can be reduced into finer particles (degraded or decomposed) by microbiological organisms or enzymes (synonymous with compostable).
- b.) **Biodegradable Wastes**- fruit & vegetable peelings, spoiled food & leftovers, vegetable trimmings, fish scales, egg shells, seafood shells, wet newspapers & cardboards, wetpapers and cartons, coconut shells & husk, seeds, garden & grass clippings, pet/poultry/livestock manure, chipped branches and sawdust;
- c.) **Compost**- decayed organic material for use as soil conditioner or fertilizer.
- d.) **Composting**- biological degradation under controlled conditions; the process of making biodegradables such as food waste, garden waste, animal waste and human waste into compost by mixing them with soil, water, biological additives/activators (optional) and air.
- e.) **Domestic Waste**- refuse from households, as distinguished from industrial waste hospital waste, etc. which may be classified as biodegradable (compostable) or non-biodegradable (non-compostable).
- f.) **Recyclable Wastes**- dry papers & newspapers, dry cardboards & cartons, plastic materials like plastic containers, plastic water bottles, plastic bottle caps, PVC & PE pipes computer casing, tin cans & covers aluminum cans, iron steel, copper wires, broken transparent glasses, glass bottles, toner catridges, computer ink cartridges.

- g.) **Residual Wastes** – sando bags, packing wrappers, styropors/styrofoams, cigarette butts, worn out plastic sacks, dirt from sweeping, worn out rags, sanitary napkins, disposable diapers, plastic straws, parlor & barber shop waste, household medicine bottles, broken ceramics, colored broken glasses, coco fiber from cushions, poultry feathers.
- h.) **Special Wastes**- paint & thinner containers, spray canisters, household batteries, pharmaceuticals waste, spoiled, spilled, expired cosmetic waste, lead acid batteries, used oil filters, broken tiles.
- i.) **Bulky Wastes**- used rubber tires: garden debris: destroyed TV sets, radios, stereos, washing machines, dryers, stoves, refrigerators, & dishwashers: broken furniture, filing cabinet, book cases, beds, & cushions.

ARTICLE V

Segregation of Wastes

SECTION 6. Mandatory Segregation of Solid Wastes. The segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources: Provided, that wastes shall be segregated into the categories provided in Section 2 of this Article.

SECTION 7. Requirements for the Segregation and Storage of Solid Waste Pending Collection. The following shall be the minimum standards and requirements for segregation and storage of solid waste pending collection:

- a.) There shall be a suitable container such as a plastic bag or the like for the ecological solid waste before these are brought out along the streets or being brought out at the assigned dumping areas.
- b.) There shall be a separate container for each type of waste from all sources: Provided, that in the case of bulky waste, it will suffice that the same be collected and placed in a separate and designated area;and
- c.) The solid waste container depending on its use shall be properly marked or identified for on-site collection as follows:

- . **Biodegradables/Compostables** or “Nabubulok”;
- . **Recyclables** or “Di-Nabubulok na maari pang pakinabangan”; and
- . **Residuals & Special Wastes** or “ Di nabubulok na di na mapakinabangan.”

Third Offense- Php 300.00 &/or Render Ten (10) Days Community Service, or both
Subsequent - Php 1,000.00 or Render Twenty (20) Days Community Service, or both

(5) Households and establishments that do not provide receptacles/containers for their refuse/solid waste;

First Offense- Warning

Second Offense- Php 50.00 &/ or Render One (1) Day Community Service, or both

Third Offense- Php 150.00 &/or Render Two (2) Days Community Service, or both

Subsequent- Php 250.00 &/or Render Five (5) Days Community Service, or both

(6) Not keeping the surrounding areas and immediate premises clean by establishments, institutions, households and other concerned occupants. Streets shall be kept clean by occupants or owners of properties lining the street from the line of the property to the middle of the street and from one property to the other.

First Offense- Warning

Second Offense – Php 150.00 &/or Render Three (3) Day community Service, or both

Third Offense – Php 300.00 &/or Render Six (6) Days community Service, or both

Subsequent – Php 500.00 &/or Render Ten (10) Days community Service, or both

If the offense is committed by a corporation, partnership, or other juridical entity duly organized in accordance with law, the chief executive officer, president, general manager, managing partner or such other officer-in-charge shall be liable for the commission of the offense penalized under this Ordinance.

Violators shall not be given barangay clearances until he/she has paid and/or served his/her fines/penalties. Their names also shall be posted at conspicuous places in the barangay.

SECTION 14. Utilization of Collected Fines. Thirty percent (30%) of the collected fines shall accrue to the General Fund for appropriations for the next fiscal year and the remaining Seventy Percent (70%), which shall be called as Ecological Solid Waste Management (ESWM) Fund, Shall be used for the following within the fiscal year of which the fines were collected:

- (1) Honoraria for the Loakan Proper Barangay Brigade of Eco-aides;
- (2) Procurement of Materials, Equipment, Protective Gears and other items necessary for the proper implementation of the Ecological Solid Waste Management of the Barangay San Simon.

ARTICLE VI
Collection and Disposal

SECTION 8. Residential Areas. The garbage shall be collected through the present system of collection within the Barangay. Independent collection systems of the composite barangays shall be followed.

SECTION 9. Schools, Churches, and Business Establishments. All garbage in these locations shall also be collected in the same manner as in Section 8.

SECTION 10. Agricultural Areas. Agricultural areas shall convert organic wastes into compost in their respective areas.

SECTION 11. Industrial Areas. All factories and plants shall separate their garbage into toxic and non-toxic. It is mandatory that all factories contact the industrial waste exchange (IWE) to exchange their wastes with others who may be able to use them. Existing industrial areas already having their proper way of collection and disposal shall continue practicing the same.

SECTION 12. Time of dumping of ecological solid wastes for collection at the collection sites shall be from five o'clock to six o'clock in the morning (5-6 AM) on the day of collection of the garbage scheduled to be collected only.

ARTICLE VII
Penal Provisions

SECTION 13. Prohibited Acts and Its fines and Penalties. The following acts are prohibited and its corresponding Fines and Penalties:

- (1.) Bringing out and dumping of garbage outside of collection day and proper time of dumping for collection, indiscriminately dumping garbage, littering, throwing, dumping of solid waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canals, drainage systems, curbs and gutters, esteros or parks, creeks, rivers, tributaries, rivulets and other natural waterways, and establishment, or causing or permitting the same;
- (2.) The open and indiscriminate burning of residual and special wastes;
- (3.) Causing or permitting the collection of non-segregated or unsorted waste/non-segregation of wastes into biodegradable, recyclable, and residual/special;
- (4.) Unauthorized removal of recyclable materials intended for collection by authorized person;

For Paragraphs (1) to (4)

First Offense – Warning

Second Offense- Php 250.00 &/ or Render Five (5) Days Community Service, or both

- (3) Information, education, communication, and monitoring activities of the Ecological Solid Waste Management of Barangay San Simon.
- (4) Acquisition of products, facilities, technologies, and processes necessary to enhance proper ecological solid waste management:
- (5) Transportation/Hauling of ecological solid wastes;
- (6) Awards and incentives;
- (7) Research Programs;
- (8) Technical assistance;
- (9) Capability-building activities; and
- (10) Maintenance and other related activities, programs, etc. for the Materials Recovery Facility of Cluster.

ARTICLE VIII

Miscellaneous Provisions

SECTION 15. Citizen Suits. For purposes of enforcing the provisions of this Ordinance, any citizen may file an appropriate civil or criminal action in the barangay against any person who violates or fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance. The Barangay concerned shall exempt such action from payment of filing fees.

SECTION 16. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstances is declared unconstitutional, the remainder of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.

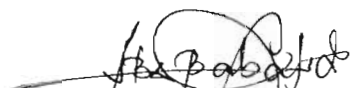
SECTION 17. Repealing Clause. All existing ordinances and resolutions of this barangay found to be inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 18. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.

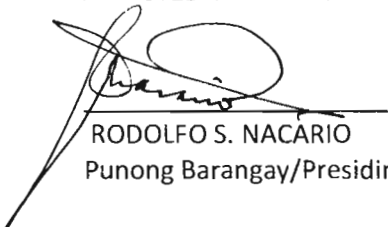

We are respectfully forwarding to your end the herein attached Barangay Ordinance No. 002 Series of 2017 of Barangay San Simon, this City.

In this connection, kindly be informed that this Office has thoroughly reviewed the above-mentioned Barangay Ordinance and poses no legal objection as it is within the mandate of Barangays under Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, the pertinent provisions are quoted as follows, to wit:

Section 10. Role of LGUs in Solid Waste Management - Pursuant to the relevant provisions of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local government code, the LGUs shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this Act within their respective jurisdictions.

Segregation and collection of solid waste shall be conducted at the barangay level specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable wastes: *Provided*, That the collection of non-recyclable materials and special wastes shall be the responsibility of the municipality or city.

x X x

Section 32. Establishment of LGU Materials Recovery Facility. - **There shall be established a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) in every barangay or cluster of barangays.** The facility shall be established in a barangay-owned or -leased land or any suitable open space to be determined by the barangay through its Sanggunian. For this purpose, the barangay or cluster of barangays shall allocate a certain parcel of land for the MRF. The MRF shall receive mixed waste for final sorting, segregation, composting, and recycling. The resulting residual wastes shall be transferred to a long term storage or disposal facility or sanitary landfill.

However, this Office strongly suggest that the said Barangay Ordinance be duly indorsed to the concerned agencies and/or departments (i.e. City Local Environment and Natural Resources Office, City Solid Waste Management Board, and City Finance Department) for proper consultation, review, comment, and recommendation. In addition, it is recommended that the Barangay comply with the requirements under Section 511¹ of the RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

¹ Section 511. Posting and Publication of Ordinances with Penal Sanctions.

(a) Ordinances with penal sanctions shall be posted at prominent places in the provincial capitol, city, municipal or barangay hall, as the case may be, for a minimum period of three (3) consecutive weeks. Such ordinances shall also be published in a newspaper of general circulation, where available, within the territorial jurisdiction of the local government unit concerned, except in the case of barangay ordinances. Unless otherwise provided therein, said ordinances shall take effect on the day following its publication, or at the end of the period of posting, whichever occurs later.
