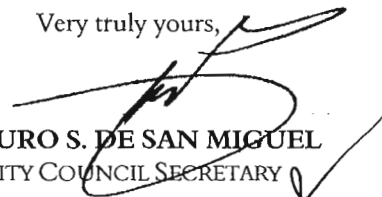

B. SPECIAL REPORT/S:

1. Councilor Ian Mark Q. Nacaya raised some issues on the recent Pag-asa weather forecast for Cagayan de Oro, and the need to prioritize by the DPWH the dredging of Iponan and Cagayan de Oro Rivers as well as the immediate production by the City Engineer's Office of the Integrated Drainage Master Plan for the city, among other things.

Action Taken: The Body adopted Resolution Nos. 12579-2017, 12580-2017, 12581-2017 even as the Presiding Officer referred the report and all reactions thereof to the Committee on Public Works for appropriate action.

2. Councilor Edna M. Dahino stood up to correct the report that the City Government is imposing new tax rates, clarifying that City Hall is only implementing the provisions of the 2015 Revenue Code, which provides some options/remedies for the businessmen to avail themselves of whenever they have some reservations in their tax worksheets, among other concerns.

Action Taken: The report was referred to the Committee on Finance for appropriate action.

3. Councilor Enrico Salcedo proposed some solutions to the problem on solidwaste management such as mobilizing barangays to collect their own garbage with the city government paying them, encourage public support and participation in the campaign on solidwaste management and the strict enforcement of Ordinance No. 8975-2003, RA 9003 and other applicable laws, among others.

Action Taken: The report was referred to the Committee of the Whole chaired by the Presiding Officer for further discussion.

[REPUBLIC ACT No. 7875]

AN ACT INSTITUTING A NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM FOR ALL FILIPINOS AND ESTABLISHING THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION FOR THE PURPOSE

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SEC. 1. Short Title — This Act shall be known as the “National Health Insurance Act of 1995”

Article I. GUIDING PRINCIPLES

SEC. 2. *Declaration of Principles and Policies.* — Section II, Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines declares that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost. Priority of the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women, and children shall be recognized. Likewise, it shall be the policy of the State to provide free medical care to paupers.

In the pursuit of a National Health Insurance Program, this Act shall adopt the following guiding principles:

- a) *Allocation of National Resources for Health* — The Program shall underscore the importance for government to give priority to health as a strategy for bringing about faster economic development and improving quality of life;
- b) *Universality* — The Program shall provide all citizens with the mechanism to gain financial access to health services, in combination with other government health programs. The National Health Insurance Program shall give the highest priority to achieving coverage of the entire population with at least a basic minimum package of health insurance benefits;
- c) *Equity* — The Program shall provide for uniform basic benefits. Access to care must be a function of a person's health needs rather than his ability to pay;
- d) *Responsiveness* — The Program shall adequately meet the needs for personal health services at various stages of a member's life;
- e) *Social Solidarity* — The Program shall be guided by community spirit. It must enhance risk sharing among income groups, age groups, and persons of differing health status, and residing in different geographic areas;
- f) *Effectiveness* — The Program shall balance economical use of resources with quality of care;

five year period if such extension will benefit Program members, as determined by the Corporation.

Personnel of the Medicare departments of the SSS and GSIS shall be given priority in the hiring of the Corporation's employees.

Article XIII. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

SEC. 54. *Oversight Provision.* – Congress shall conduct a regular review of the National Health Insurance Program which shall entail a systematic evaluation of the Program's performance, impact or accomplishments with respect to its objectives or goals. Such review shall be undertaken by the Committee of the Senate and the House of Representatives which have legislative jurisdiction over the Program.

SEC. 55. *Information Campaign.* – There shall be provided a substantial period of time to undertake an intensive public information campaign prior to the implementation of the rules and regulations of this Act.

SEC. 56. *Separability Clause.* – In the event any provision of this Act or the application of such provisions to any person or circumstances is declared invalid, the remainder of this Act or the application of said provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.

SEC. 57. *Repealing Clause.* – Executive Order 119, Presidential Decree 1519 and other laws currently applying to the administration of Medicare are hereby repealed. All other laws, executive orders, administrative rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are also hereby amended, modified, or repealed accordingly.

SEC. 58. *Government Guarantee.* – The Government of the Philippines guarantees the financial viability of the Program.

SEC. 59. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in at least three (3) national newspaper of general circulation.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
(FARM-TO-MARKET ROAD PROJECTS)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Undertaking (MOU) is entered into and executed by and between:

The **Department of Public Works and Highways – Cagayan de Oro City 2nd District Engineering Office** (DPWH – CDO II DEO), the state's engineering and construction arm to provide infrastructure facilities for national development within Region 10, headed by its District Engineer, **ANASTACIO G MARUNDAN**, with principal address at Macabalan, Cagayan de Oro City, hereinafter referred to as the **DPWH-CDO II DEO**;

- and -

The **Local Government Unit of Cagayan de Oro City** (LGU – CDOC), headed by its City Mayor, **HON. OSCAR S. MORENO**, with principal address at Cagayan de Oro City herein referred to as **LGU – CDOC**.

- W I T N E S S E T H -

WHEREAS, the DPWH-CDO II DEO and the LGU-CDOC are involved and committed to the successful implementation of Farm-to-Market (FMR) Roads to provide infrastructure facilities for national development;

WHEREAS, the Office of the Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways issued Special Allotment Release Order (SARO) dated March 4, 2016 to Cagayan de Oro City 2nd District Engineering Office (CDO II DEO) for various infrastructure projects and allocated the total amount of **FORTY-FIVE MILLION (P45,000,000.00) PESOS** for the following FMR projects:

WHEREAS, the FMR projects shall be implemented under counter-parting scheme, which the LGU-CDOC shall provide a counterpart fund of not less than ten percent (10%) of the project cost as provided for in Section 52 of Republic Act 8435 (RA 8435), also known as "Agriculture and Fisheries Modernization Act" (AFMA);

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the PARTIES to this Memorandum of Undertaking (MOU) do hereby agree to undertake the following terms and conditions:

Section 1. Coverage

Section 1.1 This MOU covers the implementation of the various FMR road projects identified by then Cong. Rufus B. Rodriguez, validated and prioritized by the Department of Agriculture (DA) for implementation by the DPWH-CDO II DEO; and

Section 1.2 Policy Guidelines. All proposed FMR road projects must meet the criteria stated in the implementing guidelines on the Implementation of Farm-to-Market Road Development Program (IFMRDP) of the DA (Annex B).

Section 2. Responsibilities of the DPWH-CDO II DEO

Section 2.1 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall cause the preparation of Program of Works (POWs) and Detailed Engineering Design (DED), noted by the DA in accordance with existing guidelines and applicable rules and regulations on the matter;

Section 2.2 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall include in the preparation of POWs the 10% counterpart fund thru LGU-CDOC amounting to **Four Million Five Hundred Thousand (P4,500,000.00) Pesos** for the implementation of the named FMR projects. The counterpart fund shall be in the form of cash. The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall provide breakdown of cash in accordance with the Sub-project Program of Works and Financing Mix presented (Annex F).

Section 2.3 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall issue official receipt to the LGU-CDOC upon receipt of the 10% counterpart for the implementation of the FMR road projects;

Section 2.4 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall secure Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) or Certificate of Non-coverage (CNC) if applicable and adhere to its provisions and the other social safeguard measures;

Section 2.5 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall undertake the bidding and award of contract for the projects' civil works in accordance with Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), also known as "Government Procurement Reform Act." The DPWH-CDO II DEO may pursue the procurement process upon the approval of the POWs and DEDs and Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAFs), and shall award the contracts only upon receipt of the 10% counterpart from the LGU-CDOC;

Section 2.6 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall conduct the procurement of the total project fund (DA Project Fund + LGU-CDOC counterpart fund) per approved POWs/DEDs;

Section 2.7 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall be responsible for the 100% completion of the projects in case the concerned contractor/s defaults in the implementation of the mentioned projects;

Section 2.8 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall complete the FMR projects within the calendar days indicated in the PERT/CPMs;

Section 2.9 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall be fully responsible for the accounting and disbursement of funds in accordance with existing Commission on Audit (COA), Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and other existing government procedures, rules and regulations;

Section 2.10 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall designate a Project Engineer in every FMR project identified who shall supervise all the project activities the entire duration of the projects; and

Section 2.11 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall facilitates the turn-over of completed FMR road projects to the concerned local government unit beneficiaries in accordance with the provisions of the MOU.

Section 3. **Responsibilities of the Local Government Unit of Cagayan de Oro City (LGU-CDOC)**

Section 3.1 The LGU-CDOC shall issue the CAFs to the DPWH-CDO II DEO for the necessary counterpart fund amounting to **Four Million Five Hundred Thousand (P4,500,000.00) Pesos**, signed by the City Local Finance Committee;

- Section 3.2 The LGU-CDOC counterpart fund amounting to **Four Million Five Hundred Thousand (P4,500,000.00) Pesos** shall be downloaded by the LGU-CDOC to DPWH-CDO II DEO upon approval of the MOU;
- Section 3.3 The LGU-CDOC shall monitor the implementation of the mentioned FMR projects as identified under this MOU; and
- Section 3.4 The LGU-CDOC shall maintain the good condition of the enumerated FMR projects after completion and turn-over from the DPWH-CDO II DEO.

Section 4. General Provisions

- Section 4.1 The DPWH-CDO II DEO shall transfer the assets at cost to the LGU-CDOC after final acceptance of the projects and all required liquidation reports shall be submitted accordingly, and such shall be taken up in the books of the LGU-CDOC;
- Section 4.2 In the event of any breach of agreement/s stated herein, the DPWH-CDO II DEO has the option to terminate this Agreement ten (10) days after receipt of written Notice. Termination shall include the availment of other right and remedies stipulated in this MOU;
- Section 4.3 Implementation of Standards and Procedures. The involved parties, i.e. DPWH-CDO II DEO, LGU-CDOC, shall guarantee to carry out the FMR projects using the generally accepted Professional and Technical Standards of the DPWH and in accordance with the attached schedules and appropriate Procurement Procedures as stipulated in the RA 9184, also known as "Government Procurement Reform Act";
- Section 4.4 Authorized Representative/s. Any action required or permitted to be taken and any document/s required to be executed under this MOU in behalf of both parties (DPWH-CDO II DEO and LGU-CDOC) may be taken or executed by the DPWH-CDO II DEO and LGU-CDOC or any other person as may be assigned or designated in writing, provided, such assignment or designation is being authorized by DPWH-CDO II DEO and/or LGU-CDOC;
- Section 4.5 any dispute/disagreement arising due to the implementation of this MOU shall be settled and filed in the Regular Courts of Cagayan de Oro City;
- Section 4.6 This MOU shall take effect upon the signing of the signatories herein identified and shall be terminated upon final acceptance of the project/s.
