1. Adoption of the increase of testing fee rates consistent with Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Department Order No. 69 series of 2015;
2. Recognize the receipt, fees and charges to accrue and be accounted under the General Fund.

WHEREAS, it was presented to the Committee, the letter request of Engr. Rolando M. Pacuribot, City Engineer, this City, for assistance to make the necessary amendments for Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3747-93, that the LGU of Cagayan de Oro to adopt the proposed increase of testing rates consistent with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Department Order No. 69 series of 2015.

WHEREAS, it was also presented, the recommendation of Ms. Roxanne Mae A. Ravidas, Head, Internal Audit Service, this City, relative to the aforementioned ordinance, specifically Section 2 which states that:

"Section 2- All fees and other charges collected under the Ordinance shall accrue to the General Fund and shall be treated and accounted for as trust accounts, and appropriated by the City Council for the various needs of the Materials Testing and Quality Control Division".

WHEREAS, it was discussed that the above-mentioned Section 2 has conflicting provision as to how the collection shall be treated and accounted for by the City Accounting Office. That upon recording receipt of the fees and charges, to be recognized as trust account, thereby negating the provisions that "All fees & charges collected shall accrue under the general fund";

WHEREAS, upon review and evaluation on the presentation of Ms. Ravidas (attached Tabulated Rates for Testing Materials), informing her favorable proposal on the increase of the testing rates, as they are at par with prevailing rates of the DPWH. Hence, to amend or revise Section 2 by excluding the accounting treatment as Trust Fund, but, rather, to recognize the income under the General Fund for the purpose of cost recovery on the maintenance of equipment & supplies and revenue generation as well;

WHEREAS, it was discussed by the Committee to inform His Honor Mayor Oscar S. Moreno, this City, the aforementioned recommendation, subject to the subsequent issuance of legislative action for the purpose;


WHEREFORE, with unanimous motion & duly seconded by all members present, the Committee resolved as it is hereby resolved, to favorably recommend to the Honorable Mayor, Oscar S. Moreno, this City, for his representation to the Honorable Members of the City Council, to request the necessary amendments of Ordinance No. 3747-93, otherwise known as "An Ordinance Imposing Fees and Charges for Laboratory Testing Construction Works and Materials

to the Contractors of the City and/or National Projects under the Supervision of the City Engineering and Public Works and of Private Construction Subject for inspection as provided under PD 1096, otherwise known as the National Building Code of the Philippines.



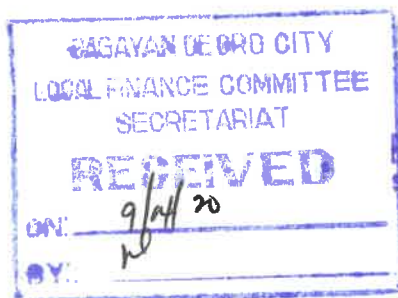

This is in relation to the endorsement dated September 7, 2020 forwarded by the Local Finance Committee to the undersigned regarding the request of City Engineer Rolando M. Pacuribot to make necessary amendments to Ordinance No. 3747-93, otherwise known as An Ordinance Imposing Fees and Charges for Laboratory Testing Construction Works and Materials upon Contractors of the City and/or National Projects under the Supervision of the City Engineering and Public Works and of Private Construction Subject for Inspection as Provided under PD 1096, other known as the National Building Code of the Philippines.

The City Government through the Materials Testing and Quality Control (MTQC) Division has adopted the testing rates provided for under City Ordinance No. 3747-93. We have reviewed the proposed fees and charges of the City Engineers Office and found out that they are five percent (5%) below the DPWH's present rates. We are recommending to the Local Finance Committee that the LGU of Cagayan De Oro adopt the proposed increase of testing rates consistent with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Department Order No. 69 series of 2015 and corresponding amendments to City Ordinance No. 3747-97 be in effect. The recommendation to adopt and implement rates **at par with the prevailing rates of DPWH** for purposes of cost recovery and revenue generation for the City Government.

The delivery of materials tests entail cost to the government. Equity requires that persons receiving or benefiting from rendered services share the cost of providing such services. Hence, the primary purpose of imposing fees and charges is cost recovery. The proposed adoption of the DPWH' Department Order No. 69 series of 2015 increase in rates is aimed to balance the recovering of cost of services rendered and the socio-economic impact of their imposition.

Further, we have studied City Ordinance No. 3747-93 and worthy of note is Section 2 which reads as follows:

"Section 2. – All fees and other charges collected under this Ordinance shall accrue to the General Fund and shall be treated and accounted for as trust accounts, and appropriated by the City Council for the various needs of the materials testing and quality control division."

The above-mentioned section indicate that no revenue redound to the General Fund. Section 2 is explicit that fees and other charges collected shall accrue to the General Fund, however, the same section also provides that the same shall be treated



and accounted for as trust account. Upon recording the receipt of the fees and charges, the city accounting will recognize a trust liability thereby negating the provision that "*All fees and other charges collected under this Ordinance shall accrue to the General Fund*". Hence, it is likewise recommended that this provision be revised to exclude accounting treatment as trust fund, if the intent of the City Ordinance is to recognize collection of fees and charges as General Fund. However, the City Government's General Fund must also provide appropriation for the maintenance and upkeep of the materials testing and quality control division in order to sustain the delivery of said services.

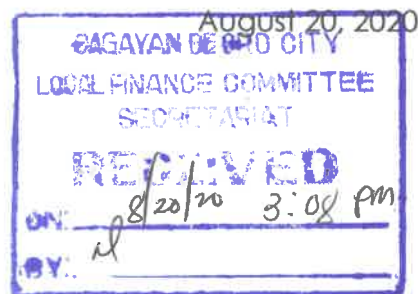

The Materials Testing and Quality Control (MTQC) Division of this Office have since adopted the proposed testing rates from the City Ordinance No. 3747-93, an Ordinance Imposing Fees and Charges for Laboratory Testing of Construction Works and Materials upon Contractors of the City and/or National Projects under the Supervision of the City Engineering and Public Works and of Private Construction subject for Inspection as provided under Presidential Decree 1096, otherwise known as the National Building Code of the Philippines.

However, on our letter dated August 14, 2015, addressed to the Hon. City Mayor Oscar S. Moreno, we have provided a tabular comparison of the LGU's old rate to that of DPWH's present rate and requested further permission to adopt the latest DPWH rates by providing a Suggested Rate that is 5% lower than the rates imposed nationwide by DPWH in accordance with Department Order No. 69 series of 2015.

In order to meet with the present time's inflation costs, we would like to request for your assistance to make the necessary amendments in the aforementioned City Ordinance to allow this Office to adopt the Suggested Rates in some of the Specific Types of Test to avoid compromising the efficiency of testing of materials intended for the various projects undertaken by the City Government of Cagayan de Oro. 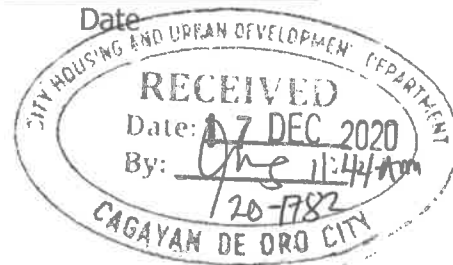

GARMA, COVERING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE *MALASAKIT* CENTER PCSO DESK-PARTNER HOSPITAL, WHICH I HEREBY CERTIFY AS AN URGENT LEGISLATIVE MEASURE

This refers to the request of the undersigned for the appropriate action of the honorable body to grant authority to the undersigned to represent the City Government-owned J.R. Borja General Hospital ("JRBGH"), as the local chief executive (LCE), to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") with the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office ("PCSO") covering the establishment of the *Malasakit* Center PCSO Desk at the JRBGH.

Under the MOA, the Parties endeavor to provided health and medical assistance to the members of the marginalized sector which shall operate under the *Malasakit* Program of the Department of Health ("DOH"). Particularly, the implementation of "Section VI (C) of Joint Administrative Order No. 2020-001 (the Operational Guidelines for the Implementation of the Medical and Financial to Indigent and Financially Incapacitated Patients pursuant to Republic Act No. 11463, or the MCA-JAO for brevity)." Among the services to be provided thru the *Malasakit* Center PCSO Desk are:

- i. Confinement Assistance;
- ii. Chemotheraphy Assistance;
- iii. Dialysis Assistance;
- iv. Homophilia Medicine Assistance;
- v. Post-transplant medicine assistance; and
- vi. Other types of medical assistance.

In this regard, respectfully request the honorable body for the authority to sign the MOA, which I hereby certify as an urgent legislative measure. A copy of the Agreement is attached herewith for your perusal.

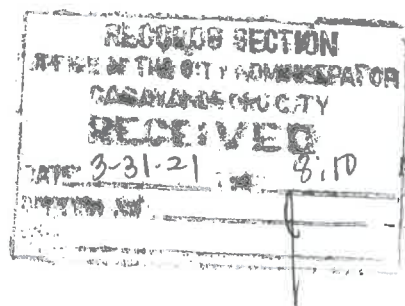

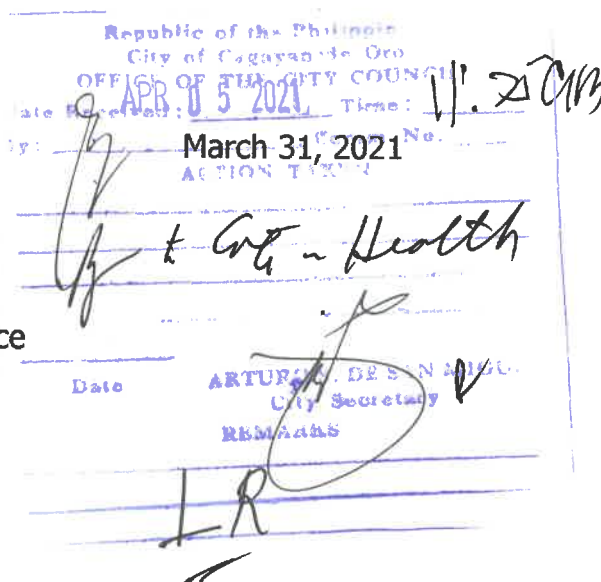

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
MALASAKIT CENTER PCSO DESK – PARTNER HOSPITAL**

THE PUBLIC IS INFORMED:

This Agreement is made and entered into by:

The **PHILIPPINE CHARITY SWEEPSTAKES OFFICE (PCSO)**, a government owned and controlled corporation existing by virtue of Republic Act No. 1169, as amended, holding office at 10F Sun Plaza Building, 1507 Shaw Boulevard corner Princeton Street, Mandaluyong City, represented by its Vice Chairperson and General Manager, **ROYINA M. GARMA**, authorized for this purpose under Board Resolution No. 0234 series of 2020, a copy of which is attached as **Annex "A"**;

-and-

The _____ (**PARTNER HOSPITAL**), a government hospital under the management and administration of the [Department of Health (DOH) / Local Government Unit (LGU) / State University or College (SUC)], represented by **[NAME OF REPRESENTATIVE]**, in [his/her] capacity as [title/position], authorized for this purpose under _____ dated _____ (**Annex "B"**).

PCSO and **PARTNER HOSPITAL** are referred to collectively as the **PARTIES**.

ANTECEDENTS

By virtue of Republic Act No. 1169 as amended (the PCSO Charter), **PCSO** is the principal government agency to raise and provide funds for health programs, medical assistance and services, and charities of national character.

Republic Act No. 11463 or the *Malasakit Centers Act of 2019* (the MCA) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (MCA-IRR) (**Annex "C"**) mandate the establishment of the *Malasakit Program* consisting of *malasakit centers* in Department of Health (DOH) Hospitals, the Philippine General Hospital (PGH), and other public hospitals such as **PARTNER HOSPITAL**. The *malasakit centers* shall, among others, facilitate access to **PCSO's** medical assistance for indigent and financially incapacitated patients, chargeable against **PCSO** funds.

By virtue of Board Resolution No. _____ series of _____, the PCSO Board of Directors approved the establishment of the PCSO Desks in the *malasakit centers* and adopted the "2021 Implementing Guidelines for the *Malasakit Centers*" (the PCSO Desk Guidelines) to put in operation the grant of medical assistance at the PCSO Desk. A copy of Secretary's Certificate dated _____ is attached as **Annex "D."**

By virtue of Board Resolution No. _____ series of _____, the PCSO Board of Directors approved the establishment of the PCSO Desk in the *Malasakit Center* of **PARTNER HOSPITAL** (**Annex "E"**).

ACCORDINGLY, the **PARTIES** agree as follows:

I. OBLIGATIONS OF PARTNER HOSPITAL

PARTNER HOSPITAL shall:

1. Provide the necessary cubicles, rooms, or desks for the PCSO Desk at the *Malasakit Center* within its premises, in accordance with Section 7.2.a.(v) of the MCA-IRR.
2. Strictly implement the order of charging for the medical and financial assistance

provided to patients, in accordance with Section VI (C) of Joint Administrative Order No. 2020-001 (the Operational Guidelines for the Implementation of the -

Medical and Financial Assistance to Indigent and Financially Incapacitated Patients pursuant to Republic Act No. 11463, or the MCA-JAO for brevity).

3. Honor all valid Claim Slips covering the confinement of patients and Guaranty Letters covering outpatient treatments, issued by **PCSO** at the **PCSO Desk** within **PARTNER HOSPITAL's** premises.
4. Submit to the **PCSO Point Persons** at the **PCSO Desk** the documents required for **PCSO** to process requests for medical assistance, including but not limited to:
 - a. The Certificate of Eligibility (COE) and Unified Intake Sheet (UIS), in the form prescribed under Annexes "A" and "C" of the MCA-JAO;
 - b. The Statement of Account (SOA) for each patient;
 - c. The patient's Medical Abstract with printed name, signature and license number of the attending physician, as required in Section VI(B)(1) (**PCSO Desk**) of the MCA-JAO; and
 - d. For outpatients, the following additional documents:
 - i. Treatment protocol, for chemotherapy assistance;
 - ii. The prescription issued by the attending physician;
 - iii. The official quotation of the patient's bill; and
 - iv. Certification on the number of sessions availed from Philhealth, for hemodialysis assistance.
5. Prepare the SOA and supporting documents thereto, accompanied by a summary of all patients to whom medical assistance is given through the **PCSO Desk** of **PARTNER HOSPITAL** for collection by duly authorized **PCSO Branch Office** personnel, in the form and frequency prescribed under **PCSO Guidelines**.
6. Comply with the policies, procedures, and obligations under the MCA, MCA-IRR, MCA-JAO, **PCSO Guidelines**, this Agreement, and Issuances by the DOH, **PCSO**, the Participating Agencies, or other government agencies relative to the implementation of the *Malasakit* Program.

II. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PCSO

PCSO shall:

1. Provide medical assistance at the **PCSO Desk** pursuant to the MCA, MCA-IRR, MCA-JAO, the **PCSO Desk Guidelines** and other guidelines issued by **PCSO** on the grant of medical assistance (collectively the **PCSO Guidelines**), and this Agreement, subject to the monthly budget allocated to **PARTNER HOSPITAL**.
2. Process requests for the following types of medical assistance in accordance with **PCSO Guidelines**:
 - a. Confinement Assistance for patients currently admitted or discharged from **PARTNER HOSPITAL**;
 - b. Chemotherapy Assistance for patients diagnosed with malignant tumor/s or cancer requiring treatment for oral (hormonal) and intravenous chemotherapy drugs;
 - c. Dialysis Assistance for patients requiring hemodialysis and Erythropoietin injection, after the sessions granted by Philhealth;
 - d. Hemophilia Medicine Assistance for patients with diagnosis of Hemophilia requiring medication;

- e. Post-transplant medicine assistance for patients who underwent transplant surgery; and
 - f. Other types of medical assistance authorized by the PCSO Board of Directors in accordance with its existing Medical Access Program (MAP).
3. Designate personnel who shall man the PCSO Desk as PCSO Point Persons in accordance with the MCA, the MCA-IRR, and the MCA-JAO.
 4. Ensure the timely and orderly release to the patients or their representatives of the Claim Slip (in the case of confined patients) or Guaranty Letter (in the case of outpatients) and the Unified Intake Sheet, in the form prescribed under the MCA-JAO.
 5. Ensure the lawful processing and confidentiality of personal information received by **PCSO** in accordance with Republic Act No. 10173 (the Data Privacy Act of 2012) and related laws, rules and regulations.
 6. Ensure the timely and orderly collection of documents that its Branch Office personnel are required to collect from the **PARTNER HOSPITAL** in accordance with PCSO Guidelines.
 7. Provide technical assistance to ensure the successful implementation of the *Malasakit* Program in accordance with Section VII (C) (6) of the MCA-JAO.
 8. Comply with the policies, procedures, and obligations under the MCA, MCA-IRR, MCA-JAO, PCSO Guidelines, this Agreement, and issuances by the DOH, the Participating Agencies, or other government agencies relative to the implementation of the *Malasakit* Program.

III. OTHER PROVISIONS

1. In the case of confined patients, all requests for medical assistance shall be filed at the PCSO Desk prior to the patient's discharge. In case of a patient's death, the request must be submitted in accordance with PCSO Guidelines.
2. When the condition of the patients renders them unable to personally file a request for medical assistance, only their immediate family member of legal age or authorized representative may apply for medical assistance on their behalf.
3. The processing of payments shall be supported by the documentary requirements used in the processing of assistance together with the original Claim Slip for confinement, the Guaranty Letter supported by the Statement of Account and Charge Slips for other outpatient services. **PCSO** shall not process payments without complete documents.
4. **PCSO**, its directors, officials and employees shall be free and held harmless from and against any claim, liability, damage, penalty, judgment, suit and costs arising from any fortuitous event or the negligence or fault of the **PARTNER HOSPITAL**, its officers, employees and representatives, or of the other Participating Agencies, their officers, employees and representatives, in connection with the establishment and operations of the *Malasakit* Center within the **PARTNER HOSPITAL's** premises.
5. The **PARTIES** hereby agree that if either **PCSO** or the **PARTNER HOSPITAL** fails to perform its roles, responsibilities or other obligations under the MCA, MCA-IRR, MCA-JAO, or obligations in the PCSO Guidelines that pertain to the foregoing laws, rules and regulations, the penal provisions in Section 11 of the MCA as Implemented by Rule VI Section 11 of the MCA-IRR, and as further implemented by Section X of the MCA-JAO, shall apply.
6. Pursuant to Rule VI Section 11.3 of the MCA-IRR, all complaints and cases shall be submitted to the **PARTNER HOSPITAL's** complaint and grievance committee for appropriate action. Complaints and cases directed toward **PCSO** shall be handled by **PCSO** in accordance with its Citizen's Charter, and shall be filed

exclusively at the courts where the **PCSO** Head Office is located at the time of filing.

7. All actions and controversies that may arise from this Agreement involving but not limited to demands for the specific performance of the obligations as specified herein and/or in the interpretation of any provisions or clauses contained herein, shall, in the first instance, be settled within thirty (30) calendar days through amicable means, such as, but not limited to mutual discussion. Should the dispute remain unresolved by the end of the aforementioned period, the dispute shall be submitted to the Office of the Secretary of Justice pursuant to the provisions of Section 66, 67, 68, 69, 70 and 71, Chapter 14, Book IV, Title III of the Administrative Code of 1987 (Executive Order No. 292), in relation to Presidential Decree No. 242 (Prescribing the Procedure for the Administrative Settlement of Claims and Controversies Between or Among Government Offices, Agencies and Instrumentalities, including Government-Owned and Controlled Corporations, and for Other Purposes).
8. This Agreement shall take effect upon signing by the Parties and shall be in full force and effect unless earlier terminated, revoked or cancelled.
9. No amendment or modification to this Agreement shall be valid or binding unless expressed in writing and executed with the same formality as this Agreement.
