[2.] PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. 2017-141 – interposing no objection and/or endorsing the application of SM Prime Holdings, Inc., to the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA) for the declaration and/or accreditation of its SM CDO Downtown Premier BPO Tower located at C.M. Recto Avenue, this City, as Information Technology (IT) Center and Business Process Outsourcing Building, subject to the following conditions:

- a. SM Prime Holdings, Inc. shall continue to pay Real Property Tax (RPT) on building or spaces that are leased out to commercial establishments whose activities are not qualified for PEZA registration. These commercial establishments shall continue to pay all local government taxes;
- b. SM Prime Holdings, Inc. incentive shall be limited to the income that will be derived from leasing out spaces to PEZA registered companies. This particular income shall be subject to the special 5% tax on gross income in lieu of all national and local taxes and which shall be remitted as follows: 3% to the National Government and 2% directly remitted to the City Treasurer's Office of Cagayan de Oro.
- c. In case SM Prime Holdings., Inc. will not be able to lease out any space to any registered PEZA IT/BPO company, then it cannot avail of this special 5% gross income tax;
- d. SM Prime Holdings., Inc. shall pay RPT on machinery, if applicable; and
- e. SM Prime Holdings., Inc. and all its IT/BPO locators/lessees shall employ about 4,000 of their manpower from Cagayan de Oro City residents in coordination with Public Employment Services Office (PESO).

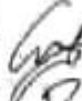

Greetings!

This pertains to the instant October 12, 2016 letter request of Mr. Constantine P. Arce, Assistant Mall Manager of SM CDO Downtown Premier as an Economic Zone which was referred to this Office for opinion.

Upon review of the provisions of Republic Act No. 8748 (June 1, 1999), the "SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONE ACT OF 1995", Section 4 and 5 thereof provides that:

"XXX

Section 4. Chapter III, Section 24 of Republic Act No. 7916 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 24. *Exemption from National and Local Taxes.* – Except for real property taxes on land owned by developers, no taxes, local and national, shall be imposed on business establishments operating within the ECOZONE. In lieu thereof, five percent (5%) of the gross income earned by all business enterprises within the ECOZONE shall be paid and remitted as follows:

"(a) Three percent (3%) to the National Government;

"(b) Two percent (2%) which shall be directly remitted by the business establishments to the treasurer's office of the municipality or city where the enterprise is located"

Section 5. Chapter III, Section 25 of Republic Act No. 7916 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 25. *Applicable National and Local Taxes.* – All persons and service establishments in the ECOZONE shall be subject to national and local taxes under the National Internal Revenue Code and the Local Government Code."

XXX"

Based on the foregoing provisions, it is clear that except for Real Property Taxes on land owned by developers, no taxes, local and national, shall be imposed on business establishments operating within the ECOZONE. Meaning, That the City Government of Cagayan de Oro can no longer assess and collect business taxes and real property taxes on building and machineries from the applicant and other Peza accredited establishments operating therein.

However, in lieu the exemption of national and local taxes, a five percent (5%) of the gross income earned by all business enterprises within the ECOZONE shall be paid and remitted as follows: (a) Three percent (3%) to the National Government and (b) Two percent (2%) to be remitted by the establishments operating therein to the City Government of Cagayan de Oro.

Thus, should the City Council choose to favorably indorse SM CDO Downtown Premier as an Economic Zone, the City Government will then only be entitled to collect the following taxes/fees:

1. Real Property Taxes on land owned by developers only. **Building and machineries** (classified as commercial) which are also subject to real property taxation under R.A. 7160 are now exempted;
2. 2% of share of the establishments' gross income in lieu of business taxes which the city can collect under the Local Government Code; and
3. Regulatory fees which are not covered by the exemption for these are not taxes.

Accordingly, it is suggested that a cost-benefit analysis be conducted by the City Council before it decides whether or not to endorse SM CDO Downtown Premier's application for Peza accreditation. For this purpose, we highly recommend that the City Treasurer's comment be solicited on the matter, specifically on the possible effects of the Peza accreditation on the City Government's revenue generation efforts.

This pertains to the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) by and between the City Government of Cagayan de Oro, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), and SM Prime Holdings, covering the construction by the latter of a 4 meter-wide concrete pavement beside the portion of Bitan-ag Creek, parallel to the Butuan-Cagayan de Oro-Iligan National Road (BCIR) adjoining SM CDO Downtown Premier.

TRIPARTITE AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Agreement entered into and executed by and among:

SM PRIME HOLDINGS, INC., a judicial entity herein represented by its _____, _____, Filipino, of legal age, married, and a resident of Cagayan de Oro City, hereinafter referred to as SM,

and

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS, a government agency, herein represented by its Regional Director Virgilio C. Eduarte, Filipino, of legal age, married, and a resident of Cagayan de Oro City, hereinafter referred to as DPWH,

and

THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF CAGAYAN DE ORO, herein represented by City Mayor Oscar S. Moreno, Filipino, of legal age, married, and a resident of Cagayan de Oro City, hereinafter referred to as CITY GOVERNMENT,

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the SM Management has offered to undertake the regular cleaning and maintenance of a section of Bitan-ag Creek and Drainage located parallel to Butuan-Cagayan de Oro-Iligan National Road (BCIR) and those within and adjacent to its property.

WHEREAS, in line with its commitment to maintain and clean the said creek and drainage system, SM will develop the easement of the waterway along its property by providing a 4-meter wide concrete pavement for such purpose.

WHEREAS, the construction of the said easement would greatly ease the vehicular traffic along Claro M. Recto Avenue and Sergio Osmeña Street.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the premises, the parties hereto hereby agree and covenant as follows:

1. SM shall undertake the construction of the 4-meter easement according to the plan duly approved by the DPWH and the CITY GOVERNMENT.
2. SM shall abide with the guidelines that DPWH and the CITY GOVERNMENT may want SM to follow and observe, particularly in the methodology and schedule of the clean up and maintenance of the waterway.

- 3. SM shall explore all possibilities to beautify the periphery of the waterway in coordination and consultation with the CITY GOVERNMENT and neighboring stakeholders.
- 4. The CITY GOVERNMENT and DPWH shall allow SM to use the concrete pavement along the waterway for vehicle traffic, as additional one-way exit towards C. M. Recto Avenue aside from Osmeña Street exit, to ensure a smoother traffic flow for the general public.
- 5. SM shall facilitate coordination with other stakeholders in the course of the undertaking of this project.
- 6. DPWH and CITY GOVERNMENT shall have ready access to the easement to monitor the status of the waterway with full support and cooperation from the SM administration.
